After successfully holding alumni gatherings in Matsuyama City, Japan, this time it was the turn of Unhas alumni in the Netherlands who received the visit of the Rector, Prof. Dwia Aries Tina Pulubuhu MA. This “Unhas Greetes Alumni” activity took place at VUMc Amsterdam, Netherlands, Wednesday 3 April 2019 at 14.00-17.00 local time.

Taking place in a warm atmosphere, the event was attended by around 40 people who were dominated by Unhas alumni who continued their studies in the Netherlands. Also attending were the Indonesian Student Association in the Netherlands, the University of Indonesia Alumni Association, the Gadjah Mada Univ. Alumni Family, & the Indonesian community in the Netherlands. In addition to alumni in the Netherlands, this gathering was also attended by alumni from Belgium

Prof. Dwia together with the Vice Rector II, Prof. Sumbangan Baja and Director of Alumni & Career Preparation, Abdullah Sanusi Ph.D., were welcomed by the Head of the Department of Oral VUMC Surgery, Prof. Tymour Forouzanfar MD DDS. In her presentation, Prof. Dwia said, currently Unhas continues to spur to become a world-class university. The students attending public lectures came from undergraduate, master and doctoral degree. Deputy Dean of Academic, Research and Innovation; Subehan, opened this public lecture. He hoped the information presented by Prof. Lisa McKenna can be useful for the participants.

The participants were very interested on the material presented by Prof. Lisa. This is based on the requirements of international publications for students at master and doctoral degree as the outputs of their research.

FACULTY OF FORESTRY UNHAS HELD A PUBLIC LECTURE ON PRIMATE CONSERVATION



On 15th of April 2019, in Faculty of Forestry Universitas Hasanuddin, Elisa Gregoria from University of Girona (Spain) delivered a public lecture entitled "Primate Conservation in Spain" and Victor Beltran from University of Leipzig (Germany) presented a public lecture about "Field Research in Primates: Methods and Techniques". These public lectures are resulted from a collaboration between Faculty of Forestry Unhas and The Forest Resource Conservation and Ecotourism Laboratory and University of Leipzig, Germany. The public lectures marked a major aim of the Faculty of Forestry of Universitas Hasanuddin which aspires to be a globally recognized

faculty and learning from the best practices worldwide. The public lecture itself was aimed to share knowledge of wildlife conservation and the methods utilized in the research of wildlife, especially primates.

The public lecture was both opened and moderated by Dr. Risma Illa Maulany, S.Hut, M.NatResSt. Risma is an academic staff of the Faculty of Forestry, Universitas Hasanuddin. Both undergraduate and postgraduate students that attended the program showed their enthusiasm in learning about primate conservation in Spain, which were reflected through their activeness in question sessions. The public lecture was able to attract interests of individual who are or plan to undergo field research about primates in the wildlife.



UNIVERSITAS HASANUDDIN IS GOING TO COLLABORATES WITH HELSINKI UNIVERSITY AND SEVERAL FINLAND UNIVERSITIES

In order to strengthen the relationship between UNHAS and Finnish Universities, Indonesian Embassy for Finland held a workshop on Global Joint Responsibility on 5th April 2019 in Helsinki. Universitas Hasanuddin formed an educational collaboration with Helsinki University and several Finland universities as a way to learn from the country with the best valued educational system in the world.

In the workshop, Finnish Ministry of Education introduced a flexible “basic curriculum” which also applied to higher education. Finland’s education system, including higher education system, has a flexible curriculum. The curriculum acts as the basis for universities to prepare their own curriculum. Universities are encouraged to be creative in emphasizing the uniqueness and specialties of their scientific fields. Therefore, Schools are not encouraged to teach or employ the same curriculum or method within the same schedule.

Finland caught the attention of the world with global surveys on world life quality (Newsweek ranked Finland as the country with the highest life quality). Finland’s national

education system received praises and acknowledgments after their students achieved the highest score test in the world in the past few years.

Therefore, Universitas Hasanuddin felt that Finland’s education system can be taken as a benchmark and Universitas Hasanuddin has a lot of multidisciplinary collaborations with Finnish universities. This cooperation includes knowledge exchange, by open discussions and seminars, and academics and students exchange programs.

Directorate of International Partnership, in this regard, evaluated some of research collaboration programs with aim to produce internationally-acclaimed academic publications.

FKM UNHAS DOCTORAL PROGRAM STUDENTS BECOME SPEAKERS AT APACPH-KL

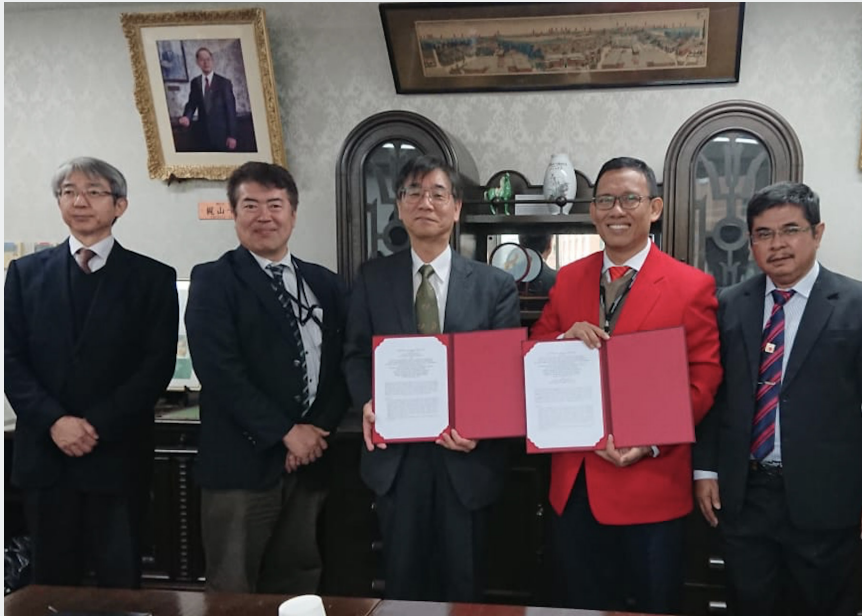


Twenty students of the Hasanuddin University Faculty of Public Health Doctoral Program (FKM Unhas) attended as well as being presenters at the Kuala Lumpur Chapter of the Asia Pacific Consortium of Public Health (APACPH-KL) Conference held at the University of Malaya, 11-12 April 2019. The students joined with around 400 participants from various countries including, Malaysia, Vietnam, Thailand, India, Sri Lanka and Indonesia. Prof. Sukri Palutturi, SKM., M Kes., MSc PH, PhD who is also Deputy Dean of Student Affairs, Alumni and Partnership FKM Unhas and Prof. Dr. Ridwan Amiruddin, SKM., M Kes., MSc PH as Chair of the Health Sciences Doctoral Study Program also attended the conference.

The conference carrying the theme of, “Early Career Global Public Health Conference”, namely, the Implementation Science for Improving Population Health. APACPH-KL is an international non-profit organization with the aim of improving the quality and relevance of public health education and training programs and expanding knowledge, improving skills and demonstrating effective interventions. As stated by Prof. Dr. Maznah Dahlui as chairman of the committee in her opening remarks. After the opening ceremony by Prof. Dato Adeeba Kamarulzaman as Dean of the Faculty of Medicine, University of Malaya, continued with the first session plenary with the topic, “Mentoring Young Public Health Professionals” and second session plenary on the topic of, “Managing Big Data for Research and Forum Career Pathways in Public Health “. What is interesting in this plenary session is during a Career Pathways in Public Health session where a public health professional works for example as a lecturer, researcher, trainer, social worker and Non-Government Organization.

Prof. Sukri Palutturi, PhD also contributed to share information in the international forum. “The concept and application of public health in each country can be different from one another, for example, in Malaysia and several other countries.” In Indonesia public health education starts from the Bachelor of Public Health (SKM), Master of Public Health and Doctor of Public Health,” explained Prof. Sukri. Furthermore, Prof. Sukri explained simply that it is easy to distinguish a professional public health from a clinician. “A public health doctor, for example, but what they are doing is the service of a doctor-patient relationship so they do not consistently carry out their functions as professional public health but they are clinicians, public health is how to prevent someone from getting sick and improving their health conditions at the level of individuals, populations and communities,” explained Prof. Sukri. During the afternoon to evening session, the oral presentation was divided into several themes, namely Epidemiology; Health System and Policy; Occupational and Environmental Health; and Behavioral and Reproductive Health. Prof. Ridwan as Chairperson of the Doctoral Program Study at FKM Unhas who was contacted separately said that he was very happy with this activity. “This activity is an academic forum and networking forum. Therefore, I ask every Unhas representative that every student need to meet at least five participants or institutions from other countries,” he concluded.

UNHAS DELEGATION VISITED KYUSHU UNIVERSITY AND NAGASAKI UNIVERSITY



Kyushu University and The existing collaboration will be developed in the form of Join-author in Journal Writing.

The next day, 12 April 2019 Unhas delegation visited Nagasaki University. Nagasaki University side led by the vice rector of Nagasaki University and the members were Prof. Tetsuo Harada (Vice Rector of Nagasaki University) and Prof. Kohei Yamaguchi from Civil engineering department of Nagasaki University. The meeting started by having discussion about the plan of joint-visit.

Delegation from Universitas Hasanuddin visited Japan in April 2019. The delegation was led by the Vice Rector for Research, Innovation and partnership; Prof. Dr. Nasrum Massi, PhD. The dean of Faculty of Engineering Dr. M. Arsyad Thaha & Prof. Rudy Dhamaluddin (The head of the Structure Lap of Civil Engineering Department) were also in the delegation.

On 11th April 2019 the delegation of UNHAS visited Kyushu Univ. In Kyushu University, the delegation team from the Faculty of Engineering of Kyushu University was Prof. Yoshio Hisaeda (The dean of Faculty of Engineering), Prof. Hidenori Hamada (The head of Civil Engineering Department), and Prof. Yasuhiro Mitani (The Head of International Collaboration). The meeting resulted several agreement: The student exchange will start by delegating master students from the second year of study to conduct research collaborating with Unhas for 3-6 months, Japanese students who conduct the joint research are exempt from tuition fees, Unhas will try to support accommodation while doing the research, The fee of in-bound professors' visit from Japan will be covered fully by Unhas for one person while the other ones will be covered by Kyushu University and Prof. Tsukahara will be invited as a speaker to attend the ICCE that will be held in Bali on 29-30 August 2019.

In addition, it was also agreed that International students from Civil engineering department are welcome to have internship program in

The meeting came with several agreements as follows:

- 1) Collaboration plan will involve the collaboration in either student exchange and/or in research field;
- 2) Nagasaki University welcomes the collaboration plan to have in-out bound professor and join-author in journal writing;
- 3) The internship program of international student will be held for 1 to 3 months in the form of joint-research, lecture internship, and the other programs done with Japanese students;
- 4) Prof. Yamaguchi will arrange his time to be able to attend the plan of Engineering Faculty to hold the international conference ICCEE that is planed to be held in Bali on 29-30 August 2019;
- 5) The follow-up of the collaboration plan will start with the signing of the MOU.

UNHAS INTERNATIONAL CLASS EXHIBITION 2019



Being recognized as a World Class University (WCU) has been a major aim of Universitas Hasanuddin. As an autonomous university, various efforts have been conducted in order to raise the university's international rankings, and exposure. One of the efforts include the establishment of International Classes, designated for both locals of Indonesian people, and International students worldwide. As of the year 2019, Hasanuddin University has successfully attained the ASEAN University Network - Quality Assurance (AUN-QA). AUN-QA assesses study programs in South-east Asia, in regards to the quality assurance of learning outcomes, student assessment, academic staff and supporting staff development, and many other crucial aspects related to the advancement of education services provided to students. Universitas Hasanuddin currently has 15 study programs, spread in 10 different faculties,

which have been certified AUN-QA. The next step for the study programs that have successfully attained the certification is the establishment of International classes, as such study programs are perceived to have sufficient qualities to facilitate International students. The Director of Educational Affairs, Dr. Ida Leida, in coordination with the Vice Rector for Research, Innovation and Partnership, Prof. Dr. Muh. Nasrum Massi, Ph.D, conducted the 2019 UNHAS International Class Expo, as an effort to attract locals for the International class programs. Several of the study programs that took part in the expo include Marine Sciences, Geology, Civil Engineering, International Relations, Law Studies, Economics, Management, Accounting, Medical Sciences, and Public

Health. Participated by hundreds of students, the expo succeeded in increasing the awareness and interest of students about the International Classes of UNHAS. There are in total three student admission pathways for Universitas Hasanuddin, which include (1) SNMPTN, admission based on grades and achievements, (2) SBMPTN, test based admission, and (3) Independent admission, which include non-subsidized pathways of entering Universitas Hasanuddin.

Universitas Hasanuddin welcomes all students from Southeast Asia, and students from all around the world. The University currently provides many scholarships for admission in the specified study programs that have established their International classes.
