HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY INTERNATIONAL CULTURAL PROGRAM 2018 (UICP)



Hasanuddin University International Cultural Program 2018 (UICP) is the first annual international culture and multidisciplinary exchange program carried out by Hasanuddin University. This activity was held on August 13-19, 2018, and attended by undergraduate and postgraduate students originating from countries worldwide. The participants consisted of 14 foreign student participants from 10 different countries, and 5 students from South Sulawesi, Indonesia. The UICP 2018 was aimed to provide participants with an introduction of the unique cultures of South Sulawesi, and an opportunity of interaction with people from different cultural backgrounds.

For the first several days, students visited Hasanuddin University faculties to gain insight on why the university is currently in its path to becoming a World Class University. They were welcomed at the University Teaching Industry. They also visited the recently constructed

Faculty of Engineering, and were especially welcomed by lecturers from Geological Department. At the end of the first day, the participants visited Fort Rotterdam and Losari Beach, to study and directly witness the unique history and culture of South Sulawesi.

UICP 2018 participants also participated in two interactive classes, namely maritime history Indonesia (specifically on South Sulawesi), and introduction to basic (*cont...*)

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Indonesian language and culture. Participants are also given an interactive lecture entitled Reflection and Presentation, presented in an interactive, fun, and enthusiastic way, to make the lecturing seem of ease for all of the participants.

But what made UICP special was the cultural visit to Toraja and Outdoor learning in Hasanuddin University's Education Forest in Maros, known as Bengo-Bengo, a two-hour drive from the university. UICP 2018 participants learned the culture of South Sulawesi by sightseeing in Toraja. They visited several cultural sites that Toraja has been typically famous for, and conducted intensive cultural discussions



with material providers appointed by the executive committee. The cultural sites visited were located in the districts of Makale & Rantepao, Toraja. In Bengo-Bengo, participants were given the opportunity to see the breeding ground of bees and taste the authentic taste of honey, with the guidance of faculty members of the Faculty of Forestry. At the closing ceremony, participants enthusiastically showed the results of traditional dances South Sulawesi they learned throughout the seven days of their presence in Makassar. With pride, participants expressed their sincere satisfaction with the implementation of the 2018 UICP. After seeing the immense enthusiasm of the participants, Hasanuddin University plan to conduct the second annual International Cultural Program. PUBLIC LECTURE: INTERDISCIPLINARY STUDIES & WORLD CLASS UNIVERSITY; RESPONDING TO CHALLENGES IN ENTERING INDUSTRIAL REVOLUTION 4.0

Thursday, 16th August 2018, Professor Sitti Kusujarti PhD from Warren Wilson College, United States and Associate Professor Sulfikar Amir PhD from Nanyang Technology University, Singapore gave an International public lecture at Hasanuddin University Makassar. Vice Rector for Academic Affairs of Hasanuddin University, Prof. Dr. Muhammad Restu, MP said that the two speakers were deliberately invited to deliver a public lecture entitled Interdisciplinary Studies and World Class University: Respondents to Challenges in Entering Industrial Revolution 4.0 in the senate room of Rectorate Building at Hasanuddin University. He said that "this sharing session is a good moment for Unhas to improve the quality of education and it can also anticipate the development of learning process in Unhas triggered by the advances of technology.

The dynamics of learning need to be responded by initiating collaboration with Indonesian scientists abroad. In her presentation, Prof. Sitti Kusujarti said that the internationalization of higher education is a global symptom because the world is currently experiencing integration into one inseparable entity, so that university as an institution should follow this trend. Associate Professor Sulfikar Amir discussed technology and industry 4.0. He explained that the core of the 4.0 industrial revolution includes digitalization, automation, and interconnection. The 2nd, a public lecture entitled "In Search of Celebes Man: an Archaeological Study of Early Hominin Occupation in Sulawesi", was conducted on August 28, 2018 with an expert from Griffith Univ Australia, Assoc. Prof. Adam Brumm.

The last one, a workshop entitled "Kimono and Its Cultural Values in Japan Society", was interestingly presented by Ms. Kikuko kato and Mrs. Dewi Lastmi Miyakawa on August 29, 2018. This last event was a cooperation between UNHAS and Japan Consulate Office in Makassar. More events will be conducted in September, October, and November this year with speakers from various countries such as Jordan, Palestine, and Korea.

MANAGEMENT DEPARTMENT, FACULTY OF ECONOMICS BUSINESS CONDUCTED BENCHMARKING AT THE FACULTY OF ECONOMICS, CHULALONGKORN UNIVERSITY

The Management Department of the Faculty of Economics and Business conducted a benchmarking activity at the Faculty of Economics, Chulalongkorn University, Thailand on August 7, 2018. This benchmarking study is one of the forms of capacity building for the department of management. In carrying out this activity, the Management Department team was led directly by the Dean of FEB, Prof.Dr. Abd. Rahman Kadir, M.Si and also Head of the Management Department, Dr.Nurjannah Hamid, M.Agr.

This activity was held with the aim of studying the internationalization process, curriculum development, learning outcomes, supporting facilities, teaching-learning process, quality assurance process, and student and alumni activities at the Chulalongkorn University's Faculty of Economics. In addition, Management Department learned the experience of AUN-QA accreditation that had been conducted at Chulalongkorn University in 2014. According to Unhas' AUN Visit schedule, Management Department will receive assessor visits from the ASEAN University Network - Quality Assurance (AUN-QA) in November 2018.

Furthermore, the Dept of Management's benchmarking team was welcomed by the Dean of the Faculty of Economics Chulalongkorn University, Prof.Dr.Worawet Suwanrada and the Director of EBA (Bachelor of Arts in Economics). Benchmark activities began with the introduction of delegates from respective universities and were

followed by remarks by Prof.Dr. Abd. Rahman Kadir, M.Si. Afterwards, it was followed by a presentation from the Director of EBA regarding the EBA program and the AUN-QA accreditation process that had been concluded in 2014. In addition, both parties also discussed internationalization programs carried out by Chulalongkorn University and discussed the potential of collaboration that can be done between the two parties. The program was then continued with a discussion process between the two universities related to various academic aspects in their respective study programs. The event was closed by a souvenir exchange by the Dean of the respective University, followed by conducting a campus-tour to learn and view various facilities that could support the learning process.

UNIVERSITAS HASANUDDIN AND JAPANESE RESEARCHERS COLLABORATE ON THE APPLICATION OF RENEWABLE ENERGY SOURCE TECHNOLOGY IN SOUTH SULAWESI

the Engineering Faculty of Unhas, Dr. Eng Muhammad Isran Ramli explained that this International General Lecture was kind of sharing research results conducted by researchers from the Faculty of Engineering Unhas and researchers from Japan.

The researchers who joined the meeting were

- Prof. Yoshiro Narita as JICA-CBEST Expert;
- Dr. Eng Jalaluddin from the Engineering Faculty of Unhas, and
- Dr. Eng Arief Widiatmojo, a researcher from Japanese research institute called AIST (National Institute of Advance Industrial Science Technology).

This activity was also attended by several industry partners.

The future action agenda will be an international yymposium on smart infrastructure Issues and renewable energy sources that will be held in November 2019.

This activity will be a collaboration between the Center of Technology Engineering Faculty of Unhas with Industry (for example: Kalla Group) and together with three Regional Governments in South Sulawesi: Tana Toraja Regency Government, North Toraja Regency Government & Enrekang Regency Government.
