FOUR STUDY PROGRAMS ACHIEVED ASIIN ACCREDITATION, GERMANY



Universitas Hasanuddin establishes its existence as an international standard university, indicated by the increasing number of internationally accredited study programs.

Latest news, Unhas again received the results of accreditation from a very credible and prestigious institution called Akkreditierungsagentur für Studiengänge der Ingenieurwissenschaften, der Informatik, der Naturwissenschaften und der Mathematik or ASIIN, which is a European Accreditation Institution based in Germany for Engineering, Informatics / Computer, Natural Sciences, and Mathematics.

The accreditation was given to the following 4 study programs at Unhas:

- Study Program of Pharmacy
- Study Program of Nursing
- Study Program of Aquaculture
- Study Program of Food Science and Technology

Director of Communication of Unhas, Suharman Hamzah, Ph.D. mentioned that the achievement is a crucial step for Unhas. ASIIN is known to have very strict criteria and standards.

"It is not easy to get quality recognition from ASIIN. After sending the accreditation document, the assessors came to visit. After that, the assessors send notes of improvements that must be made by the study programs. So this requires intensive work from the ASIIN task forces in each study program." said Suharman.

Each ASIIN task forces in the study programs have shown commitment and sincerity in completing the ASIIN criteria. Therefore, the result is quite satisfied.

"Especially for Nursing Study Program, this accreditation also includes recognition of the nurse profession program. We congratulate faculty leaders and study programs for this achievement," said Suharman.

With this accomplishment, 23 study programs at Unhas have successfully met various criteria and standards of international accreditation. Three institutions that provide recognition for these study programs are AUN-QA, ABEST-21, and ASIIN.

"All 15 faculties at Unhas at least have I internationally accredited study program for each. This implies that quality of learning in Unhas works equal and balanced" said Suharman.

RECTOR OF UNHAS RELEASES STUDENTS OF INTERNATIONAL CLASSES TO EUROPE, AUSTRALIA, & CANADA

The Rector of Unhas, Prof. Dr. Dwia Pulubuhu, MA, officially dispatched 25 students of international classes from Faculty of Public Health (FKM) and Faculty Economy & Business (FEB). The students will join the lecturing process at partner universities of Unhas in Europe, Australia, & Canada for 1 to 3 months.

On Friday, June 21, 2019, the event was attended by the Director of Education of Unhas (Dr. Ida Leida Maria, SKM., M.KM), Dean of the Faculty of Economy and Business (Prof. Dr. Abd. Rahman Kadir, M.Si CIPM), Vice-Dean II of the Faculty of Public Health (Dr. Atjo Wahyu, SKM., M.Kes), Head of the International Affairs Office (Karmila Mokoginta, MA, M.Hum), and Head of Academic Administration Bureau (Ernawati Rivai, MM).

Prof. Dr. Abdul Rahman Laba, MBA as Chair of the FEB International Class Manager, and M. Sabranjamil Alhaqqi, MIntBus along with the FEB International class management team as well as students and parents of students were also present at the event.

The destination universities are international partners of Unhas International Class Program, including University of Griffith (Australia), Leibniz Universität Hannover (Germany), Goethe Universitat Frankfurt Am Main (Germany), Utrecht University in (Netherlands), and Humber College (Canada).

The Rector of Unhas warmly welcomed the students who are actually the first badge of the program. She emphasized the importance of taking advantage of overseas study opportunities for all international class students.

"This is an excellent opportunity to build networks & collaboration among academics, to enhance quality & competitiveness in a global context, & to become ambassadors for Indonesia and UNHAS in International Community." said Prof Dwia.

Before releasing the students, Unhas also conducted a pre-departure briefing for the students before the departure. This pre-departure briefing aimed to mitigate the culture shock that might happen to the students while studying at the partner universities.

Director of Education of Unhas, Dr. Ida Leida Maria, explained that the international exposure programs attended by students are in the form of Credit Transfer program with a duration of one semester, Double Degree Program (I-I.5 years in length) and Sit-In and Summer School program which lasts I-2 months in the country of study destination.

This is the excellence that we offer in the International Class Program of Unhas. "Students have international experience since they are in university, therefore they will open up their mind for the global insights," said Ida Leida.

In this 2019, again Unhas offers the opportunity for the High School students to be part of the International Class program. There are 10 study programs offered by far. Besides lecturing process delivered in English, the International class program also offers education systems in the form of Single and Double Degree conducted by international partner universities. The Double Degree System provides an opportunity for students to obtain 2 undergraduate degrees at the same time when completing the undergraduate level.

UNHAS AND EHIME UNIVERSITY JAPAN JOINT RESEARCH IN PALU – SIGI



Team of Center for Disaster Study and Research of Universitas Hasanuddin conducted research together with the Team of Disaster Study of Ehime University of Japan in Sibalaya, Palu, Central Sulawesi. The Research Teams have been in the field since Sunday, June 24th, 2019, and they will stay there for 14 days.

The advanced research was focused on the excavation of certain locations to examine the liquefaction phenomenon that occurred in Palu and surrounding area on September 28th, 2018 ago. The earthquake and liquefaction disaster have shocked the international community, especially the geological researchers or geologists. The objective of this research is to find out the mechanism that caused the liquefaction during the natural disaster.


Sibalaya was chosen because of its location which is ideal for digging and excavating until the liquefaction source can be discovered. When the earthquake and liquefaction hit Central Sulawesi, Sibalaya area experienced the liquefaction and shifted approximately 500 meters from its original area.

Head of the Center for Disaster Study and Research at Unhas, Dr. Adi Maulana, said that this research collaboration was based on the MoU between Unhas and Ehime University. The Teams conducted excavation at several places using heavy equipment to make 5-7 meters deep and 3-4 meters wide of excavation pits.

"It is expected that in this study, the teams can reveal the liquefaction mechanism and learn it, then make it as a disaster mitigation references in the future. This research will also be crucial to be used as a reference in reviewing spatial planning in earthquake-prone areas in other places so that casualties and property damage can be minimized, "said Adi Maulana.

He hopes that the results of this study will be useful not only for the development of science but also for future mitigation needs of disaster so that casualties and property damage can be minimized. (*)
