### AMBASSADOR OF JAPAN TO INDONESIA OFFICIALLY INAUGURATED JAPAN CORNER OFFICE IN UNIVERSITAS HASANUDDIN



Japanese Ambassador to Indonesia, H.E. Masafumi Ishii, visited Unhas for the first time. The first time visit was in the context of official inauguration and launching of Japan Corner Unhas, which took place at the Central Library of Universitas Hasanuddin, Tamalanrea Campus Makassar, July 30th, 2019.

Japan Corner Unhas has been operating since 2017. Various activities have been carried out by this unit, including various seminars and workshops. Meta Sekar Puji Astuti, Ph.D., as the coordinator of Unhas Japan Corner explained that the idea to establish this unit was based on some consideration, including the interest of Unhas students to know more about Japan.



## UNIVERSITAS HASANUDDIN, UNIVERSITAS INDONESIA & VICTORIA UNIVERSITY OF WELLINGTON AGREED TO COLLABORATE IN IMPROVING THE CAPACITY OF THE INDONESIAN STATE CIVIL APPARATUS



Departing from the mandate of the Ministry of State Apparatus Empowerment/Bureaucratic Reform (PAN/RB) in improving the capacity of Indonesian human resources especially for the State Civil Apparatus (ASN) which are the front guard in public services, Universitas Hasanuddin (Unhas) and Universitas Indonesia (UI) were entrusted to build cooperation with partner universities abroad in educating and building a culture of serving ASN to the community. One country that has a very good public service track record is the government of New Zealand.

Tuesday, 30 July 2019, morning in Wellington, the Rector of Unhas with the Unhas Board of Trustees, Prof. Eko Prasajo (Dean of the Faculty of Administrative Sciences UI/Chair of the National Independent Bureaucracy Reform Team), and PAN/RB Ministry Staff met with Victoria University of Wellington (VUW), New Zealand. From the VUW present included: Grant Guilford (Vice Chancellor), Ian Williamson (Pro Vice Chancellor), Blair McRae

(Deputy Vice Chancellor), Girol Karacaoglu (Head of School of Government) and several Professors and VUW staff. The Rector of Unhas, Prof. Dr. Dwia Aries Tina Pulubuhu, MA, represented the Minister of PAN/RB expressed the intention to increase the capacity of the State Civil Apparatus (ASN) in Indonesia through collaboration with Victoria University of Wellington. Unhas and UI were appointed to be partners in Indonesia. This Ministry also in collaboration with the Educational Fund Management Institution (LPDP) to run this program.

The warm meeting took place in the Victoria room, Hunter Building at Kelburn Parade Campus Wellington. The discussion on the cooperation plan discusses in detail of the technical aspects of operational implementation of the program. It is expected that the program can run from July 2020. VUW will provide support with the best teachers in the field of e-government to run and to support the implementation of this tripartite collaboration.

4. Grant for Environmental Research Projects, to be applied in English or Japanese.

5. Grant for Basic Science Research Projects, to be applied in English or Japanese

## STUDENTS OF MURDOCH UNIVERSITY AUSTRALIA STUDY VISIT TO THE FACULTY OF PUBLIC HEALTH UNIVERSITAS HASANUDDIN



The urban planning design of the Revitalizing Informal Settlement and Their Environment (RISE) program implemented by UNHAS & Monash University attracted the attention of Engineering & Energy students, the College of Science, Health, Engineering & Education, Murdoch University, Australia.

The enthusiasm of Engineering students was seen in the study visit to the Indonesian RISE office at the Faculty of Public Health (FKM) Unhas, Monday (15/7). This visit was led directly by Murdoch University's Academic Chair Environmental Engineering, Dr. Martin, PhD, B.SC. (Hons), B. Eng (UWA). Their visit was received by RISE Indonesia Coordinator Fitriyanty Awaluddin, Unhas RISE Focal Point Ansariadi, SKM, MSc.PH, Ph.D, RISE Build Team Leader DR. Eng Ihsan Latief, and Vice Dean for Student Affairs, Alumni & Partnership FKM Unhas Prof. Sukri Palutturi, M.Sc.PH, Ph.D.

"RISE is a Monash University Australia and Unhas research project in Makassar. Working in 12 slums and one pilot site in Makassar, RISE aims to provide research-based evidence that a water-sensitive and localized city approach can provide sustainable and cost-effective health and environmental improvements," explained Unhas RISE Focal Point, Ansariadi, SKM. MSc PH., Ph. D.

RISE uses the concept of green infrastructure in handling slum areas. The program is testing natural solutions – such as built artificial swamps and specially designed absorption gardens – to reduce environmental pollution & human contact with pollution.

The success of the program will be measured by the health of residents living in slums – especially children under the age of five – & the environment around the community.

In the study visit, students visited the RISE laboratory. Guided by RISE Lab Technician, Zulkify, Murdoch's students conducted a touring lab to see several environmental samples such as mosquito samples which are vectors of several diseases such as malaria and dengue fever.

## UNHAS WAS ENTRUSTED TO HOST THE 2ND INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON GLOBAL STS (SCIENCE, TECHNOLOGY AND SOCIETY)

As a continuation of the first conference in 2014 at Nanyang Technology University Singapore, The 2nd International Conference on Global STS was held on July 24-27 2019 in Makassar, South Sulawesi. The conference was attended by researchers from universities in Makassar, Java and Sumatra. Chair of the Committee, Dr. Rijal Idrus, said that Global STS is a platform of exchange of scientific works for international researchers in the field of STS. He hoped this event will create a productive debates and scientific exchanges for researchers in the field of STS from all over the world.

This conference brought the theme “Between the Land & The Sea, Knowledge Transformation & New Knowledge Production”. Some sub themes were discussed, namely: Sustainability of Governance, biodiversity & conservation, social changes & green development, climate change & Anthropocene, disaster & resilience, cities & urban transitions, medical and public health, digital systems and big data, and energy politics.

It took places in Official Residence of Governor of South

Sulawesi, & in Fort Rotterdam Makassar. Several world experts were attended & be the speakers such as Professor Michael Fisher (Massachusetts Institute of Technology) USA, Dr. Adam Brumm (Griffith University), Prof. Sulfikar, (Nanyang Technological Univ. Singapore), Dr. Sara Beavis (Australian National Univ), Prof.Wen Lin Tu (National Chengchi Univ. Taiwan).

In addition, several senior Indonesian researchers also attended this event, including Prof. Sangkot Marzuki (President of Indonesia Academy of Science), Prof. Satriyo Soemantri, Prof. Jamaluddin Jompa & Prof. Irawan (Univ. Hasanuddin).

## STUDYING SOCIAL BEHAVIOR IN MACAQUES



Faculty of forestry held a general lecture on Tuesday, July 9th, 2019 in Senate Room, Faculty of Forestry. The general lecture titled “Studying Social Behavior in Macaques” was delivered by three speakers from University of Lincoln and San Diego State University.

This lecture is one form of collaboration between the Lab. of Forest Resources & Ecotourism Conservation, Faculty of Forestry, Univ. Hasanuddin, Univ. of Lincoln & San Diego State Univ.

The purpose of this general lecture was to share knowledge and understanding of the social behavior of monkeys as well as the methods used in the research of wildlife, especially primates.

## WORLD SCIENCE EXPERTS ATTEND THE 3RD ICOS HELD BY THE FACULTY OF MATHEMATICS AND NATURAL SCIENCES



The Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences (MIPA) Hasanuddin University held The 3rd International Conference on Science (ICOS). The conference was held in collaboration with the Indonesian Mathematical Society (IndoMS), the Indonesian Physics Association (HFI), the Indonesian Geophysical Expert Association (HAGI), the Indonesian Chemical Association (HKI), and the Indonesian Biological Consortium (KOBI). The conference took place on Friday - Saturday, July 26-27th 2019 at the Four Points Hotel by Sheraton, Makassar.

This 3rd ICOS presented keynote speakers with amazing international reputation; Prof. Jalifah binti Latip from Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia, Prof. Ocky Karna Radjasa from the Faculty of Maritime Affairs and Fisheries at Universitas Diponegoro, who is also the Director of Research and Community Service, Kemenristekdikti, Prof. Ian R. Young from the University of Melbourne, Australia, Prof. Kenseng Tan, Ph.D from the University of Waterloo, Canada.

Chair of The 3rd ICOS Committee, Prof. Dr. Ivan Azis, M.Sc, explained that the number of participants continues to increase. In the 1st ICOS in 2014, 71 papers were published in proceedings, while for the 2nd ICOS in 2017, 97 papers were published.

“In this 3rd ICOS, the committee received 284 abstracts. However, the committee implemented a multilevel selection system and 260 papers were accepted for oral presentation,” said Prof. Ivan.

Additionally, The executive committee also prepared a scheme for presentations in the form of posters. A total of 20 researchers participated in this poster session.

Since the 2nd ICOS and also for this 3rd ICOS, the paper presented was published in Scopus indexed proceedings. This has a significant impact on the increase in articles by the Unhas academic community indexed by Scopus. The ICOS paper was published in the Journal of Physics: Conference Series (JSPS) published by IOP.



## UNHAS DELEGATION EXPLORES COOPERATION AND CONDUCTED ALUMNI GATHERING IN KUALA LUMPUR



Delegation of Universitas Hasanuddin (Unhas) that was led directly by the Rector, Prof. Dwia Aries Tina Pulubuhu together with several officials in the Unhas (The Dean of Faculty of Medicine and Faculty of Dentistry) held a series of activities in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, on July 8-10, 2019.

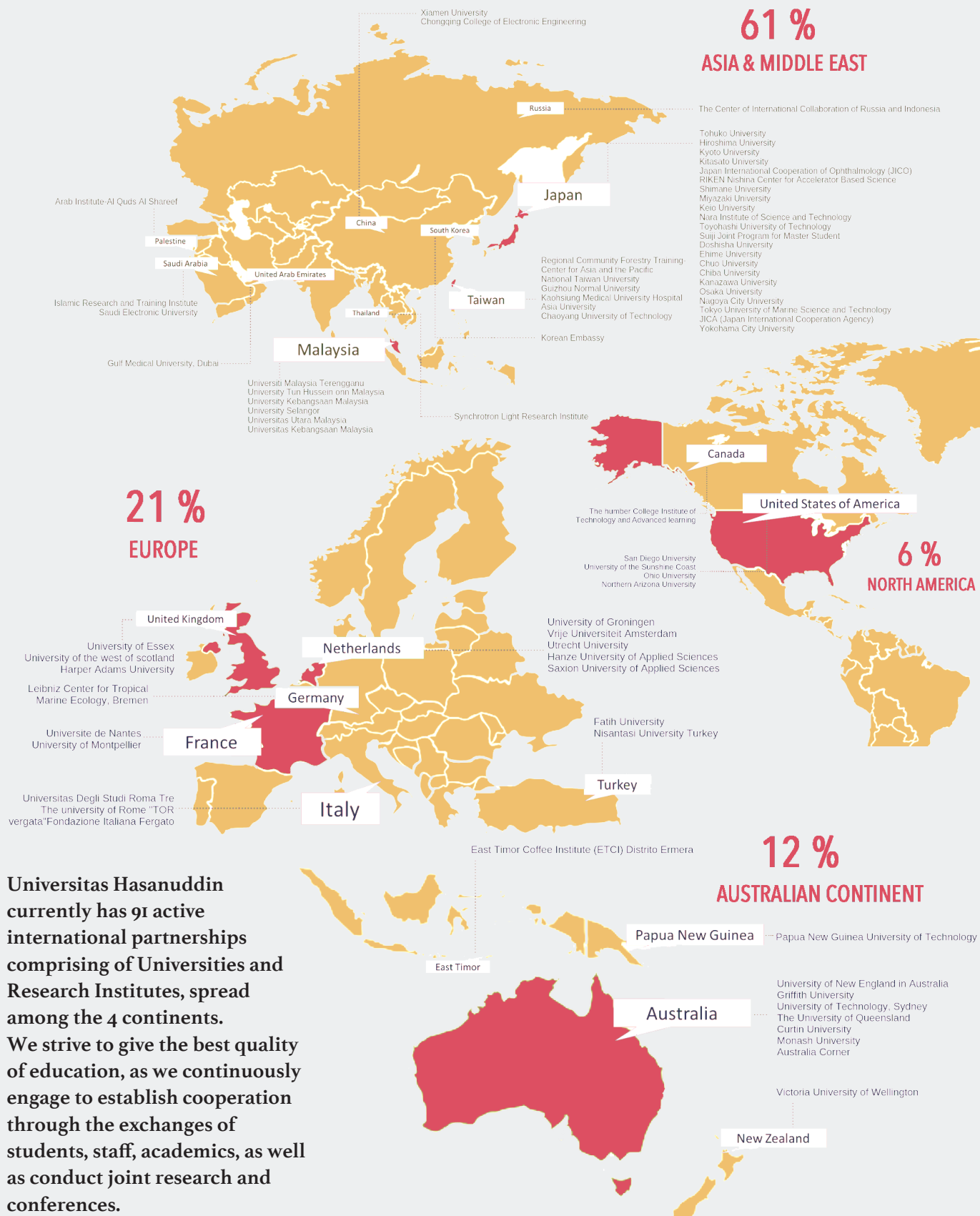
