## UNIVERSITAS HASANUDDIN HOSTED THE INTERNATIONAL LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURE SEMINAR



The Faculty of Agriculture of Universitas Hasanuddin collaborated with the Indonesian Landscape Architecture Association (IALI) in the conduct of an international seminar “International Landscape Architecture Seminar,” under the theme of “Preserving Traditional Village Landscape as a Tool for Sustainable and Local Quality Tourism Village,” which was conducted in Ibis Hotel, 11 September 2019.

The seminar discussed matters related to the natural and cultural landscape, with issues focused on the conservation of villages or regions that have a high potential of the cultural landscape. The seminar is a continuation of the Asia-Pacific student camp previously held, which was attended by participants from three countries and nine different institutions that have a Landscape Architecture Study Program in their respective institutions. After the conduct of the student camp, the participants camped in the Rammang-Rammang village between 08-11 September 2019, with the aim of directly interacting with locals and to view the cultural potential of the area. The results of the observations made will then be presented, completed with the suggested concept

that could be utilized in advancing the potentials that exist. A total number of 29 participants took active participation in this seminar.

The seminar consisted of two sessions, with the first section listening to the materials from three speakers that discussed issues related to landscape architecture. The following session gave the opportunity for the participants to present their findings in the form of a poster. The sessions provided key findings and suggestions to related governmental stakeholders of landscape architecture. Several officials representing key institutions expressed their enthusiasm and high hopes for the seminar. The individuals include the Vice-Rector for Academic Affairs Universitas Hasanuddin, Prof. Muh. Restu, Dean of the Agriculture Faculty, Prof. Baharuddin, Head of the National Board of the Indonesian Society for Landscape Architects (ISLA), Dr. Siti Nurisjah, as well as a number of lecturers from the Faculty of Agriculture.

UNHAS Postgraduate School (SPS) held The 2nd International Conference on Global Issues for Infrastructure, Environment, and Socio-Economic Development (GIESED), Wednesday, 11 September 2019, at Four Points Hotel by Sheraton, Makassar. The opening ceremony took place at 08.30 WITA by the Rector of Unhas, Prof. Dwia Tina Pulubuhu, MA.

This year, The 2nd GIESED took the main theme: “Sustaining the Earth and the People through renewable energy, green environment, sustainable agriculture, and socio-economic inclusion”. The program began with a report from the head of the committee, Prof. Dr.-Ing. Ir. Herman Parung, who is also the Deputy Dean of the Field. Prof. Herman explained that this conference was the second series of activities held by SPS Unhas. Present as the Keynote Speaker was Associate Prof. Ariel Liebman, Ph.D from Monash University. Prof. Liebman is Director of the Monash Grid Innovation Hub. Experts in the field of energy have the Scopus H-index 7.

In addition, the invited speakers invited at the conference were Prof. Mr. Yoshihiro Narira (Hokkaido University), Mr. Thijs Sablerolle (Project Development Director at Asia Power Development Platform Pte. Ltd), & Dr. Dimas B. E. Dharmowijoyo (Petronas University of Technology, Malaysia).

The Dean of SPS Unhas, Prof. Jamaluddin Jompa, M.Sc in his speech explained about the character and uniqueness of the conference which had been held twice. “The uniqueness of GIESED is not only because it is held regularly. This is an example of interdisciplinary collaboration in various fields of science. GIESED is a conference that discusses a global theme, but from various perspectives and various scientific disciplines,” said Prof. Jamal.

SPS Unhas is currently intensively promoting an interdisciplinary approach. Besides forming the Center for Interdisciplinary Studies, SPS Unhas also became the leading institutions at Unhas in the development of Sustainable Development Goals.



“We also have an SDGs Center. As we know, the SDGs have a lot of targets, so achieving those targets involves diverse scientific disciplines,” said Prof. Jamal. At the end of his remarks, Prof. Jamaluddin Jompa expressed his gratitude for the support given by various parties so that this conference could be held.

Unhas Rector, Prof. Dr. Dwia Aries Tina Pulubuhu, MA delivered her speech and opened the event. She began her lecture with a welcome speech and appreciation for the keynote speakers and invited speakers present. In Enrekang, the researcher visited Maiwa Breeding Center, an experimental farm owned by Universitas Hasanuddin

## FORESTRY FACULTY OF UNHAS AND UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE (USDA) HOLD A YOUTH BIOTECH OUTREACH



Universitas Hasanuddin through the forestry faculty in collaboration with the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) and foreign agricultural services held a youth biotech outreach. This event was officially opened Wednesday (09/25) in the Hall of the Faculty of Forestry at 09.30 WITA (Central Indonesia Time Zone) attended by around 100 participants consisting of students, lecturers, and delegates from various offices throughout South Sulawesi.

The main objective of this event was to socialize the importance of biotechnology in our lives today in accordance to high population of Indonesia which automatically has the food needs increase. Therefore, it is hoped that this event could give a huge knowledge of Biotechnology especially in GMOs (Genetically Modified Organisms) as an improvement of modern biotechnology itself in which this might be still new to biotechnology in the world. According to the discussion issued by the speakers, GMOs (Genetically Modified Organisms) itself brings benefits from various aspects, both environmental, health, and economic aspects, one of them is that it can reduce the use of pesticides which automatically reduces the use of petroleum and CO<sub>2</sub> gas emission. Besides, the

production costs lower compared to the conventional one, and so much faster in producing high quality of food. In Indonesia, it is also safe to be implemented including feed, food, environmental safety, and halal compliance because the GMO products must pass various stages of feasibility testing before being circulated in the wider community.

To support this technology, in Unhas, biotechnology research at the Faculty of Forestry is encouragingly issued by providing Biotechnology & Tree Breeding Laboratory beyond 3 main activities in it namely tissue culture, genetic analysis, and microbiology. And nowadays, The Biotechnology & Tree Breeding Laboratory often collaborates with various government & private institutions, both domestic and foreign. One collaboration that is still ongoing today is with South China Limestone Plants Research China, South China Agricultural University. In addition, there are still many studies that are ongoing (on going), including DNA Barcoding for Endemic Wallacea, Metabarcoding for Microbe, and Genetic Diversity for Conservation.



## FACULTY OF AGRICULTURE OF UNHAS HELD AN INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON FOOD SECURITY & SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURAL IN THE TROPICS (FSSAT) 2019



Faculty of Agriculture of Universitas Hasanuddin held an International Conference entitled “The 2nd International Conference on Food Security and Sustainable Agricultural in the Tropics (IC-FSSAT) 2019”. This second international conference proposed a theme of “Developing and Improving Sustainable Agricultural Practices: An attempt to Achieve Food Security and to Mitigate Climate Crisis in the Tropics”. The opening ceremony took place at Swiss-Bel Hotel, Makassar on Monday, September 2, 2019.

The event invited two keynote speakers, Dr. Ir. Kasdi Subagyo, M.Sc, (General Director of Forestry as a representative of the Ministry of Agrarian Affairs of Indonesia) and Mr. Guo-Jhong Moh (Taiwan International Cooperation and Development Fund). Several speakers were also invited to this conference; Peter Mc. Mahon (University of Sidney, Australia), Masahiro Mii (University of Chiba, Japan), Bustanul

Arifin (Universitas Lampung, Indonesia), Ambo Ala (Universitas Hasanuddin, Indonesia), dan Silke Stober (University of Humboldt, Germany).

The International Conference on FSSAT 2019 was opened by the Rector of Hasanuddin University, Prof. Dr. Dwia Aries Tina Pulubuhu, MA. In her opening speech, she hoped that this event can be a milestone to enhance the sustainable agricultural practices to achieve food security & climate change crisis in the tropics.

On the same occasion, Prof. Dr. Agr. Ir. Baharuddin as the Dean of the Faculty of Agriculture hoped that there will be new knowledge and exchange of new ideas during this conference. The ultimate goal of this conference is how research results from the Faculty of Agriculture related to food security issues and sustainable agriculture in tropical regions can be published to the public.

## UNHAS' STUDENTS WON 2ND PLACE IN ASIAN LEVEL ENGLISH DEBATE CONTEST



Muh. Firmansyah Walenna (student of the Department of Management of the Faculty of Economics & Business) & Nurmuliasneny Musa (a student of the Department of Psychology at the Faculty of Medicine) won 2d place in the Asian English Debate Competition.

Member of the Student Activity Unit (UKM) English Debate (DBI) joined the Asian British Parliamentary (ABP) competition in Yogyakarta, (29/8 - 5/9). ABP is the most prestigious Asian level English debate competition for the British Parliamentary format. This competition is under the world level English debate competition, the WUDC (World Universities Debate Championship). The activity was attended by 11 countries, namely: Indonesia, Malaysia, Indonesia, China, Korea, Singapore, Hong Kong, the Philippines, Bangladesh, Japan, and Thailand. As many as 77 participating teams participated in this competition.

The team from Unhas entered the grand final with Atma Jakarta, University of Indonesia, and Keio University in Japan. At the end of the competition, Atma Jakarta won first place, while Unhas, UI, and Keio University Japan won the Co-Grandfinalist or joint 2-place winner.

In addition to winning 2nd place, Firmansyah was also ranked as the 10th best speaker in the category of English as Foreign Language (EFL) at the Asian level. Firmansyah also shared his strategy when competing. He explained, the Unhas team focused on knowing the latest issues in detail. Starting from

the background of the event, and know how to solve it. "For example, the issue of the Amazon forest burning debate and Brazil's handling of the problem and the issue of West Papua separatism in Indonesia," he explained. Firman hopes that the results obtained can be an initiative for Unhas to be more active in participating in international competitions. "Hopefully we get full support from the Unhas, both morally and in funds so that we can provide better performance as well," he continued.

Responding to the achievements of the students, the Vice Rector for Student Affairs and Alumni Unhas, Prof. Dr. Drg Arsunan Arsin MKes said, this achievement was not only the pride of Hasanuddin University students, but also all the people of South Sulawesi in the Asian arena. "We will continue to pay attention to students who excel, and for those who take part in the competition and get a gold, silver and bronze medal" explained Prof. Arsunan.



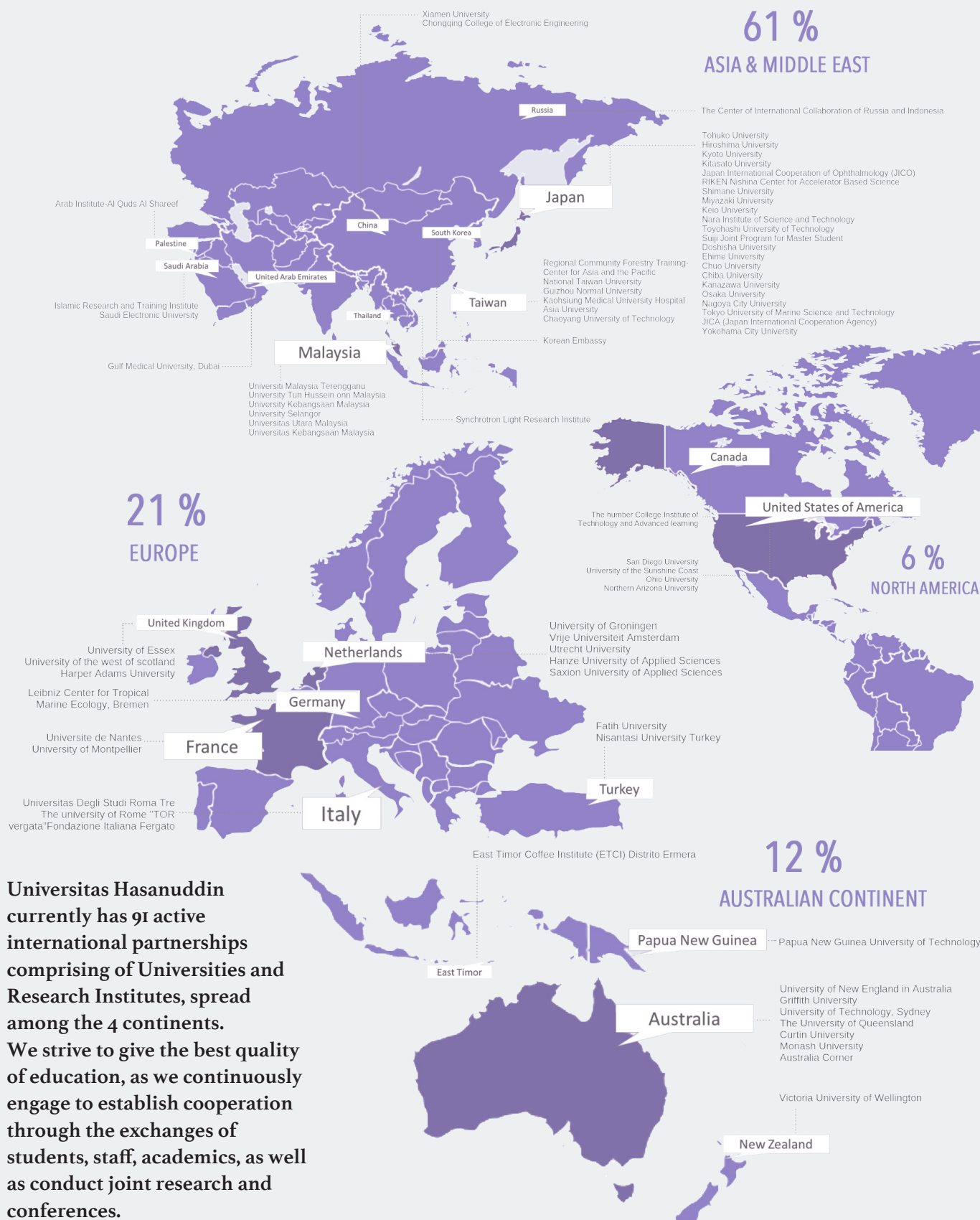
