Rector of Universitas Hasanuddin, Prof. Dr. Dwia Aries Tina Pulubuhu, MA., attended the policy dialogue activity organized by The Australia-Indonesia Center (AIC). Dialogue that discussed several agendas regarding transportation, commodities, and opportunities for people who live along the Makassar-Parepare Railroad. The event took place at the Melia Hotel, Makassar, Wednesday (05/02).

Also present was the Australian Consul General in Makassar (Richard Mathews), Economic and Investment Advisor in the Ministry of Transportation of the Republic of Indonesia (Prof. Wihana Kirana Jaya), the South Sulawesi Development Acceleration Team, the Regional Development Planning Agency, representatives of the Australian Government, and researchers from Indonesia and Australia is part of the Partnership of Australia - Indonesia Research (PAIR).

In her remarks, Prof. Dr. Dwia Aries Tina Pulubuhu, MA said that AIC regularly strengthens bilateral relations between Indonesia and Australia in various aspects of development such as economic, industrial and the relationship between academics. PAIR is a program that tries to connect between Indonesian and Australian researchers

in answering various development issues. At present, PAIR is focusing on the construction of the Makassar-Parepare Railroad.

After opening, the event continued by listening to the presentation of material from several speakers with different backgrounds. The activity which presented approximately 80 participants from the delegation of Indonesian and Australian researchers, the Government, and the South Sulawesi Development Acceleration Team took place until 4pm.

UNHAS through the Center of Excellence for Interdisciplinary and Sustainability Science (CEISS) Graduate School once again held a Graduate Seminar Series with the theme “The Science, Policy, and Economics of Carbon Farming in the Asia-Pacific Region”. The activity was attended by Dr. Sebastian Thomas, Senior Researcher of the Australia-Indonesia Center (AIC) / PAIR and lecturer at the University of Melbourne. It took place in the Hall of Prof. Fachruddin, Graduate School of Unhas on Monday.

On this occasion, Dr. Thomas explained several discussion topics which are Science of Carbon, Carbon in Policy, Economic of Carbon, Aboriginal Firestick Farming, and Blue Carbon in The Asia-Pacific. The concept of carbon economics or carbonomics will be important in the future. Carbonomics puts carbon calculations into a tool to encourage environmental sustainability and save the

earth from the threat of climate change impacts that have been widely felt today. Carbon economy can encourage environmental sustainability because it does not use a lot of energy sources that emit carbon dioxide, so this can reduce the effect of greenhouse gases into the biosphere while reducing the impact of global warming.

On the same occasion, Dr. Sudirman Nasir, who is also the Director of CEISS Unhas emphasized that in solving environmental problems, studies from various other disciplines are needed. As an interdisciplinary center of excellence & sustainability, CEISS will continue to encourage interdisciplinary knowledge exchange and collaboration at Unhas. Universitas Hasanuddin through the Faculty of Dentistry (FKG) held a Guest Lecture which presented presenters from Australia. Assoc. Prof. Peter J. Anderson, DSc., DDSc., MD, Ph.D., M.Surg. Ed. This speaker is a lecturer at the Faculty of Public Health, University of Adelaide, Australia. And also, another speaker is from Malaysia, Prof. Dr. Sabri Musa. The speaker was the Dean of the Faculty of Dentistry at Universiti Malaya, Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia on Wednesday 19/02.

Prof. Peter brought material entitled "What is Craniofacial Surgery?". In his explanation, Prof. Peter said that craniofacial surgery is one of the surgical procedures that focus on the head and facial bones. Meanwhile, Prof. Sabri brought material entitled "An Update on Restorative in Pediatric Dentistry", which discussed the profession of a pediatric dentist. Human teeth undergo major changes from infancy to adolescence.



On this occasion, Prof. Peter invited the participants to express their opinions on some of the cases presented. In addition, he showed many videos of craniofacial surgical procedures. On the other hand, besides describing Pediatric Dentistry, Prof. Sabri also gave some restoration material developments that are currently widely used in the field of pediatric dentistry.

UNHAS, AIC, AND AUSTRALIAN MEDIA DISCUSS SOUTH SULAWESI AND AUSTRALIA'S AGRICULTURAL COOPERATION

In the activity, Prof. Jamaluddin Jompa, Ph.D., as the Dean of the Postgraduate School of Universitas Hasanuddin welcomed the PAIR program, where the program was interdisciplinary by the development of science at the Postgraduate School of Universitas Hasanuddin. He said Makassar and

Australia have a close relationship related to history therefore that it is expected to be the initial foundation for developing collaboration.

The Australian Consul General in Makassar, Richard Mathews said that the PAIR program was expected to produce useful policy formulations as a reference for the government. Several researchers at Universitas Hasanuddin also provided an overview of research development in the field of research and marine science, such as Dr. Rita Rukminasari, Ph.D., and Dr. Muhammad Junaid. Dr. Rita Rukminasari, Ph.D., as a researcher at the Center of Excellence for Development and Utilization of Seaweed (CEDUS) explained about "Seaweed at South Sulawesi: Research

and Opportunity” where seaweed is currently one of the promising business potentials in South Sulawesi thus requiring a research center that intensively studies seaweed and provides training for business people.

Dr. Muhammad Junaid explained “Main Agricultural Commodities: Challenges and Opportunities” in which the Indonesian economy grew very well and the biggest contribution was made by agriculture.

THE EXPERT FROM AMSTERDAM DELIVERED LECTURE ON STEM CELL IN THE FACULTY OF DENTISTRY OF UNHAS



Faculty of Dentistry conducted guest lectures that present expert from Amsterdam, Dr. Marco N. Helder, Ph.D. He is a lecture from the Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery, Vrije Universteit (VU) Medical Center Amsterdam, Netherlands. This guest lecturer took place at the Auditorium of Halima Dg Sikati, Unhas Dental Hospital, Kandeja Street, Makassar, on Thursday (20/02). The public lecture attended by approximately 100 participants from the Faculty of Dentistry students and young doctors of Unhas Dental Hospital.

The title of the Lecture was “Stem Cell and Regenerative Medicine for Tissue Repair”, discussed the Adipose Stem Cell and 3D Printing Univision Lab which has been developed by VU Medical University in Amsterdam.

Adipose Stem Cells (ASCs) are a type of mesenchymal stem cell that has the potential for differentiation in adipose tissue. This stem source cell is used to repair and regenerate damaged, acute, and chronic tissue. Adipose Stem Cells can be used in valve conditions, trauma, and oncology

patients. “In recent years, ASCs have become a focus of regenerative medicine because it has an important role in tissue regeneration engineering,” explained Dr. Marco.

Furthermore, Dr. Marco also explained the collaborative research conducted with Unhas about the use of Adipose Stem cells combined with Calcium phosphate to close the defects in patients with cleft lip and palate.

Before presenting the material, Dr. Marco first followed the operation conducted in the operating room of Unhas Dental Hospital for gnatoschizis patient (a congenital abnormality in which gaps in the lips or the ceiling formed) using bonggraph combined with stem cells.

The participants followed the material presented by Dr. Marco enthusiastically. Most of the participants asked questions or their points of view about the lecture.

UNHAS DISCUSSED SUSTAINABLE SCIENCE WITH AUSTRALIAN EXPERTS



Universitas Hasanuddin through the Center of Excellence for Interdisciplinary and Sustainability Science, the Postgraduate School held a seminar series on the topic “Identifying Research Topic and Developing Research Proposals for Research Grant on Sustainability Issues / Science”, presented by Dr. Sebastian Thomas from The University of Melbourne. This meeting took place in the Dean Meeting Room, Postgraduate School of Universitas Hasanuddin, Tamalanrea Campus and was attended by Postgraduate School academics. In the activity, Thomas delivered several issues related to sustainability science, designing research proposals and the impact of sustainable science. Sustainability science is a study that focuses on developing inter-disciplinary & transdisciplinary

environmental and scientific studies. This study considers the future of humanity and civilization as a process determined today, so science should dedicate itself to sustainability. Also, to develop this study, some basic abilities are needed, such as thinking system, anticipating ability, normative ability, strategic thinking, and interpersonal skills.

During the presentation, Thomas and the participants shared ideas and research ideas that could or were being conducted. Every scientist can consistently research according to the field of study / respective fields of science, but still, pay attention to aspects of sustainability in the process and analysis.

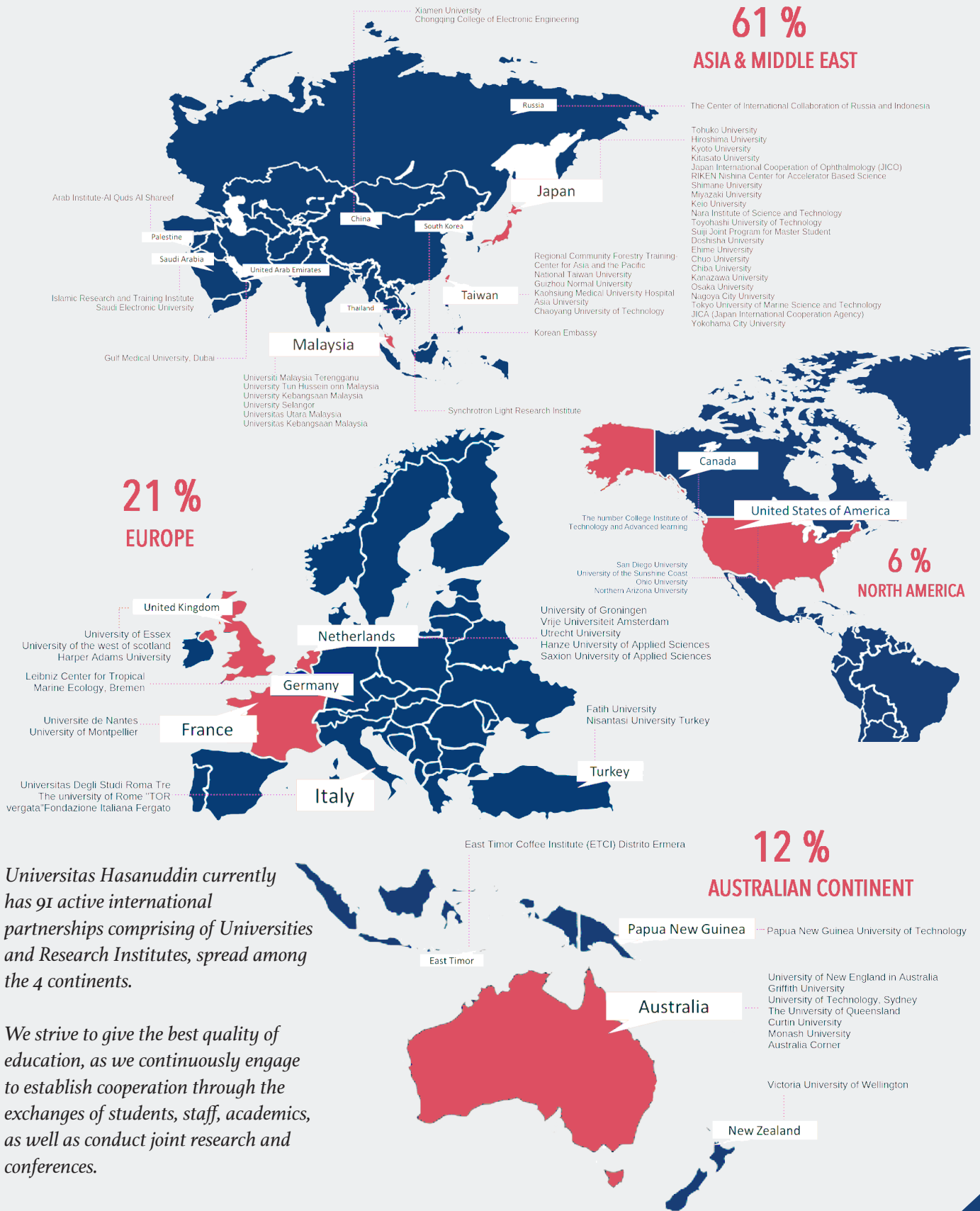
