

MEETING WITH PROF. DWIA, SIDNEY JONES DISCUSSED ABDUCTION IN THE SULU SEA AGAINST INDONESIAN CITIZENS FROM BUTON

The chair of the Institute for Policy Analysis of Conflict (IPAC), Sidney Jones, who is also an expert and researcher on terrorism in Southeast Asia, visited the Unhas Rector, Prof. Dr. Dwia Aries Tina Pulubuhu, MA. This visit was intended to discuss the abduction in the Sulu Sea, Philippines, which befell an Indonesian citizen (WNI) from Buton. This discussion was also attended by Anthropologist Unhas (Dr. Tasrifin Tahara, M.Sc) and Vice-Rector for Planning, Finance, and Resources (Prof. Ir. Sumbangan Baja, M.Phill, Ph.D.).

Sidney Jones explained that the abduction of Indonesian citizens, especially the citizens of Buton and Wakatobi, was not an issue in Indonesia. However, "This incident should be considered even more serious, it is fitting that three countries (Indonesia, the Philippines, and Malaysia) sit together and discuss the subject matter and how it is resolved," said Sidney. The Government of Indonesia, Philippines, and Malaysia themselves have signed the Trilateral Maritime Patrol (TMP) in 2017, which is an agreement among the 3 countries that will patrol in the border waters of the three countries (Sabah and Sulu Sea).

As a higher education institution that must contribute to society, it is fitting for Unhas to take a role in solving this problem. Prof. Dwia emphasized the readiness of Unhas to facilitate both dialogue and discussion that presents social science experts in the field of conflict resolution. In addition to experts, in this dialogue, it is necessary to invite native figures who understand well and have closeness, both geographically and emotionally. The results of this dialogue and discussion will later be given to the government as consideration for the preparation of the strategy.

Tasrifin Tahara, researcher and Anthropologist Unhas who also came from Buton, felt he had moral responsibility and emotional closeness in this international abduction case. The researcher who concentrated on the maritime shipping tradition admitted that this problem which if it will be published later can become a reference for various parties.

STUDENTS AND YOUNG LECTURERS OF FACULTY OF DENTISTRY OF UNHAS JOINED SAKURAN AND ODAPUS PROGRAM IN JAPAN

Sakura and Odapus Program are the annual programs of the Faculty of Dentistry of Unhas. Unhas annually dispatches their lecturers and students as a part of the exchange program with Okayama University, Japan. Dean of Faculty of Dentistry of Unhas, drg. Muhammad Ruslin, M. Kes, Ph.D.,

Sp.BM (K) said that this program was very positive for students to observe the education system and student life in Japan. Thus, students and lecturers who participate in the program are expected to gain broader insights and have a global perspective. Furthermore, the programs provided opportunities for young Unhas lecturers who wished to continue their education abroad. For this reason, outbound lecturer programs are available which are hosted by the Japan Science and Technology Agency through the Sakura Program.

The event coordinator, drg. Acing Habibie Mude, PhD. added that while attending the program at Okayama University, our lecturers and students will join other lecturers and students from various countries such as Brazil and Vietnam.

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THE 171ST ASSESSMENT, AUN-QA VISITED UNHAS



ASEAN University Network-Quality
Assurance (AUN-QA) visited Universitas
Hasanuddin to assess the 4 study programs,
Accountant (Faculty of Economics and
Business), English Literature (Faculty of
Cultural Sciences), Agrotechnology (Faculty
of Agriculture), Science of Nutrition
(Faculty of Public Health). This assessment
is the 171st event that had been held by
AUN-QA, meanwhile, this assessment is
the 6th time for Unhas to be visited and
assessed. The visitation held on
7-9 January 2020.

At the end of the visitation, each assessor presented their result for each study

program, where all of them has the excellences also points that need to be developed, or in AUN-QA called as "area of improvement". After that, the assessor will give recommendations to the study program to be followed up to improve and maintain the academic quality of each study program based on the standard criteria.

Until now, as much as 17 study programs in Unhas had qualified to the AUN-QA standard, and for 2020, Unhas is preparing for the visitation for four study programs in the upcoming November.

CONSISTENT IN SUPPORTING WCU, FKG UNHAS PRESENTS INTERNATIONAL SPEAKERS



The Faculty of Dentistry (FKG) of Unhas held two Public Lectures which presented speakers from Taiwan, Prof. Lun-Jou Lo MD and Prof. Lih-Jyh Fuh, D.D.S., Ph.D., F.I.C.D. The first guest speaker is affiliated with the Department of Plastic Surgery, Chang Gung Hospital, Chang Gung University, Taoyuan, Taiwan, and the second speaker is affiliated with the Faculty of Dentistry, China Medical University, Taiwan. The first public lecture took place in the Molar Room, FKG UNHAS, Tamalanrea Campus, Makassar, Monday (06/01). While the second public lecture took place on Friday (10/01)

Prof. Lun-Jou discussed the big topic of "Plastic and Reconstructive Surgery; especially jaw reconstruction ". At the beginning of his presentation, Prof. Lun-Jou introduced several surgical divisions at Chang Gung Memorial Hospital, Taipei. He also explained the various types of cases that have been done with his team, ranging from cleft/lip palate surgery, aesthetic surgery, craniomaxillofacial surgery, orthognathic surgery, to facial contouring surgery.

"Cosmetic and reconstructive surgery are very common surgical procedures performed at Chang Gung Memorial Hospital. There is a special satisfaction after operating the procedure and seeing patients who experience changes in physical appearance dramatically so that it can increase their confidence which indirectly affects the personal lives of the patients themselves, "said Prof. Lun-Jou

On the other hand, Prof. Lih-Jyh Fuh, D.D.S., Ph.D., F.I.C.D discussed two major topics namely "Conventional Versus Digital Workout in Prosthodontics" and "Implant Retained FRD for Large Bony Defect Patients Rethinking". Prof. Fuh explained, among others, the process of making dentures that are done conventionally and by using modern technology."In the mechanism of prosthodontic action to avoid errors or process errors, one of the supporting factors that need to be considered is when selecting the material or material used," said Prof. Fuh

Dean of FKG Unhas, drg. Muhammad Ruslin, M. Kes., Ph.D., SP. BM (K) said that aside from being FKG's efforts to support Unhas as a World Class University (WCU). These lectures also become one of the effective learning media that is useful for updating student scientific information.


The Dean of the Faculty of Law Unhas explained that the purpose of the delegation's visit was to continue the cooperative


