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DEPARTMENT OF JAPANESE LITERATURE HELD INDONESIA-JAPAN MICROHISTORY WEBINAR



Japanese Literature Department, Faculty of Cultural Sciences (FIB) Universitas Hasanuddin in collaboration with FIB Diponegoro University and Gadjah Mada University held a webinar under the theme of "Indonesia-Japan Microhistory".

This webinar took place at 14.00 WITA virtually through the Zoom meeting application on Tuesday (25/08) which was attended by approximately 300 participants and presented two speakers, namely Prof. Kurasawa Airo (Professor at Emeritus Keio University) and Dr. Agus Suwignyo, M.A (Lecturer at the Department of History, Faculty of Cultural Sciences UGM).

Microhistory is an approach to historical study that was first developed by Giovanni Levi, a historian in the 1970s. This approach focuses on one event and one character which does not emphasize the scale, but considers it as a

window to see broader things such as mentality, beliefs, and family systems to social relations in the countryside as a reaction to history upon big concepts.

In the presentation session from the speakers, Prof. Kurasawa Airo started the material related to "A Story of a Stateless Woman in Indonesia: Hide Miwa", then continued with the second presentation by Dr. Agus regarding "Japan-Indonesia Microhistory: Seeing Ordinary Things as Ordinary, But Full of Meaning".

The activity lead by Dias Pradadimara, M.A. (Lecturer, Department of History, Faculty of Cultural Sciences, Universitas Hasanuddin) as a moderator aims to provide an overview of the local history of the relationship between Indonesia and Japan.

THE CIVIL ENGINEERING STUDY PROGRAM AND THE ELECTRICAL STUDY PROGRAM AT THE ENGINEERING FACULTY HAVE BEEN DECLARED ACCREDITED FROM ABET



After a visitation conducted in November 2019, two study programs at The Faculty of Engineering, namely: The Civil Engineering Study Program and The Electrical Engineering Study Program were declared to have met the accreditation requirements to hold accredited status from the Accreditation Board of Engineering and Technology (ABET).

The Dean of Engineering Faculty, Prof. Muhammad Arsyad Thaha, stated that the two study programs have been declared accredited until December 2022. To obtain the fully accredited status, both study programs should complete several documents until July 2021.

The Head of the Unhas Education Quality Assurance and Development Institute (LPMPP), Budi Prastawa, explained that ABET has a high reputation and very prestigious. Therefore, even though the study programs are accredited with requirements, it is not easy to achieve it. Even experience in Indonesia, not a single tertiary institution has received full accreditation from ABET without requirements.

The acquisition of ABET accreditation made Unhas academics aware of the importance of a quality culture. The accreditation illustrates that the continuous improvement of quality culture is important and strategic if a study program wants to get international accreditation or certification.

Rector of Universitas Hasanuddin, Prof. Dr. Dwia Aries Tina Pulubuhu, MA, warmly welcomed and gave appreciation to all parties involved in preparing for the accreditation.

"We are committed to the continuous improvement of quality culture. This achievement is clear evidence that Unhas has carried out a development strategy in accordance with the principle of continuous quality improvement. I congratulate the Faculty of Engineering, especially to the Civil Engineering and Electrical Engineering Study Programs, ", said Rector of Unhas.

The activity was held in collaboration with the Indonesia Mathematical Society, the Indonesian Physics Association, the Indonesian Geophysicists Association, the Indonesian Chemical Association and the Indonesian Biology Consortium.

The conference was conducted in 2 days straight, on August 22 - 23, 2020, through the Zoom meeting application and live streaming on Unhas youtube channel.


Prof. Jamaluddin Jompa, Ph.D. (Dean of the Unhas Postgraduate School), Prof. Alexander V. Babanim (Professor of Ocean Engineering, University of Melbourne, Australia), Prof. Jan Leendert Nouwen (Medical Center of Erasmus University, Netherlands),

and Prof. Ulrike Lindequist (University Greifswald, Germany) were invited as main speakers.

In the opening ceremony, The Chair of the ICOS 2020 Committee, Prof. Dr. Moh. Ivan Aziz, M.Sc., explained that the 4th ICOS invited speakers who had international reputations with an amazing number of citations. Since the first ICOS in 2014, as many as 71 submitted papers were published in the proceedings, while the second ICOS in 2017 had 97 papers. In the third ICOS, 260 papers were collected, and in this year ICOS, the committee received 420 papers to be presented virtually. The presented, referenced, and accepted papers will be published in the Journal of Physics: Conference Series (JSPS) published by IOP. The JSPS is listed as a Q3 publication in Schimago.




