

AUSTRALIA-INDONESIA CENTER AND UNVERSITAS HASANUDDIN CONDUCTED AN INTERNATIONAL WEBINAR PRESENTING NOBEL PRIZE WINNER

The Partnership for Australia-Indonesia Research (PAIR), in collaboration with the Australia Indonesia Center (AIC) and Universitas Hasanuddin (Unhas), held a two-hour inspirational webinar, which discussed the role of science in tackling Covid-19.

The webinar started at II.00 WITA, on Tuesday (22/9) and carried out virtually through the zoom meeting application. The themes discussed were "Nobel Laureate Talks on the Importance of Science in Covid-19: Discussing Covid-19 Through Interdisciplinary Approach" and "Nobel Was Born in the Archipelago: The Importance of a Scientific Personality."

The first session of the webinar was delivered in English and by a phenomenal resource person, Prof. Peter Doherty AC, the Nobel Prize Winner in Medicine in 1996. Prof. Doherty is a patron of the Doherty Institute and Immunologist, Australia.

Bahasa by Prof. Sangkot Marzuki, AM., (Director of the Eijkman Institute) and Prof. Irawan Yusuf (Member of Indonesian Academic Sciences, who is also a professor of medicine at Unhas).

Starting the activity, The Rector of Unhas, Prof. Dr. Dwia Aries Tina Pulubuhu, MA., expressed her gratitude for Prof. Peter's willingness to provide views and ideas about Covid-19, which has had an impact on all aspects of human life.

The Covid-19 pandemic is a challenge for scientists. Until now, efforts to deal with this outbreak have been continuously carried out, starting from research development to social strengthening.

"Covid-19 does not only involve one scientific discipline. Collaboration is needed to provide solutions that are expected to answer the current nation's challenges. We hope that this discussion will

provide a clear view of the complexity of the Covid-19 problem," explained Prof. Dwia.

Laureate Professor Peter Doherty AC gave a view regarding the Covid-19 in the field of immunology. According to this Noble Prize Winner, handling Covid-19 requires many elements and requires proper handling by taking a scientific approach as a basis.

The activity that was part of the 64th Anniversary of Unhas and supported by the Indonesian Youth Academy of Sciences (Akademi Ilmu Pengetahuan Muda Indonesia/ALMI) and the Australian Alumni Association in Indonesia, South Sulawesi Chapter (Ikatan Alumni Australia/IKAMA) went on smoothly until the end of the event at 13.00 WITA



The webinars of study opportunities and scholarships to the UK were conducted in collaboration between the Directorate of Alumni and Career Preparation (DAPK) Universitas Hasanuddin (Unhas) and the British Council.

Four speakers were presented in this webinar; Raras Tulandaru (Network and Alumni Officer of British Embassy Jakarta), Nursidah, S.Sos (Chevening Awardee 2020), Rowena Rompas (Chevening Scholarship and Alumni Coordinator British Embassy Jakarta), and Yuli Vega (Marketing Officer Study UK).

The Director of DAPK Unhas, Dr. Abdullah Sanusi, said that this activity aims to provide information to students on how to get a scholarship to England and as a forum to build good relations between UNHAS alumni who have also studied in England.

Rowena Rompas explained that the Chevening scholarship is one of the scholarships that have a very broad scope and has existed in 160 countries in the world, including Indonesia. Candidates who are looked for this scholarship are people who have ambition and strong interpersonal skills. And through this scholarship, it is hoped that the awardee of this scholarship can occupy good positions in various companies in Indonesia. Furthermore, Raras Tulandaru provided tips and tricks in writing essays using the STAR method which stands for Situation, Task (Your Role), Action (What & How You Did), and Result. The webinar held by DAPK is expected to provide space for new Unhas students and alumni who wish to continue their education and seek scholarships.


In the first session with the topic of Youth Nutrition, dr. Hasto Wardoyo, Sp.OG (K), the Head of BKKBN, said that to achieve superior Indonesian human resources, the problem of stunting must be overcome. "Stunting is not a single problem, but there are still many nutritional problems behind it, one of which is a pregnancy that occurs at a young age," he explained.

Lenny N. Rosalin, SE, M.Sc., M.Fin Deputy for Child Development, Ministry of Women Empowerment and Child Protection as Keynote Speaker in the second session said that the role of breastfeeding is very important for the growth and development of children because toddlers who are not given exclusive breastfeeding from birth will have a risk of stunting by 4.8 times compared to toddlers who are given exclusive breastfeeding from birth.

UNIVERSITAS HASANUDIN CONDUCTED INTERNATIONAL WEBINAR DISCUSSING THE MITIGATION OF COVID-19 IN AUSTRALIA & JAPAN



Universitas Hasanuddin in collaboration with The Australia-Indonesia Center (AIC) established an international webinar with the theme "Covid-19: Lesson Learned from Australia and Japan" as a part of the 64th Anniversary of Unhas through the zoom meeting application and live streaming on the Faculty of Public Health of Unhas youtube channel on Thursday (16/09). The webinar presented three experts from respective countries to share knowledge and insight in handling the Covid-19.

The first topic was delivered by Prof. Anu Rammohan (AIC Senior and Dean of the Faculty of Arts, Business, Law and Education, Western University, Australia) who explained about "Australia's Covid-19 Experience". He stated that the Covid-19 is a big shock for the global community and affects many aspects of life, not only health, but also the tourism, arts, entertainment, and economy sectors. On the same occasion, Prof. Takuro Furusawa (Kyoto University, Japan) as the second spaker presented a topic on "Science, Policy, and Society of Japan Under the

Covid-19 Pandemic". He outlined the Japanese government's policies on the Covid-19 outbreak, for example, appealing citizens to stay at home, ordering companies to allow employee work from home, closing restaurants, and only allowing delivery food services. The last presentation was delivered by Sudirman Nasir, Ph.D with a topic regarding the handling of Covid-19 in Indonesia. He explained policies taken to prevent the transmission spread along the regions and villages.

Prof. dr. Nasrum Massi, Ph.D., (Vice-Rector for Research, Innovation, and Partnership), in his closing remarks, appreciated the webinar which provides information and descriptions related to the efforts of each country to overcome the pandemic problem. He expected Unhas, Japan, and Australia can enhance joint collaboration to discuss the handling of Covid-19 or other issues which are expected to produce scientific articles.


