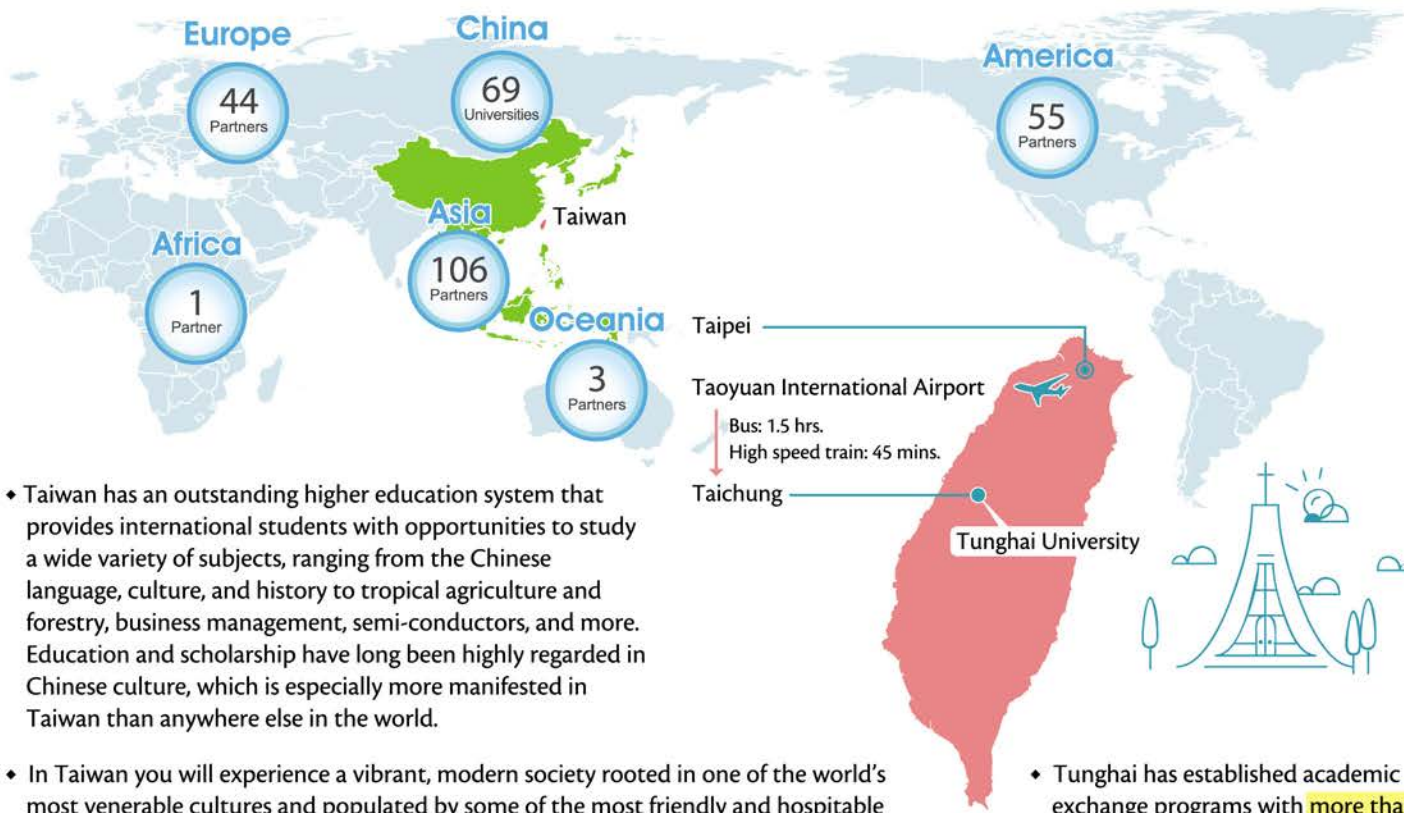

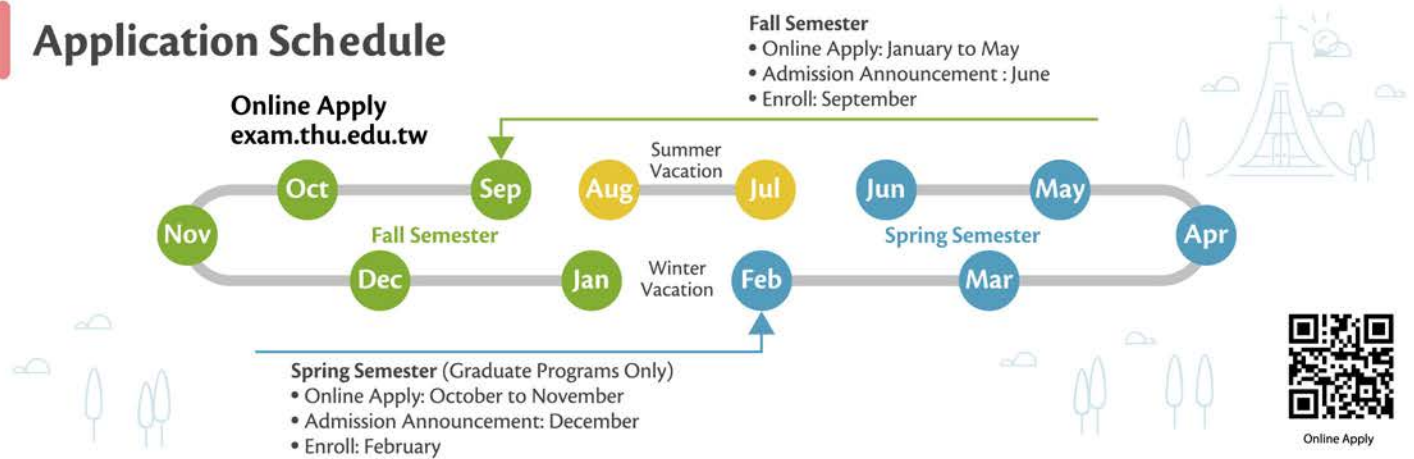

- A financial statement

- Study plan
- Autobiography
- Additional requirements by the intended department
- Other referential documents

## Accommodation

- \* Tunghai University offers over 6,000 beds in on-campus dormitories.
- \* First-year students are guaranteed on-campus accommodation.
- \* A standard room accommodates four students and is furnished with beds, desks, closets, bookshelves and chairs. Bathrooms are shared.
- \* Facilities include Laundromat, kitchen, living room, and Internet access.
- \* Special rooms are available for disabled students.
- \* Tunghai Off-Campus Housing Service Center provides assistance to students who need to look for off-campus accommodation.
