

UNHAS HOST THE 2021 ICMR INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE

The Faculty of Social and Political Sciences, Universitas Hasanuddin University (Unhas), hosted an international conference entitled "International Conference on Multi-disciplinary Research (ICMR) with the theme "Implementing Knowledge and Research on Humanity and Environmental Sustainability ".

The activity started at 08.00 WITA virtually through the zoom meeting application (16/01).

ICMR is an annual event jointly organized by the Distance Education School (SDE) of the University Sains Malaysia (USM), the Islamic University of North Sumatra (UISU) Indonesia, the University of Syiah Kuala (Unsyiah) Indonesia, and Hasanuddin University (Unhas) which aims to share research results in various fields in order to enhance a culture of research and collaboration between scholars and researchers both regionally and internationally.


This activity begins with a report from the chairman of the committee Muh. Nasir Badu and continued by the official opening by the Unhas Rector, Prof. Dr. Dwia Aries Tina Pulubuhu, MA.

This activity resulted in 156 papers which would be presented by dividing the participants into several room zooms and later the papers would go through a review process to be published in a Scopus indexed journal.

The 2021 ICMR is scheduled to last until 17 January.

COLLABORATION BETWEEN UNHAS AND YOKOHAMA CITY UNIVERSITY ON SAKURA SCIENCE ONLINE EXCHANGE PROGRAM



The Faculty of Nursing Universitas Hasanuddin in collaboration with the Nursing Department, Yokohama City University opened the Sakura Science Online Exchange program on Tuesday, 19 January 2021. The activity was scheduled to last for three days and was held virtually through the Zoom meeting application.

The Vice Dean for Student Affairs and Alumni of the Faculty of Nursing Unhas, Syahrul Said, S.Kep., NS., M.Kes., Ph.D., explained that this program aims to share knowledge, research, and nursing experiences between the two universities, especially on the topic of nursing in patients with dysphagia. Syahrul also mentioned that this activity was originally planned to be held in Yokohama.

There were 20 students as participants, 3 lecturers as facilitators, and 1 lecturer as resource persons. However, because of the Covid-19 pandemic situation, the process has switched to online.

Syahrul also explained that through this program, students can gain experience at an international level program. Students can interact with lecturers and other students from other countries as well as getting new knowledge. For lecturers, Syahrul added, it can help the process of identifying potential research topics that can increase joint research activities.

The Dean of the Faculty of Nursing Unhas, Dr. Ariyanti Saleh, S.Kp., M. Kes., added that through this program, apart from building international cooperation between universities, it is also a form of supporting Unhas' efforts towards a World Class University. All elements involved are also expected to obtain broader information and knowledge.

Dr. Ariyanti also mentioned that the Faculty of nursing continue to open up opportunities for international cooperation, especially since the Nursing Study programs have been internationally accredited.

The Undergraduate Study Program and the Nursing Professional Study Program have received international accreditation recognition from ASIIN (Akkreditierungsagentur für Studiengänge der Ingenieurwissenschaften, der Informatik, der Naturwissenschaften und der Mathematik) based in Germany. This accreditation was achieved in July 2019.

UNIVERSITAS HASANUDDIN HOSTED A PUBLIC LECTURE IN COLLABORATION WITH THE INDONESIAN EMBASSY IN WASHINGTON, MRPTNI, AND I-4



Faculty of Medicine (FK) of Universitas Hasanuddin acted as a host in organizing a Virtual Public Lecturer (VPL) with the topic “Clinical Research from Bench-to-Bedside” as a part of the People to People Relationship program, the 5th Series Health Science Cluster.

This activity was initiated by the Education and Cultural Attaché of the Embassy of the Republic of Indonesia (KBRI) Washington, together with the Indonesian State University Chancellors Council (MRPTNI) and the USA-Canada International Association of Indonesian Scientists (I-4). The event took place through the zoom meeting application and live on the YouTube Channel of FK Unhas at 10:00 WITA on Friday (29/01).

Rector of Unhas, Prof. Dr. Dwia Aries Tina Pulubuhu, MA, who opened the event, appreciated the presence of expert speakers at this public lecture. She observed that there are many serious problems related to mother and child. Therefore, it needs the latest studies and research as input in the medical field to solve these

problems. Dean of the Faculty of Medicine, Prof. dr. Budu, Sp.M (K), M.Med.Ed., also agreed that the activity is relevant to the field of study of a fairly large department in the Faculty of Medicine, namely obstetrics and gynecology.

Eva Suarthana, MD., Ph.D., (adjunct Professor, Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, McGill University) as the main speaker conveyed that many things related to clinical research, such as, making effective research questions and observational studies by providing several research examples. Eva said clinical research does not only include clinical trials. It also contains various study designs with the main objective of answering clinical questions, in order to improve the quality of patient care. In clinical research, health informatics also has an important role in documenting clinical data.

UNHAS HELD IC-FSSAT TO DISCUSS AGRICULTURAL INNOVATION STRATEGIES IN THE NEW NORMAL ERA



Faculty of Agriculture Universitas Hasanuddin held an international conference entitled “The 3rd International Conference on Food Security and Sustainable Agriculture in the Tropics (IC-FSSAT)”. This 3rd conference series carries the theme “Strategies and Innovations in Agriculture to Ensure Food Security During New Normal and to Mitigate Disaster Impacts”. The conference was held virtually through the Zoom meeting, Friday (08/01).

Present as keynote speakers were the Minister of Agriculture of the Republic of Indonesia, Dr. Syahrul Yasin Limpo, SH., MH, and the Rector of Unhas, Prof. Dr. Dwia Aries Tina Pulubuhu, MA. Also, presents as the resource persons in this conference were: Dr. Ir. Bayu Krisnamurthi, M.Si (IPB, Indonesia), Prof. Dr. Ir. Steel Donation, M.Phil., (Unhas, Indonesia), Prof. Takuya Sugahara (Ehime University, Japan), Dr. Ravindra C. Joshi (CABI, South East Asia), Dr. Lau Wei Hong (University Putra Malaysia, Malaysia) and Moh. Guo-Jhong (ICDF, Taiwan).

This activity also resulted in 383 papers, of which 238 were affiliates of Unhas and 145 were outside Unhas. The complete and checked papers will be published in the Scopus indexed journal and proceedings. Approximately 300 papers will be published in international proceedings indexed by Scopus, according to committee approval and IOP Conference Series: Earth and Environmental Science.

The 2021 FSSAT Conference that was attended by approximately 600 participants from several countries was officially opened by Unhas Rector, Prof. Dr. Dwia Aries Tina Pulubuhu, MA.

In her speech, Prof. Dwia said that Eastern Indonesia has attracted a lot of attention because of its abundant biodiversity. For the last several years, food modernization and its practices have become factors causing environmental changes and have an impact on the food system and local wisdom in the community. She said that this is an ongoing challenge that is necessary to put forward a solid innovation strategy in agriculture to ensure food security to achieve the 2030 sustainable development goals.



In his description, the Minister of Agriculture also maximizes the strengthening of the availability and stability of food prices through accelerating planting in the past dry season, developing farmer markets to cut supply chains, encouraging people not to depend on rice staple food, but expanding options through diversification of local non-rice foods.

On the occasion, Prof. dr. Muh. Nasrum Massi, Ph.D., as the Vice Rector for Research and Innovation, started his explanation by giving an overview of the history of Unhas. 
