



THE 197TH ASSESSMENT, AUN-QA CONDUCTED QUALITY ASSESSMENTS FOR 4 UNHAS STUDY PROGRAMS

The ASEAN University Network Quality Assurance (AUN-QA) conducted a visitation to assess four study programs from three faculties. This was the 197th assessment organized by AUN-QA. The opening of this event began at 08.30 (Eastern Indonesian Time) in limited offline by applying the Covid-19 protocol in Academic Senate Room, the 2nd Floor, Unhas Rectorate Building and connected virtually through the zoom meeting application, Monday (01/02).

Those who also attended the event were the Unhas Rector, Prof. Dr. Dwia Aries Tina Pulubuhu, MA., the Chairperson of Unhas Academic Senate, the Board of Professors, the representatives of the Board of Trustees (MWA), the deputy chancellors and directors, and the deans.

"Unhas continually encourage and empower all study programs to gain international recognition through development programs such as international classes, student and staff exchanges, joint research and publications, and international accreditation," explained Prof. Dwia.

On behalf of AUN-QA, Prof. Dr. Wyona C. Patalinghug (De La Salle University) as the chief assessor. In his speech also said that there had been a change in the assessment process in line with the Covid-19 pandemic. Therefore, it should have

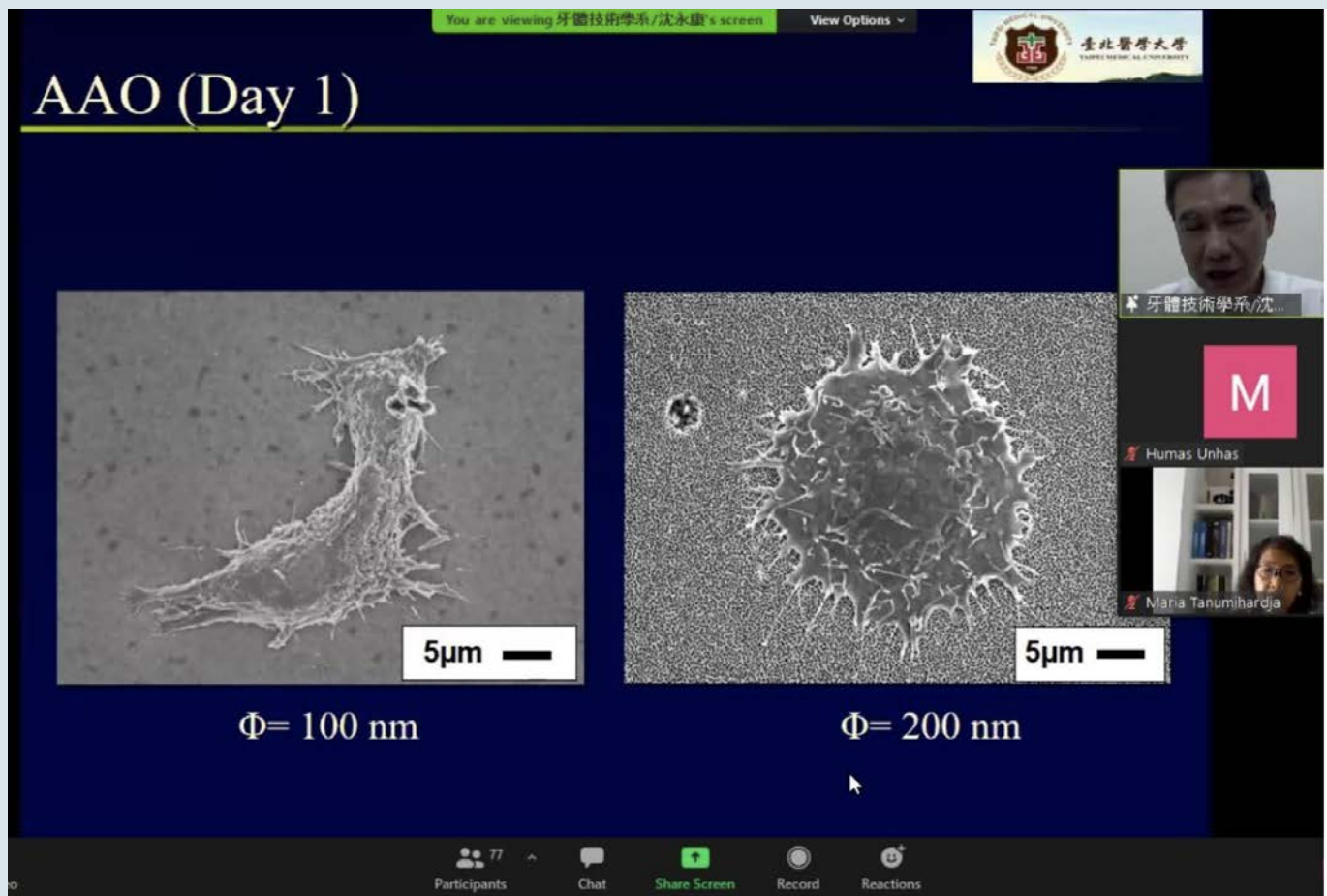
been scheduled in September 2020, but there was a change in the schedule and online assessment mechanism.

TAIWANESE EXPERT IN VIRTUAL INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM OF FACULTY OF DENTISTRY



The Faculty of Dentistry Unhas held a Virtual International Symposium series seven with the theme “New Advance in Dental Biomaterials”.

The speaker who attended was Prof. Yung-Kang Shen (Collage of Oral Medicine School of Dental Technology, Taipei Medical University, Taiwan).

This event was part of a series of 38th Anniversary of Faculty of Dentistry Unhas which took place virtually through the zoom meeting application and live-streaming on the Faculty of Dentistry Unhas youtube channel.

This event began with a speech delivered by the Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs Unhas, Prof. Dr. Ir. Muh. Restu, MP. Then, the event was continued by the presentation of the main speaker, Prof. Yung Kang discussed “The Nano-Topology Influence of The Nanostructure of Biomedical Thin Film on the Behavior of Osteoblast - Like Cell”.

This research was made nanopillars (polylactic acid (PIA) and polycarbonate (PC)) with an AAO template, using nanoimprints, then discussed surface properties and observed osteoblast-like cell behavior.

Based on these studies, Prog Yung Kang showed that cell adhesion and spread could be affected by surface topographic features at the nanometer level.

The conclusion from this research is that nanostructures can behave like osteoblast cells. The significant differences in adhesion and cell proliferation depend on the shape and contact area of the nanostructures. After delivering the material, it was followed by a discussion session.

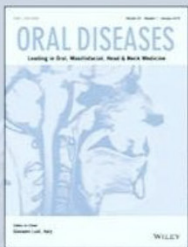





Two Unhas lecturers received The Crispian Scully Research Award 2020 in the category of "The Best Review Article" from the Oral and Dental Research Trust (ODRT), a non-profit organization in the field of dental and oral health research based in Birmingham, England.

The Crispian Scully Research Award is an award given to researchers and authors in the field of oral health all over the world. This award is to remember and honor Prof. (Emeritus) Crispian Scully, CBE, FMedSci, DSc, MD, PhD, MDS, FDS, FRCPath. Throughout his life, Prof. Scully has dedicated himself to the Trustee Board of Domestic Violence and is known as a figure in clinical academics.

The two Unhas lecturers who received this award were dr. Faqi Nurdiansyah Hendra, (Ph.D Candidate - VU University Medical Center Amsterdam) from the Medical Faculty (FK) Unhas and drg. Muhammad Ruslin, M.Kes., Sp.BM (K), Ph.D., from Dentistry Faculty (FKG) Unhas.

The award-winning article is "Global incidence & profile of ameloblastoma: A systematic review and meta-analysis", written collaboratively by Faqi Nurdiansyah Hendra, Ellen M. Van Cann, Marco N. Helder, Muhammad Ruslin, Jan G. de Visscher, Tymour Forouzanfar, and Henrica CW de Vet. The other authors are researchers from VUmc Amsterdam.

In his explanation on Monday (8/2), drg. Muh. Ruslin, Sp.BM (K), Ph.D, said the article was published in the journal Oral Diseases Volume 26 Issue 1 of 2019 with Impact Factor 2,613 (Clarivate Analytics), Wiley Publisher. This article discusses the evaluation of the global incidence of ameloblastoma and to provide a profile of ameloblastoma patients.

One of the advantages of articles written by dr. Faqi and drg. Ruslin is that the study is the first to assess the global incidence of ameloblastoma.

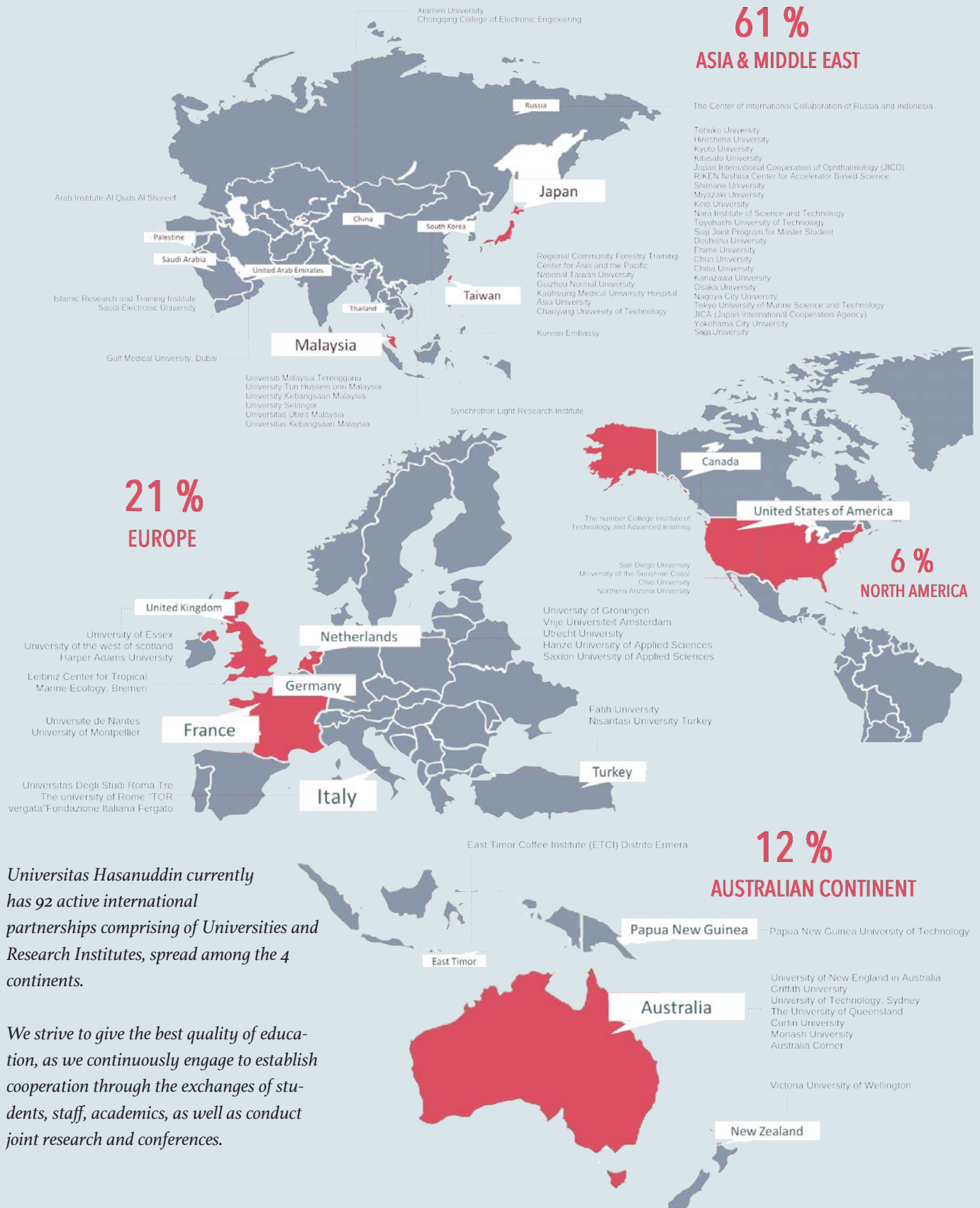
