UNHAS RECORDED SPECTACULAR ACHIEVEMENTS IN THE VERSION OF THE WORLD RANKING

Times Higher Education (THE) annually measures the impact ranking of universities around the world. The result of THE ranking is widely accepted as an indicator of the achievement of a world class university.

One of the thematic rankings presented by THE is measuring how universities in the world adopt the principles of Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). For 2021, THE Impact Ranking involves 1,115 universities from 94 countries and regions.

UNHAS recorded a spectacular achievement in the achievement of THE Impact Ranking for the SDGs theme. In 2020, Unhas has not made it into the ranking list, and this year it has immediately shot to the second position nationally and in the top 79 of the world. This achievement is very encouraging, remembering the complexity of the assessment variables, which cover the 17 SDGs objectives.

ASIIN CONDUCTED QUALITY ASSESSMENT VISITATION FOR FOUR STUDY PROGRAMS AT UNHAS



ASIIN (Akkreditierungsagentur für Studiengänge der Ingenieurwissenschaften, der Informatik, der Naturwissenschaften und der Mathematik) conducted a visitation in order to assess four study programs from two faculties at Hasanuddin University including the Naval Architecture Study Program and the Mechanical Engineering Study Program (Faculty of Engineering), and the Study Program Mathematics and Geophysics Study Program (Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences).

The activities took place at the Academic Senate Room of Hasanuddin University with limited offline implementation of the covid-19 protocol and connected virtually through the google meet application.

The Rector of Hasanuddin University, Prof. Dr. Dwia Aries Tina Pulubuhu, MA, started the meeting by expressing her joy at the assessment process. Furthermore, the quality assessment carried out by ASIIN is in line with Hasanuddin University's strategic objectives in the process of increasing international reputation.

Various efforts have been made such as presenting international classes, student and staff exchanges, joint research and publications, earning credit, and international accreditation. Likewise with this visitation process.

The meeting was continued with a question and answer session from the ASIIN assessors. In general, the assessors gave questions about the learning process and the achievements of Hasanuddin University, especially the contribution to Hasanuddin University policies during the Covid-19 pandemic.

This activity was attended by 11 ASSIN delegates from various universities.

UNHAS AND UNAIR COLLABORATED TO CONDUCT A VIRTUAL INTERNATIONAL SYMPOSIUM



On Saturday, April 17, the Faculty of Dentistry of Universitas Hasanuddin (FoDUH) together with the Faculty of Dentistry of Universitas Airlangga (FoDUA) organized an International symposium series virtually through zoom meeting application. The symposium which took the theme: "Advance Imaging in Dentistry" was officially opened by the Vice Rector for Planning, Finance and Infrastructure of Unhas; Prof. Ir. Sumbangan Baja, M.Phil., Ph.D. In his remarks, he appreciated the existence of the International discussion forum as the result of cooperation between Universitas Hasanuddin and Universitas Airlangga.

"The topic is very interesting for Dentistry students, whose knowledge improves very fast and we hope this activity will contribute in International based research", said Prof. Sumbangan.

He added that FoDUH has given significant contribution to the university and possess an Oral and Dental Hospital. He expected the speakers would someday visit the hospital when the pandemic is over.

There were two speakers in the Symposium: Dr. Priyyanka Sakhavalkar, BDS., MDS., M.Sc (Doktor Student at University of Liverpool/Alder Hey Children's Hospital, Liverpool, United Kingdom) dan Dr. Varun R. Kunte, BDS., MDS (Founder, CEO ARTHROSE Craniofacial Pain & TMJ Centre, Mumbai, India.

Dr. Varun presented "Biometrics in TMD and Disclusion Time Reduction". He explained about biometric technology, by which the connection among TM joints, muscles, and mastication can be measured accurately, giving insight about discs displacement, hyperactive muscles, and abnormal distribution of biting activity. The specific purpose of this new technology is the use of T-Scan and BioEMG.

Afterwards, in his presentation "CBCT-Applications in Dentistry", Dr. Priyanka explained that CBCT has been widely used in orthognathic surgical planning when performing facial orthomorphic surgeries. He added, with the help of advanced software, CBCT facilitates soft tissue visualization to allow post-treatment aesthetic control. After presenting and having discussion session, the symposium which moderated by Drg. Fadhlil Ulum A. Rahman, Sp.RKG and attended by more than 130 participants was closed on 16.30 local time of Makassar.

UNHAS FACULTY OF LAW HELD INTERNATIONAL WEBINAR, PRESENTING RESOURCE SPEAKERS FROM SIX COUNTRIES

INTERNATIONAL GUEST LECTURE SERIES FOR UNHAS PHARMACY STUDENTS



The Faculty of Pharmacy of Hasanuddin University has a routine program which is guest lectures that invite foreign lecturers. This lecture is intended for Pharmacy Faculty students during the 2020/2021 Academic Year lectures. Meetings conducted by foreign lecturers can last between 3 and 5 meetings, and lecturers who come from well-known universities in Japan, Australia and England.

On Wednesday, April 7, 2021, the first lecture was held by Dr. Tim Weil. Dr. Tim Weil is the Deputy Head of School (Undergraduate Strategy) Department of Zoology, The University of Cambridge.

Dr. Tim Weil will give lectures for 4 meetings with different topics in each meeting, namely "Life in Research", "Model Organisms", From One Cell to Many ", and" Tales from Cell Biology ".

Previously, the lecture was delivered by Dr. Robert Kinobe from James Cook University, Australia.

The Head of Unhas Pharmacy Department, Firzan Nainu, M. Biomed.Sc., Ph.D., Apt. explained that one of the objectives


of this foreign lecturer is to strengthen academic collaboration with international institutions so that it will provide academic insight to students.

Moreover, there has been published collaboration with Assoc. Prof. Karryn Johnson (University of Queensland) and Asso. Prof. Takayuki Kuraishi (Kanazawa University) and meanwhile there is exploring the possibility of publication with Dr. Tim Weil (University of Cambridge).

Furthermore, he said that the pandemic condition needs to be dealt with creativity, one of which is by presenting foreign education without having to visit abroad. It is also hoped that students will be motivated to continue their education to well-known campuses abroad.


