



ENLISTED IN THE QS WORLD UNIVERSITY RANKING, UNIVERSITAS HASANUDDIN BECOMES A WORLD-CLASS UNIVERSITY

Universitas Hasanuddin (Unhas) has finally succeeded in being listed in the ranks of world-class universities according to the QS World University Ranking (WUR). Based on QS Top Universities 2022, Unhas is listed in the 1001 – 1200 group.

Unhas has struggled to be listed in the QS WUR ranking for the last four years. So far, the achievements of Unhas have been recorded in the QS Asia University Ranking (AUR), and this is the first time that Unhas has successfully entered the QS WUR.

The most significant component of the QS WUR method was Academic Peer Review, worth 40% of the total score. Over the years, Unhas has met other indicators. However, there are challenges in encouraging global academics to recognize Unhas. This achievement proves that Unhas is on the right track to improve its global reputation.

The achievement in the world ranking of 1001-1200 is a valuable asset to improve our performance continuously. In Indonesia's national level, there are also several universities being listed in the 1001 – 1200 ranking together with Universitas Hasanuddin, including Universitas BINUS, Universitas Diponegoro, Universitas Telkom, and Universitas Brawijaya.

The activity was conducted offline at 16.00 (Central Indonesia Time), in the Unhas Rector's Room, on the 8th floor, Unhas Rectorate Building, Tamalanrea Campus, Makassar by keeping adhering to the Covid-19 health protocol, Monday (21/06).

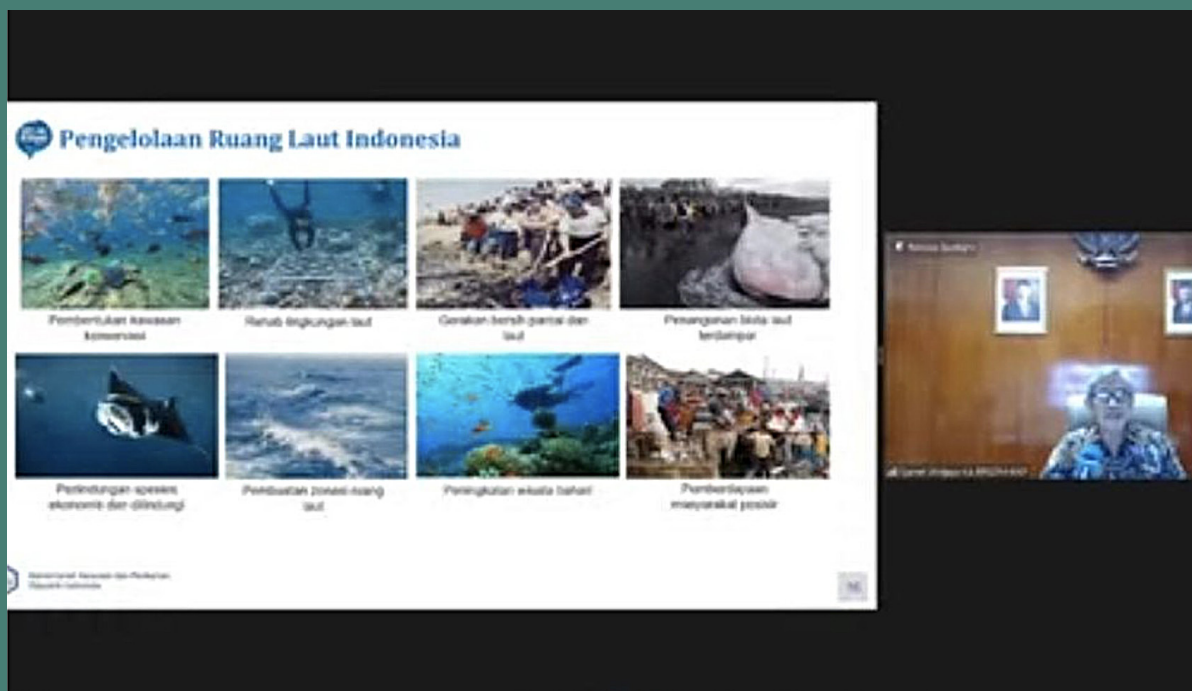

As for the Unhas side, the Vice-Rector for Research, Innovation and Partnership, Prof. dr. Nasrum Massi, Ph.D, the Director of Unhas Partnership, and several lecturers of the French Literature Department also took part in this activity. Stephane Doyert explained that France and Unhas

have collaborated for a long while through the implementation of the DELF exam, the establishment of Warung Prancis, as well as academic and cultural activities carried out simultaneously with the IFI representative office in Surabaya. Besides, he added that they are currently carrying out a program called independent learning program that has been joined by 15 universities in France, and it is hoped that Unhas Students are interested in taking part in the program.

Before meeting the Rector of Unhas, the IFI Delegation first visited the Warung Prancis located in the Unhas Central Library. IFI is ready to help and be actively involved if needed in the development of Warung Prancis as a medium of information and learning for students.

SEVEN FOREIGN SPEAKERS ATTENDED SYMPOSIUM ON MARINE AND FISHERIES, UNIVERSITAS HASANUDDIN



As an effort to achieve the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), especially the 14th Goal of SDGs that is "Life below Water", the Faculty of Marine and Fisheries Sciences (FIKP) Universitas Hasanuddin (Unhas) along with Aquatrop of Universiti Malaysia Terengganu held the 8th National Symposium and 4th International Symposium. The activity which carried out virtually through this zoom application was themed "Accelerating the Management of Marine and Fishery Resources to Achieve SDGs amid the Covid-19 Pandemic".

The keynote speaker presented was the Head of the Agency for the Marine and Fisheries Research and Human Resources, Prof. Ir. R. Sjarief Widjaja, Ph.D. representing the Ministry of Marine Affairs and Fisheries of the Republic Indonesia, Ir. Sakti Wahyu Trenggono, MM. The other invited speakers are as follows:

Whereas, the International Symposium will present 205 international papers consisting of 73 symposium papers from Unhas and others from outside Unhas.

This activity was officially opened by the Rector of Unhas, Prof. Dr. Dwia Aries Tina Palubuhu, MA, then, the activity continued with a discussion and question and answers session from the participants guided by Prof. Dr. Ir. Zainuddin Latif, M.Si.

UNHAS IN COLLABORATION WITH UITM AND UHO HELD A PUBLIC LECTURE



Universitas Hasanuddin (Unhas) together with Universiti Teknologi Mara (UiTM) Cawangan Pahang, Malaysia, and Universitas Halu Oleo (UHO) Kendari, conducted a public lecture, which entitled: "Tentative Global Lecture Series 2021".

The Tentative Global Lecture Series 2021 was held in two days (22nd and 23rd of June 2021) and was presented virtually through the zoom meeting application and was also connected to youtube UiTM Pangan Rasmi.

On the first day, several topics were presented by Assoc. Prof. Ts. Dr. Megat Ahmad Kamal Megat Hanafiah (UiTM Pahang), Ramadhan Tosepu, SKM., M.Kes., Ph.D (UHO), Dr. dr. Rina Masadah, M.Phil, Sp.PA(K), DFM (Unhas), dan Assoc. Prof. cHM, Dr. Nor Yuziah Mohd Yunus (UiTM Pahang)., and at the second day different source persons presented: Muhammad Junaid, SP, MP, Ph.D (Unhas), Dr. Nur Arba, S.Si., M.Si (UHO), Dr. Nor Hidayatun binti Abdul Razak (UiTM Pahang).

The event was officially opened by the Rector of UiTM Cawangan Pahang: YBhg. Prof. Ts. Dr. Mohd Ilham Bin Adenan. In his remarks, he stated that the development of one country is not only valued from the economic growth,

but also on the educational development. Therefore, the event was expected to give chances and experiences for students to contribute in the development of knowledge.

Assoc. Prof. Ts. Dr. Megat Ahmad Kamal Megat Hanafiah from UiTM delivered a lecture about Building Academic Career: Continuing Studies at Postgraduates Level. He explained that Universiti Teknologi Mara has 37 campuses and provides 498 programs offered to students. The study period for postgraduate students was ranged from 1 year to 4 years.

Dr. dr. Rina Masadah, M.Phil, Sp.PA(K), DFM., a resource person from Unhas presented "Early Detection of Cervical Cancer". Dr. Rina explained that cervical cancer resulted from HPV (Human Papilloma Virus) infection.

In 2020, as many as 490.000 women in the world were suffering from cervical cancer and 240.000 of them died. "This fairly deadly disease, 80% is found in developing countries. Cervical cancer is easily transmitted by several risk factors, such as smoking or exposure to secondhand smoke, having a family history of cancer, and lack of hygiene," said Dr. Rina.

14 UNHAS STUDENTS SUCCESSFULLY SELECTED THE IISMA INDEPENDENT CAMPUS PROGRAM



A total of 14 students from the University of Hasanuddin successfully selected the Indonesian International Student Mobility Awards (IISMA) program organized by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Research, and Technology. This is in line with the announcement published by the IISMA committee on Sunday (13/06). IISMA is one of the flagship programs of the Merdeka Campus which aims to provide rights and opportunities for students to carry out self-development activities outside the campus at foreign universities.

During Thursday's interview (17/06) with the Director of Unhas Education, Dr. Ida Leida M, SKM., M.KM., M.ScPH., explained that this program provides students with opportunities to take courses or activities that can be

compared to courses that do not fall within the scope of the curriculum. Students also can study at foreign universities that are becoming a partner of the Ministry of Education and Culture for one semester whose activities are equivalent to up to 20 credits by taking courses and self-development activities of interest.

Under the IISMA program, students must take several courses from the partner universities. Lectures will take place face to face or offline. Participants depart according to the academic calendar of partner universities abroad.

FRANCE REVIEWED UNHAS RESEARCH LOCATION IN THE 2021 ARCHIPELAGO PROGRAM



The French Embassy team in Indonesia visited Universitas Hasanuddin (Unhas) research site in the Nusantara 2021 program. The visit chaired by M. Stephane Doyet (The counselor for Cooperation with the French Embassy) took place on Wednesday (23/06) in Takalar Regency. The Nusantara Program is a collaboration of Hubert Curien between France and Indonesia.

This collaboration is implemented in France by the Ministry of Europe and Foreign Affairs (Ministere de L'Europe et des Affaires Etrangères, MEAE) and the Ministry of Higher Education Research and Innovation (Ministere de L'Enseignement Supérieur, de La Recherche et de L'Innovation, MESRI) in collaboration with Kemenristekdikti which has now changed to Kemendikbud, Research and Technology.

Through an interview on Wednesday (30/06) with Dr. Nurjannah Nurdin, ST, M.Si, lecturer at the Faculty of Marine and Fisheries Sciences, Unhas as the head of the Nusantara Program Team, explained that the presence of the program aimed to increase the mobility of researchers from both countries for research performance and international publications.

Unhas is one of six universities in Indonesia that won a competitive grant in the 2021 Nusantara Program. "Unhas' participation in the program begins with the submission of a research proposal that was prepared by involving

research partners from the University of Nantes, France who previously had a cooperation agreement through the signing of the MoU," explained Nurjannah.

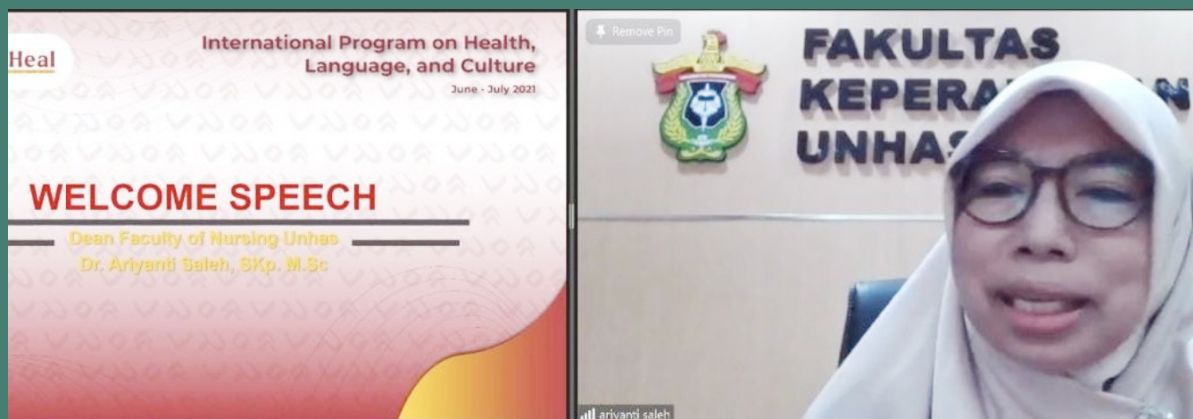
Researchers who successfully passed this program got two years of research opportunities. Financing was approved based on the annual budget for two consecutive years. The research project would be evaluated scientifically and separately from both parties.

"The selection process took place last year and for now we are conducting research whose main object is seaweed. Incidentally, representatives of the French Embassy at that time visited Unhas and we invited them to see the research location directly," added Nurjannah.

With this program, Nurjannah hopes that it will have an impact on higher quality Unhas publications because it involves outside researchers. Not only that, it will directly increase and expand the partnership network.

FACULTY OF NURSING UNHAS AND LA TROBE UNIVERSITY HELD INTERNATIONAL HEALTH AND CULTURE PROGRAM

This program aimed to increase students' knowledge, awareness, and experience in the fields of health, Indonesian language, and culture, especially South Sulawesi and Australia.

"This is an inbound student program that should be held offline. However, due to the pandemic situation, we conduct this program online. We hope that this will not affect the enthusiasm of students in joining it. Hopefully, next year, the conditions will improve, so La Trobe University students can come and visit Makassar straight away," explained Dr. Ariyanti. Representing La Trobe

University, Prof. Lisa also hopes that this program will strengthen the relationship between Unhas and La Trobe University. In addition, students can exchange information and experiences as well as a wider network.

The activity was officially opened by the Director of Unhas Partnership, Dr. Mahatma Lanuru, ST., M.Sc. In his speech, he welcomed this cooperation program. Mahatma gave a brief description of Unhas to the participants who took part in the activity. He explained, Unhas has many achievements both nationally and internationally, breaking through the world rankings in the Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) World University Ranking at 1,001-1,200 in the world.

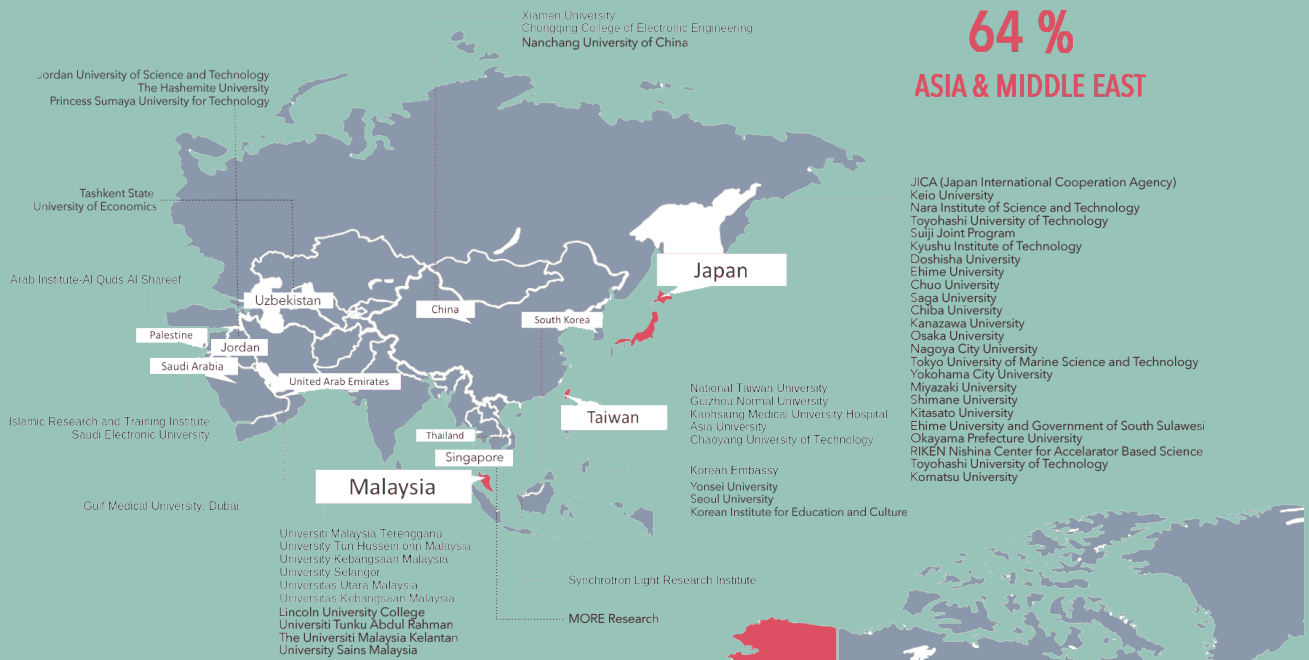
