



FOUR UNDERGRADUATE STUDY PROGRAMS OF UNHAS MEET THE STANDARD OF AUN-QA CERTIFICATION

Four undergraduate study programs of Universitas Hasanuddin (Unhas) received recognition from the ASEAN University Network-Quality Assurance (AUN-QA). The four programs are Political Science, Public Administration Science, Arabic Literature, and Aquatic Resources Management study program.

The AUN-QA affirmed that the four study programs had met the requirements of a quality standard developed by AUN-QA. The Director of Communications Unhas, Ir. Suharman Hamzah, Ph.D., explained that the four study programs had previously been visited in February 2021. Since they were still in a pandemic situation, the visitation took place virtually.

"This achievement makes Unhas now have 34 undergraduate study programs that meet international standards. In other words, as many as 51 percent of all Unhas undergraduate study programs are internationally accredited," said Suharman.

The fulfillment of AUN-QA standards by undergraduate study programs is a continuous effort to improve the quality of study programs and graduate competencies. This is also in line with the Directorate General of Higher Education program of Indonesia, which places international accreditation as one of the Key Performance Indicators.

The Political Science Study Program and the Public Administration Study Program are under the Faculty of Social and Political Sciences (FISIP). While the Arabic Literature Study Program is in the Faculty of Cultural Sciences, and the Aquatic Resources Management Study Program is under the Faculty of Marine and Fisheries Sciences.

THE CENTER OF PEACE, CONFLICT AND DEMOCRACY OF UNIVERSITAS HASANUDDIN COOPERATED WITH THE CENTER OF INNOVATIVE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT OF UNIVERSITI TEKNOLOGI MALAYSIA DISCUSSING THE PALESTINIAN-ISRAELI CONFLICT



The Center of Peace, Conflict and Democracy (CPCD) of Universitas Hasanuddin, in collaboration with the Center of Innovative Planning and Development (CIPD) of Universiti Teknologi Malaysia, held a discussion with the theme "Palestinian-Israeli Conflict Analysis and Perspectives".

This activity took place online through the Webex application at 11.30 Central Indonesia Time (WITA), on Thursday, May 20th.

In this discussion, speakers who took part in this discussion were Dr. Wesam Al-Madhoun (Centre of Sustainable Development Gaza University) and Agussalim Burhanuddin (Centre of Peace, Conflict and Democracy Hasanuddin University, Indonesia).

To begin with, Dr. Wesam briefly explained the background of the latest confrontation between Palestine and Israel in Jerusalem. The beginning of the latest clash occurred when

Israel Police aggressively rushed the Sheikh Jarrah area in which Palestinians worshipped in the month of Ramadan. This attack resulted in many casualties. Responding to this, Agussalim, who is the second speaker, affirmed that Indonesia, Malaysia and Brunei Darussalam strongly oppose Israel aggression against Palestine in this current conflict.

Furthermore, the three countries support for the freedom of Palestine as an independent and sovereign state and firmly commit to resolving the conflicts between the two countries through negotiations and diplomacy.

UNHAS LECTURER RECEIVES INTERNATIONAL AWARDS FOR SCIENTIFIC ARTICLE



Sudirman Nasir, Ph.D, a lecturer of the Faculty of Public Health (FKM) Universitas Hasanuddin, won the annual Pittu Laungani Award for his scientific article entitled "Cultural Norms Create A Preference for Traditional Birth Attendants and Hinder Health Facility-Based Childbirth in Indonesia and Ethiopia: A Qualitative Inter-Country Study" which was published in the International Journal of Health Promotion and Education, volume 58 issue 3, year of 2020, with a special issue highlighting the social determinants of health. The journal is published by Taylor and Francis, which is UK based and is the official journal of the Institute of Health Promotion and Education, an international community of academics/researchers/health professionals with expertise and interest in health promotion.

Dr. Sudirman finished writing his article when he was a visiting researcher (a visiting fellow supported by SAME Program, Ministry of Research and Technology of the Republic of Indonesia in 2019) at Liverpool School of Tropical Medicine/LSTM, so he could edit articles with fellow researchers/co-authors at LSTM named Professor Miriam Taegtmeier and Dr. Rosalind Steege. The article written by Dr. Sudirman Nasir together with a number of co-authors from various countries such as the UK, the Netherlands, Indonesia and Ethiopia, is the result of

international health research as a collaboration between a number of research institutions/universities such as Universitas Hasanuddin, Liverpool School of Tropical Medicine, Eijkman Institute, Royal institute of Tropical Medicine (Netherlands), Reachout Indonesia and Reachout Ethiopia. The research also involved experts from two Asian countries (Indonesia and Bangladesh), four African countries (Ethiopia, Kenya, Malawi, Mozambique) and two European countries (UK and the Netherlands) who joined a research consortium called REACHOUT supported by the European Commission.

The Pittu Laungani Award is an award given to researchers whose articles emphasize the importance of local cultural aspects and their influence on people's attitudes either in accessing or not accessing the essential health services. In an interview on Tuesday, May 18th, Sudirman Nasir explained that this research took place five years from 2013 to 2018. Indonesia and Ethiopia chose to focus on the role of health workers upon the front lines to reduce maternal mortality and improve maternal/women's health.

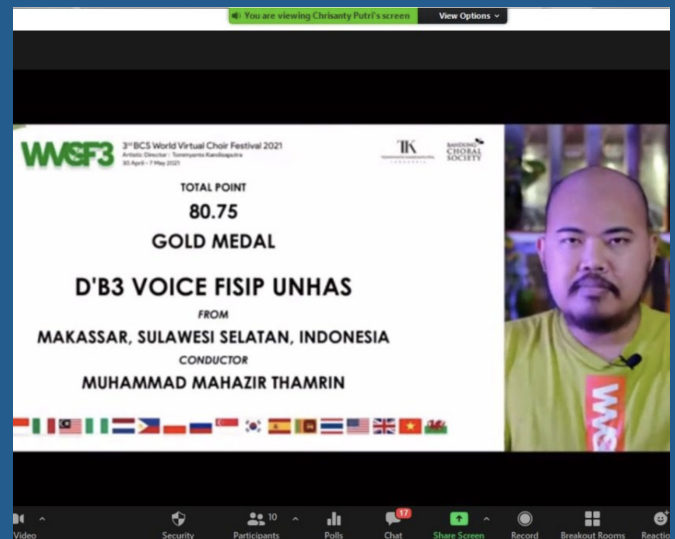

D'B3 VOICE FISIP UNHAS WINS GOLD IN THE 3RD WORLD VIRTUAL CHOIR FESTIVAL 2021

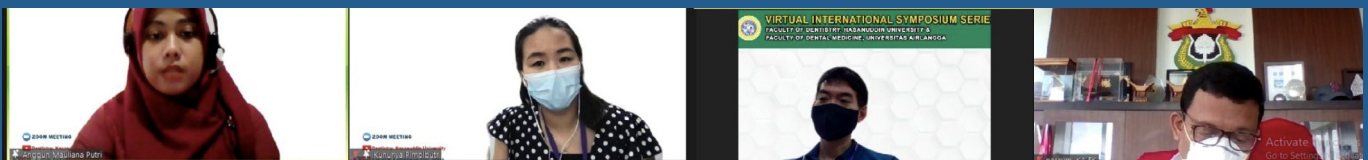

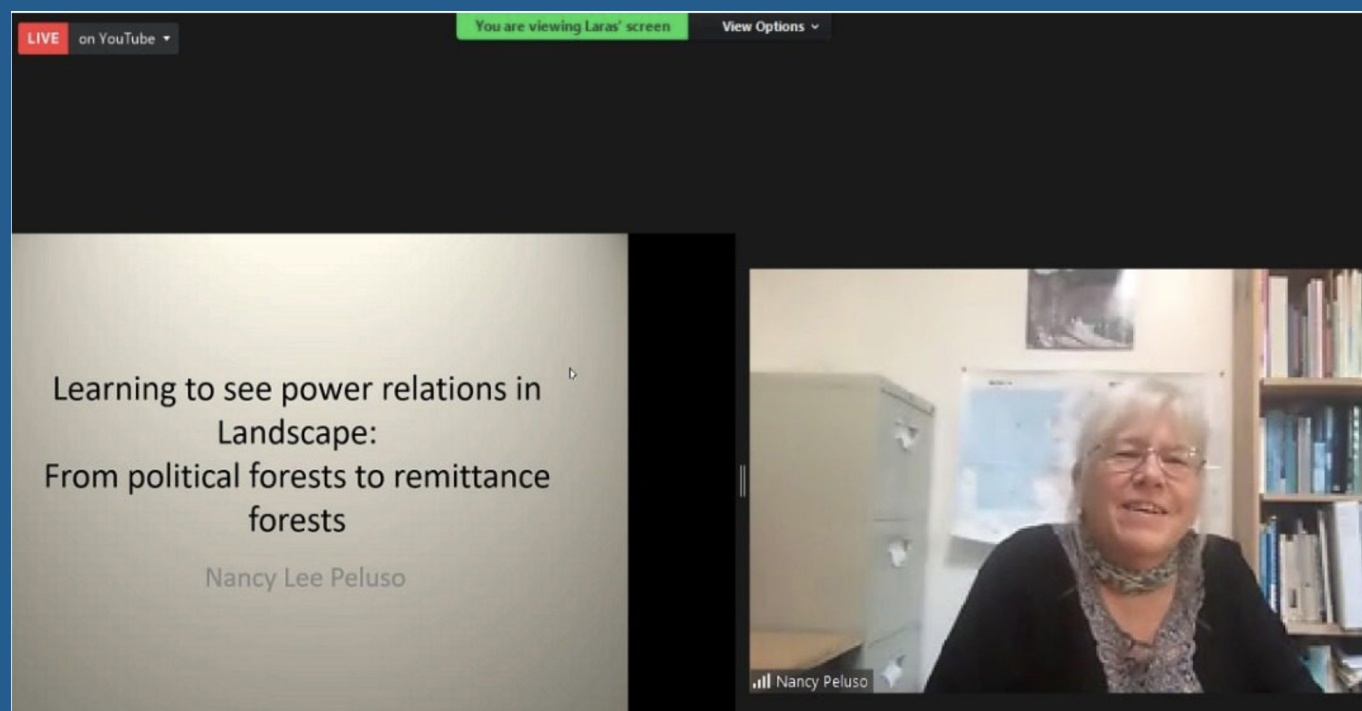
The symposium was officially opened by the Vice Rector for Research, Innovation, and Partnership, Prof. dr. Muh.

UNHAS FACULTY OF FORESTRY INVITED LECTURERS FROM THE UNITED STATES IN PUBLIC LECTURE



The Faculty of Forestry, Universitas Hasanuddin (Unhas), held a public lecture entitled “Online Course: Environment, Development and Governance in Indonesia, Theories, Issues and Trends” with the theme “Multi-scalar Histories and Political Ecology: Researching Questions of Power, Labor and Land-based Resources in Indonesia”. The public lecture started at 10:00 Central Indonesia Time (WITA) virtually through the zoom meeting application and the Faculty of Forestry’s YouTube channel on Monday, May 31st. Micah R. Fisher, one of the editors of the Journal of Forest and Society, said that the event was a discussion forum to increase the information and knowledge for the participants. The Faculty of Forestry invited Prof. Dr. Nancy Lee Peluso (a professor of environmental science, policy and management in UC Barkeley, USA) to present a topic of “Learning

to See Power Relations in Landscape: From Political Forest to Remittance Forest”, which generally explained the political and remittance forest. She stated that the term political forest was first used to denaturalize the forest. She considered that the political forest of ecological entities can be described in three periods: colonialism, post-colonial independence, and the counter-insurgency struggle. It is helpful to analyze how countries in South-east Asia use forests as a tool of territorial power. She has researched the history of political forests in South-east Asia, linking global geopolitics, professional forestry institutions and natural resource law with the country’s regional production.

Eligibilities

- Graduated from high schools in 2019, 2020, or 2021
- Maximum age of 22 years old by the end of admission period.
- Foundation Program/ A-level or equivalent qualification (depending on each country for instance South Australian Matriculation, Monash University Foundation Year).
- Certificate of National and/or International awards in academic or non-academic (sport, art, etc) (If any).
- Free from total colour blindness.
- Have a minimum TOEFL score of 500/173/60 for paper-based, computer-based, and internet-based, respectively, or IELTS score of 5.5 or equivalent with no band lower than 5.0 (for non-English speaking applicants).

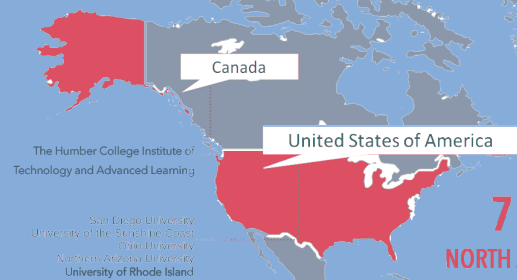
