UNHAS AND SAPPORO HEART CENTER JAPAN HAVE AGREED TO COLLABORATE ON ACADEMIC EXCHANGE



UNHAS and Sapporo Heart Center Japan agreed to cooperate in academic exchanges for students of the Faculty of Medicine. This agreement was stated through the signing of a MOU between the Executive Director and General Manager of Sapporo Heart Center (Kevin Kosaku Samon) and the Rector of Unhas (Prof. Dr. Dwia Aries Tina Pulubuhu, MA).

This activity was conducted on Wednesday, February 9th, 2022 at the Rector Meeting room, located on the 8th floor of the Unhas rectorate building. It was held offline starting at 11.00 WITA with the implementation of the COVID-19 prevention protocols.



On this occasion, the Rector of Unhas, Prof. Dwia Pulubuhu, said that the collaboration was in line with the presence of the Integrated Heart Center owned by Wahidin Soedirohusodo Hospital in Makassar. UNHAS MASTERS & DOCTORAL STUDY PROGRAMS ARE SUBJECTED TO FIBAA QUALITY ASSESSMENTS



The Foundation for International Business Administration Accreditation (FIBAA) conducted a visit to assess three study programs at the masters and doctoral levels at the Faculty of Agriculture and the Faculty of Economics and Business. The three study programs are Masters in Agribusiness, Masters in Development Economics and Planning, and Doctoral Programs in Economics.

The opening of the visitation on Monday, February 7th, 2022 at the Academic Senate room located on the 2nd floor of the Unhas rectorate building.

It was held offline with limited participants and by implementing the COVID-19 prevention protocols. It was also virtually connected through a Zoom Meeting application starting at 15.30 WITA.

This activity was attended by the Chancellor of Unhas, Prof. Dr. Dwia Aries Tina Pulubuhu, MA., Unhas Academic Senate, Board of Professors, Representatives of the Board of Trustees (MWA), Vice-Chancellors, Directors, and Deans within Unhas.

Unhas Rector, Prof. Dwia, said that the study program assessment at Unhas was intended to encourage and motivate quality improvement at the international level. In addition, this process also provides opportunities for network development and the expansion of partnerships with other institutions around the world.

FIBAA is an accrediting agency that was established in 2002 and is tasked with providing quality assurance and quality development for higher education based in Bonn, Germany.

The assessment process is scheduled to last until Wednesday (09/02). While the implementation of the first day is scheduled to last until 19.30 WITA.

FACULTY OF DENTISTRY UNHAS HOLDS INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE (ICOBTD) DISCUSSING NEW TECHNOLOGY & RESEARCHES IN ORAL AND DENTAL HEALTH



The Faculty of Dentistry (FKG) of UNHAS again conducted an international conference entitled “The 7th International Conference on Biophysical Technology in Dentistry” themed “Emerging Technologies and Interdisciplinary Research in Daily Dental Practice”. The event which was attended by approximately 200 participants started from 1.30 to 4.00 pm Central Indonesia Time online through the Zoom meeting application, Thursday (24/02).

This activity was run with a material presentation by two resource persons, Prof. Dr. Sabri Musa (Department of Paediatric Dentistry, Universiti Malaya, Malaysia) and Tunde Bamgbose, BDS., DDS., MS., FMCDS., FWACS (Bayero University Kano, Nigeria).

The first material was delivered by Prof. Sabri Musa regarding “Paediatric Oncology Patient Concerning Oral Health Issue”. In general, he presented an overview of the dental and oral health services for children provided by Universiti Malaya. He also

explained the importance of a child’s dental and oral health.

He said that early detection of children’s dental problems will have a direct impact on a drastic reduction in mortality due to early diagnosis and improvement of oncology treatment. Furthermore, efforts are highly needed to prevent, stabilize and treat dental and oral problems that can interfere with children’s health and their life quality. Another view was also conveyed by Tunde Bamgbose in “The Usefulness of Readout Segmented Echo Planar Imaging (RESOLVE) for Bio-Phantom Imaging Using 3 Tesla Clinical MRI”.

On that occasion, he generally explained an overview of the use of 3T MRI technology in the health sector. MRI 3 Tesla (3T) is the latest technology that provides detailed anatomical imaging. Clinically, MR is used for diagnosis and treatment and has an ADC value.

On that occasion, Prof. Dr. Wolfgang Voegeli representing the FIBAA assessor team explained the general results of the field assessment reports for each study program. Several report points were submitted based on the results of the criteria and procedures referred to in the assessment guidelines.

Representing the Rector of Unhas, the Vice-Rector for Academic Affairs Prof. Dr. Ir. Moh. Restu, MP., conveyed his gratitude and was thankful for finally being able to finish the FIBAA assessment. He said the various suggestions and inputs given by the assessor team would be fully

considered in the future. He hoped that the visitation process would produce an objective portrait for improving the quality of Unhas education services.

A series of visitation processes were performed in each study program by looking at various aspects of achievement, such as improving supporting facilities and infrastructure, learning curricula, quality assurance of education, as well as the design of standardized learning modules applied.

Prof. Oba focuses on international relations and politics in East Asia and the Asia-Pacific, particularly in the development of regionalism in the region as well as the theory of regional integration and regionalism. One of his works is Further Development of Asian Regionalism: institutional hedging in an uncertain era.

The concept of the Indo-Pacific is a hot topic of discussion

because it is considered to have economic opportunities as well as great security challenges.

Southeast Asia Lecture Hall is a program that aims to provide world-class lectures by leading academics and experts in their respective fields to students and young people in the Southeast Asia region.

This activity was guided by Dr. Sheila Devi Michael (Senior Lecturer, Department of International and Strategic Studies, Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences, University of Malaya) and was attended by around 600 participants from various countries. 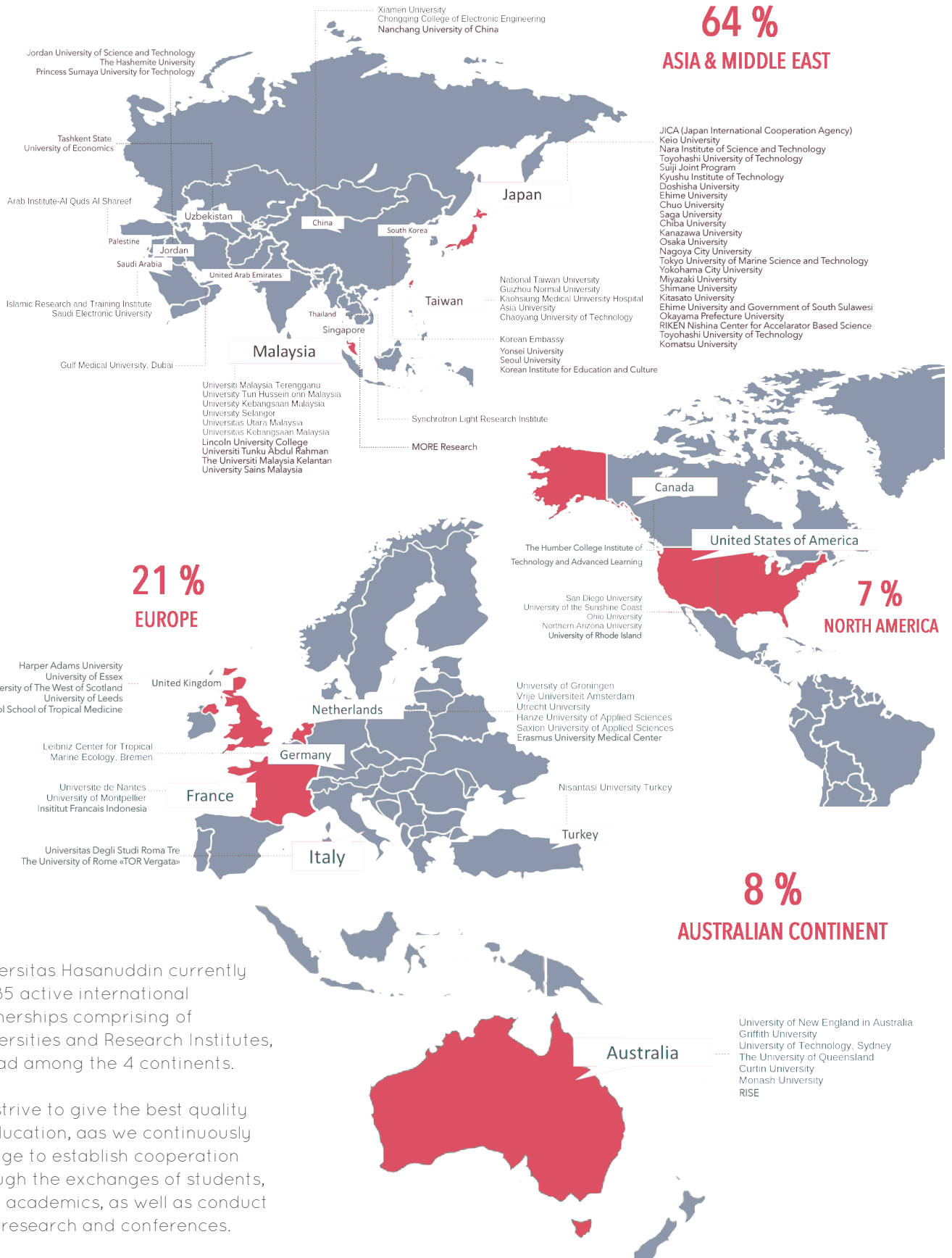
