THREE STUDY PROGRAMS OF THE FACULTY OF PUBLIC HEALTH UNIVERSITAS HASANUDDIN UNDERGO ASIIN INTERNATIONAL ACCREDITATION VISITS



The ASIIN international accreditation agency (Akkreditierungsagentur für Studiengänge der Ingenieurwissenschaften, der Informatik, der Naturwissenschaften und der Mathematik) organized visitations in the context of assessments for undergraduate, master, and doctoral programs at the Faculty of Public Health Universitas Hasanuddin (Unhas).

The opening started at 3 pm, Central Indonesian Time (WITA) The event was conducted virtually through the Zoom meeting application, Tuesday (31/5) and the assessment lasted until Thursday, 2nd of June 2022.

The rector of Unhas; Prof. Dr. Ir. Jamaluddin Jompa, M.Sc., together with several leaders and the Head of the Unhas Faculty of Public Health Study Program also attended the opening session.

QONITA KURNIA, A GRADUATE OF UNHAS' FACULTY OF PHARMACY, HAS BEEN AWARDED A DOCTORATE IN NORTHERN IRELAND AT THE AGE OF 25

Qonita Kurnia Anjani, a graduate of Hasanuddin University's Faculty of Pharmacy, class of 2012, has furthered her scientific career and got a Ph.D. degree at Queen's University Belfast, Northern Ireland, at the young age of 25.

According to a press statement accompanying the announcement of Identitas Unhas, Qonita has been researching drug delivery technology, particularly technology that allows pharmaceuticals to permeate the skin. She subsequently applied this knowledge to her thesis, which focused on gels. Later she found out that a similar, more practical technology had been developed abroad, namely Microneedle.

Qonita was initially accepted at Queen's University Belfast as a master's degree student with a two-year study time. She subsequently pursued her doctoral studies for another year without the benefit of a grant. In her doctoral education, the research he did was entitled "Development of Antibiotic Microneedle Delivery Systems for Tuberculosis Treatment". This research focuses on developing Microneedle patch technology for tuberculosis drugs.

UNHAS AND AUSTRALIA INDONESIA CENTER DISCUSS THE PROGRESS OF RESEARCH PROJECTS IN SOUTH SULAWESI







Universitas Hasanuddin (Unhas) and the Australia-Indonesia Center (AIC) conducted a meeting together with Unhas researchers, members of the Partnership for Australia-Indonesia Research (PAIR) program, discussing the progress of the PAIR program research in South Sulawesi.

According to him, the existing collaboration could shed the light on actualizing positive and creative ideas.


