
HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY AND UNIVERSITI KEBANGSAAN MALAYSIA CONTINUE COOPERATION IN THE TRIDHARMA OF HIGHER EDUCATION



Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) and Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia (UKM) extended the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) in the field of Tridharma of Higher Education (education, research, and community service). The MoU extension was signed by the Rector of UNHAS, Prof. Dr. Ir. Jamaluddin Jompa, M.Sc and Naib Canselor of UKM, Prof. Dato Gs. Ts. Dr. Mohd Ekhwan Toriman. The event took place at Universiti Kebangsaan Malaysia, Malaysia on Wednesday, December 4, 2022.

Prof. Jamaluddin Jompa or usually called Prof. JJ in his speech said that the relationship between UKM and UNHAS has been established for a long time. He hoped that the extension of the MoU could bring positive impacts to both parties. He said that the collaboration will further strengthen UNHAS' commitment in the improvement of society in various sectors. Prof. JJ added that in general, UNHAS continues to build cooperative relationships with many partners, while developing research collaborations. Representing UKM, Prof. Dato expressed his pleasure at the extension of this collaboration. Besides strengthening the relationship between the two, it will also have an impact on cooperation in the field of Tridharma.

In the ceremony, the Rector of UNHAS was accompanied by the Deans of the Faculties of Medicine and Dentistry. From the UKM representatives, Prof. Emeritus Dato, Dr. Mohamad Abd. Razak, Prof. Dato Dr. Hanafiah Harunarashid, Prof. Dr. Abdul Halim Abdul Gafor and Prof. Madya Dr. Tuti Ningseh Mohd Dom. Dato Dr. Sahruddin Jamal, the former Menteri Besar of Johor and also an alumnus of UNHAS, attended the MoU signing ceremony.









Hasanuddin University Welcomes Delegation from Toyàhashi Institute of Technology to Discuss Collaboration

Toyàhashi Institute of Technology (TIT) visited Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) to discuss cooperation between the two universities on January 5, 2023 at the Faculty of Engineering (FT), in Gowa Campus. The TIT delegation was led by Prof. Junichiro Asano accompanied by Associate Prof. Dr. Shirou Tsuboi, and five architecture master students from Toyohashi Institute of Technology. They were warmly received by Vice Rector for Partnership, Innovation, Entrepreneurship, and Bussiness Prof. Adi Maulana accompanied by Dean of FT, Prof. Isran Ramli and the Architecture Engineering academic community.

During this visit, the TIT delegation explained that in the future there will be a public lecture which will be attended by lecturers and students of both universities. In addition, it is hoped that there will be an exchange of students between TIT and UNHAS as a part of the cooperation. Furthermore, the universities expected to conduct joint research on strategic fields. UNHAS will continue to expand cooperation with potential partners from various countries. Moreover, the cooperation that has been established will be maintained and strengthened in order to create a sustainable impact for all parties.







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VICE DEAN OF FACULTY OF MEDICINE, HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY, DR ANDI ALFIAN, PARTICIPATES AS IVLP PROGRAM AWARDEE IN THE UNITED STATES

Vice Dean for Partnership, Research, and Innovation of the Faculty of Medicine, Hasanuddin University (UNHAS), Dr. Andi Alfian Zainuddin, MKM, was selected as a participant in the International Visitors Leadership Program (IVLP) in the United States. The program initiated by the US government includes participants from various countries who have been selected previously. Dr Alfian is also a Deputy Secretary of Nahdlatul Ulama Regional Executive Board of South Sulawesi (PWNU) and was once Deputy Secretary of the Nahdlatul Ulama Health Institute for the 2015-2020 Period. PWNU is a very well known religious organization in Indoneisan. This program was attended by Dr Alfian along with five other participants who were activists of the Nahdlatul Ulama Health Institute with the theme Healthcare Administration and Medical School Program Development for Faith-Based Organizations, which took place in the US, December 3-14, 2022.



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

On December 29, 2022, the implementation of cooperation between the Faculty of Agriculture (FAPERTA) UNHAS and Ehime University was carried out with the dissemination of the Graduate Program at Ehime University which was presented by Prof. Hiroki Oue, the Dean of the Graduate School of Agriculture from three consortium universities (Ehime University, Kochi University and Kagawa University). The event was attended by several lecturers, alumni and senior students of the Faculty of Agriculture who are interested in pursuing further studies at Ehime University.

This event was also supported by the Japanese Consular Office in Makassar by providing information about the Monbukagakusho (MEXT) scholarship from the Japanese government. The event lasted for approximately two hours with a series of agenda, including opening remarks from the Dean of On December 29, 2022, the implementation of cooperation between the FAPERTA UNHAS, presentation of socialization material by the Dean of United Graduate School of Agricultural Sciences (UGAS-EU) Japan, discussion about studying at Rendai UGAS-EU, question and answer session with 30 participants. This activity is expected to open opportunities for lecturers, alumni and final year students to continue their studies at Ehime University.



The meeting was attended by Dias Prasetiamartati, Eugene Sebastian, Kevin Evans and Helen Fletcher Kennedy from AIC side and UNHAS Vice Rector for Partnership, Innovation, Entrepreneurship, and Bussiness Prof Adi Maulana, Director of Partnership Dr. Ansariadi and Head of International Office, Dr. Andi Masyitha Irwan. After successfully conducting Partnership for Australia the Indonesia Research (PAIR) Summit in December 5-7, 2022 at UNHAS which resulted in the decision to establish PAIR Lab at UNHAS, both parties AIC and UNHAS worked together to write and finishing proposal grant submitted to Indonesia Endowment Fund (LPDP) for the Indonesia side. In addition, from the Australian side, AIC will submit and propose additional grants. The meeting discussed in detail about characteristic, expected outcome and some points of PAIR Lab proposal grant. Following this meeting, next agenda to discuss about the proposal grant will be conducted with inviting LPDP officer on January 9, 2022
