Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) and Universiti Putra Malaysia (UPM) agreed to cooperate in the field of developing the Tri Dharma (Education, Research, and Community Service) of Higher Education. The agreement was contained in the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the Rector of UNHAS, Prof. Dr. Ir. Jamaluddin Jompa, M.Sc, also known as Prof. JJ and Naib Canselor, UPM, YH. Dato' Prof. Dr. Mohd Roslan Bin Sulaiman. The activity took place in the Rector's Meeting Room, 8th Floor of the UNHAS Rectorate Building, Tamalanrea Campus, Makassar on Monday, January 9th 2023.

During the meeting, the UPM delegation was welcomed by the Rector of UNHAS, Prof. JJ. He was accompanied by the Vice-Rector for Partnership, Innovation, Entrepreneurship and Business; Prof. Dr. Eng. Adi Maulana, S.T., M.Phil, Dean of the Faculty of Forestry of UNHAS; Dr. Ir. A. Dato' Prof. Dr. Mohd Roslan said that the collaboration carried out with UNHAS was a collaboration intended to strengthen the relationship and try to strengthen, advance and develop academic and research cooperation, through educational programs, research promotion and joint publications.

Representatives of the Faculty of Marine Science and Fisheries, Hasanuddin University (FIKP UNHAS), held a meeting with representatives of the Faculty of Natural Resources and Agricultural Sciences, Swedish University of Agricultural Sciences (NJ SLU). The Vice Dean for Partnerships, Research and Innovation, Dr. Ahmad Faisal, ST, M.Si, International Partnership, Dr. Shinta Werorilangi, Dr. Widyastuti, and UNHAS Internationalization Working Group, Dr. Wilma Moka represented FIKP UNHAS at the meeting. Meanwhile, the NJ SLU Representative was the Head of the Department of Aquatic Resources, Prof. Noel Holmgren. The meeting was also attended by the Head of Sub Directorate of Partnership and Network Development, Dr. Nuvida Raf S.Sos., MA. took place in the Vice Rector IV meeting room, 6th floor of the Rectorate Building UNHAS on Tuesday, January 10th 2023. The meeting was to discuss plans for possible collaboration that could be carried out between FIKP UNHAS and NJ SLU.

Dr. Faisal explained that this meeting was an effort to increase collaboration in education and research, especially in fisheries and marine resource management. Prof. Holmgren, an expert on aquatic resources management, expressed his enthusiasm for the intention conveyed by Dr. Faisal. The planned form of cooperation that will be implemented including joint research in marine and fisheries resources management, stock assessment, and inland fisheries management.

This collaboration plan is not only limited to lecturers but also students. FIKP UNHAS is open for NJ SLU students who may be interested in exchange program and vice versa. Shortly, both parties will finalize a collaboration plan in a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU).

The activity took place starting at 08.00 WIB at the UNHAS Grand Ballroom, UNHAS Hotel and Convention, Makassar on Thursday, January 12th 2023.

The activity was attended by 32 participants, including the leaders of the faculties and units involved. As for the HEPI technical experts program team that attended as speakers, namely Dr. Robert Schoenfeld and Dr. Scott Danielson. Vice Rector for Partnership, Innovation, Entrepreneurship, and Business at UNHAS, Prof. Dr. Eng. Adi Maulana, S.T., M.Phil., expressed his gratitude for the trust given through cooperation in the HEPI program. This activity is one of UNHAS' strategic steps to advance the quality of sustainable learning. Accordingly, the performed academic activities can produce globally competitive graduates.

After the opening, a presentation related to curriculum development and learning at UNHAS was given by the Head of Curriculum Development and Learning Division, Quality Assurance and Educational Development Unit - (LPMPP), Prof. Dr. Yusring Sanusi Baso, S.S., M.App.Ling. On the same occasion, representing the HEPI team, Dr. Robert Schoenfeld in his presentation explained the purpose of the workshop was to equalize perceptions related to the core objectives of the HEPI program and develop a curriculum and work plan for the HEPI-UNHAS program based on the needs/input of UNHAS stakeholders as university partners. As a result this workshop can provoke an understanding of views and commitment to collaborate through a series of workshops / activities that will be carried out in the future to achieve the three core objectives of HEPI.

FACULTY OF PUBLIC HEALTH CONDUCTS A GUEST LECTURE ON SOCIO-ECONOMIC OUTLOOK



Dr. Arianto Patunru, a research fellow at Indonesia Project, the Australian National University (ANU), Canberra, visited and delivered a guest lecture at the Faculty of Public Health Hasanuddin University (FKM UNHAS) on Thursday, January 12th 2023. A study entitled "Socio-economic Outlook in 2023 and Beyond" elaborated on several implications for Indonesia, including consequences to people's welfare and health. He mentioned vital elements such as inflation, the global value chain, and the need for public health redesign based on experience during the Covid-19 pandemic.

Dr. Sudirman Nasir, who worked with Dr. Patunru in ANU-UNHAS collaboration Covid-19 updates in 2020-2022, acted as a discussant and emphasized the threat of widening inequality globally and within the country due to the factors explained by Dr. Patunru. Dr. Nasir elaborated on how inequality worsens people's health and well-being.

Meanwhile, in his speech, the Dean of the Faculty of Public Health, Prof Sukri Palutturi thanked Dr. Patunru for being able to present his valuable experiences with ANU. With the moderator, Dr. Arifah, Dr. Patunru addressed Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), particularly Goal 8 - Decent Work and Economic Growth and Goal 17 -Partnership. This is one of FKM UNHAS' means to achieve a World Class University. The guest lecture was held at the FKM and was attended by academic staff and students.
