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


About us:

- 5. managing global mobility of students, researchers, and lecturers



ELEVEN HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY STUDENTS PARTICIPATE IN THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION, CULTURE, RESEARCH AND TECHNOLOGY IISMA 2022 PROGRAM



A total of 11 Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) students successfully passed the selection for the Indonesian International Student Mobility Awards (IISMA) program organised by the Ministry of Education, Culture, Research, and Technology. The IISMA committee issued the selection results in June.

The Vice Rector for Academic and Student Affairs, Prof. drg. Muhammad Ruslin, M.Kes., Ph.D., Sp.BM (K), officiated at the send-off ceremony for the UNHAS student representatives participating in the IISMA program. The ceremony took place in the Vice Chancellor for Academic and Student Affairs Room, 7th Floor of the UNHAS Rectorate Building, Tamalanrea Campus, Makassar, on Friday (22/07).

On this occasion, Prof. Ruslin gave some advice and expressed some hopes for the IISMA participants. He reminded the students that they would be the representatives of UNHAS on campuses in different countries. Therefore, he hoped UNHAS students would become agents for partnerships between UNHAS and overseas universities.



The students were going to overseas universities in Chile, the United Kingdom, Estonia, Lithuania, the USA, Italy, Taiwan, Germany, South Korea, and Poland. Prof. Ruslin stated that the students participating in the IISMA program should use this opportunity to increase their knowledge and build networks.

IISMA 2022 PRE-DEPARTURE

International Office of Universitas Hasanuddin held a hybrid (online and offline) Focus Group Discussion - IISMA Pre-Departure for the 11 awardees of IISMA 2022 on Friday (29/07/2022). This activity was attended by Prof. Muhammad Ruslin (Vice-Rector for Academic and Student Affairs), Prof. Adi Maulana (Vice-Rector for Partnership, Innovation, Entrepreneurship, and Business), Dean of the Faculty of Social and Political Sciences, Dean of the Faculty of Economics, Dean of the Faculty of Law, Head, Secretary, and Task Force of the International Office of Affairs. In addition, the Pre-Departure Forum was officially opened by the Vice-Rector for Partnership, Innovation, Entrepreneurship, and Business.

There were three main sessions: Academic Writing, Cross-Cultural Understanding, and sharing sessions with IISMA alums. The International Office task force delivered the sessions. Besides academic writing skills, cultural awareness is also highly required.





The second material Muhammad Ridwan presented regarding cross-cultural understanding, students are equipped with cultural knowledge. The third session was essential to understand students' needs to prepare before and during their time at the destination universities.

In this FDG, ten IISMA alumni had the opportunity to share their past experiences during their first semester in 2021. One of them, Muhammad Rifli, who had the chance to study at UC Davis, USA, advised that awardees should make the most of their time to build networking and connections with the academics at their universities. Nurul Habaib, an IISMA alumnus who studied at the University of Glasgow, UK, also stated the same suggestion that IISMA students should participate in activities or events, such as consortiums, conferences, etc. to broaden their insights of the students further.

The closing speech was brought by Andi Masyitha Irwan, S.Kep., Ns., MAN., Ph.D. as the Head of the International Office. She hoped that UNHAS students who would leave as delegations could bring the reputation of UNHAS to the international world and become ambassadors. Furthermore, she hopes that later on, they could also become a bridge for UNHAS and their destination universities to establish collaborations in various fields.





HANKUK UNIVERSITY OF FOREIGN STUDIES KOREA TEAM VISITS HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY - DISCUSSING COOPERATION OPPORTUNITIES



The Rector of Universitas Hasanuddin, Prof. Dr. Ir. Jamaluddin Jompa, M.Sc., hosted a team from Hankuk University of Foreign Studies - Seoul Campus to discuss opportunities for cooperation, especially in producing and promoting innovative products. The activity was conducted offline by applying the COVID-19 prevention protocol in the UNHAS Rector Meeting Room, 8th Floor, UNHAS Rectorate Building, on Wednesday (7/20).

Prof. Jamaluddin Jompa welcomed the cooperation between academics and industry to introduce and promote innovative products generated in various scientific fields. Furthermore, Prof. Jamaluddin Jompa said that he would discuss more with the relevant lecturers and research teams as a follow-up to the cooperation opportunities that will be carried out in the field of product promotion and marketing.

On the same occasion, Prof. Sung Soo Kim, Ph.D., (Division of Environmental and Forest Science College of Agriculture and Life Sciences, Gyeongsang National University) introduced Ginseng products as the result of his research. He said that UNHAS is one of the best partners in conducting cooperation in the field of study to generate innovation in the health and pharmaceutical fields. The types of ginseng introduced by the Korean side are Double Wood Panax Ginseng for health products and Ginseng Serum for beauty products.

The team from Hankuk University, University of Foreign Studies - Seoul Campus hopes that the meeting held with the leadership of UNHAS can be continued through a partnership agreement so that there will be further discussions related to collaborative research and development of the business world with universities. The Hankuk University team and ginseng entrepreneurs from South Korea were accompanied by Dr. Munira Hasyim, Chairperson of the UNHAS Indonesian Literature Department.

The Faculty of Marine and Fisheries Sciences (FIKP) of Hasanuddin University held a webinar on "Can Algae Save the Planet?" by Prof. Peter Ralph (Faculty of Science, University of Technology Sydney, Australia). The webinar was conducted via Zoom Meeting application on Wednesday, July 13, 2007. The Dean of FIKP, Safruddin, S.Pi, M.P., Ph.D., expressed his hopes that this webinar could be a medium to increase motivation and ideas, and improve the quality of research, especially in the use of algae for various lines of life.

The Vice-Rector for Partnership, Innovation, Entrepreneurship, and Business, Prof. Dr. Eng. Adi Maulana, ST, M.Phil officially opened the webinar. In his remarks, he said that activities like this were generally in line with the Minister of Education and Culture, Research, and Technology policies through the World Class University. Prof. Adi said that currently, UNHAS is recognised as a world-class university based on the QS World University Ranking.

After the official opening, the webinar continued with the presentation of the speakers' materials. Then, Prof. Peter explained how the bio-economic value of algae could fight climate change as the crisis we are currently facing. Not only that, but he also said that many food products can be replaced with algae ingredients without any difference in taste. The webinar was guided by Dr. Yayu Anugrah La Nafie, ST., M.Sc., (Lecturer FIKP UNHAS) as moderator and attended by approximately 100 participants. The participants were also very active in giving responses and questions to the speakers.

The Chief Executive of KKN PK UNHAS, Dr. Irwin Aras, M.Epid., M.Med.Ed, said in his remarks that International Class KKN PK was the first program by the Faculty of Medicine. The community service participated by six students from the Faculty of Medicine would take place at Kaikoukai Healthcare Group, which is one of FK UNHAS' strategic partners. One goal of the International KKN PK program is to teach students about the Japanese healthcare system and give them a chance to learn about Japanese health and culture first-hand.

Representing the Kaikoukai Healthcare Group, Abe Kayuza, as Division Manager, said in his speech that he warmly welcomed the arrival of UNHAS students and would provide the best facilities. Furthermore, he hoped that Kaikoukai could assist UNHAS in increasing its capacity and quality in the global world through various positive activities.

He said programs like this are the first step in strengthening the internationalisation process to be more collaborative. UNHAS was involved in the Higher Education Partnership Initiative (HEPI), a collaborative project between Indonesia and the United States in education. As the first step, a meeting was held to discuss project implementation. The activity was performed virtually through the zoom meeting application on Friday (08/07).

Not only did the Rector of UNHAS, Prof. Dr. Ir. Jamaluddin Jompa, M.Sc (Prof. JJ) attend the meeting but also did the Rector of the Sepuluh November Institute of Technology (ITS), the Rector of Binus and the HEPI Project team, Mr. Jeffrey S. Goss (Associate Vice Provost, Southeast Asia Initiatives Arizona State University) and Dr. Kathy Wigal (HEPI Project Director).

Prof. JJ expressed his gratitude and high appreciation for the trust to be involved in university development projects in various sectors. According to him, this project will provide many benefits in improving the quality of higher education institutions. Mr. Jeffrey S.Goss (Associate Vice Provost, Southeast Asia Initiatives Arizona State University) explained the HEPI Project. He said this project involves many sectors, including universities, government, and other strategic partners. Furthermore, Jeffrey said the HEPI Project is a sustainable partnership program between the United States, Indonesian higher education institutions, and the private sector to improve student competencies and through high-quality, internationally recognized degrees and industry credentials.

UNHAS has been trusted to be part of the Higher Education Partnership Initiative (HEPI) facilitated by USAID and Arizona State University (ASU), United States. UNHAS together with the Sepuluh November Institute of Technology (ITS) and Bina Nusantara University (BINUS) were selected through an assessment process by ASU, which then received funding approval from USAID.

During the meeting, several essential agendas were discussed, including the draft MoU that would be made as well as several other strategic agendas that Indonesian partner universities could carry out.

Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) conferred a Doctorate Honoris Causa (HC) upon Dr. Bruce Michael Alberts, a leading biochemist from the United States of America. The award ceremony took place at 09:00 WITA (GMT+8) at the Baruga A.P Pettarani, Tamalanrea Campus, Makassar, on Wednesday (10/08).

Dr. Alberts is a world-class biochemist who has made major contributions to the field of biochemistry. He has also played very significant roles in other fields such as science education and science diplomacy in the United States and around the world. Dr. Alberts has received 17 Doctor Honoris Causa awards from various world-renowned universities. He has been awarded the highest honour of the United Kingdom, Commander of the Order of the British Empire (CBE), as well as the National Medal of Science (2014) by President Barack Obama.

During the award ceremony Prof. Jamaluddin Jompa, the Rector of UNHAS, represented UNHAS to confer the honorary doctorate on Dr. Alberts as a token of respect for his dedication and contribution to science, especially in the biomedical-biochemistry field. Prof. Jamaluddin Jompa added that another major consideration in awarding this degree was the active involvement of Dr. Alberts in advancing science education and empowering young scientists around the world, especially in Indonesia.

Dr. Alberts has played a key role in initiating and developing interdisciplinary scientific forums, especially for prominent young scientists in various fields, for example through the annual Indonesian-American Kavli Frontiers of Sciences Symposium (KFoSS) held in various cities across Indonesia, including Makassar (2015). The KFoSS is a forum that facilitates intensive scientific discussions among young scientists who have a strong and promising track record, and has resulted in strategic collaborations between scientists from the two countries. Dr. Alberts also gave lectures and held dialogues at several Indonesian universities, including UNHAS, in 2012 and 2015.





ACADEMIC SENATE VISITS THE CENTER FOR INDUSTRY AND HIGHER EDUCATION IN JAPAN TO STRENGTHENING THE UNHAS' PERFORMANCE

The Academic Senate of Hasanuddin University visited several industrial companies and higher educations in Japan to strengthen and optimize the university performance. The group visited Amino Up Co. Ltd in Hokkaido Sappora, Kitasato University in Tokyo, Tsukuba University in Ibaraki, and the Indonesian Embassy in Japan on 31 July to 5 August 2022.

Head of the UNHAS academic senate, Prof. Dr. Ir. Abd. Latief Toleng, M.Sc., explained that the senate needed to provide policies and regulation to academic activities as an adaptation towards post-pandemic era. In addition, senates needed to supervise the implementation of the academic activities.

UNHAS as a Legal Entity State University (PTN-BH) is expected to produce and obtain comprehensive information on the implementation of PTN-BH activities," Prof. Latif added. In addition UNHAS is expected to adapt to different learning styles like those implemented by universities in Japan. The breakthroughs to improve academic services include launching an academic service to help international students conduct studies and research independently.



HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY AND THE UNIVERSITY OF CAPE TOWN (UCT), SOUTH AFRICA, AGREE TO CONDUCT COLLABORATIVE RESEARCH ON INFECTIOUS DISEASES



Hasanuddin University (Unhas) and the University of Cape Town (UCT), South Africa, agreed to establish joint research on infectious diseases. This agreement was produced though the meeting conducted by the Research and Community Services Institution of Unhas (LP2M Unhas) and the Faculty of Medicine of UCT South Africa on Tuesday (02/08) via the Zoom Meeting.

The meeting was attended by the head of LP2M UNHAS, Prof. dr. Muh. Nasrum Massi, Ph.D., Sp.MK., Vice Dean of Faculty of Medicine UNHAS, Dr. dr. Rina Masadah, Sp.PA., M.Phil., DFM, Dean of Faculty of Medicine UCT, Prof Leonel Green Thompson and Director of Research of UCT, Dr. Yolande.

Prof. dr. Muh. Nasrum Massi, Ph.D. explained that the initiation of research collaboration was a form of contribution by UNHAS in building partnerships and benefiting the community. He said, in general, the number of research collaborations with the parties from the African continent was relatively low.

Prof. Nasrum further described that this collaborative research would focus on infectious diseases by establishing a link and match method between researchers from both parties. For the initial collaboration, UNHAS and UCT will focus on three common diseases; tuberculosis, malaria, and hepatitis.

This meeting could lead to establishing programs and projects to increase the quality of the health sector, significantly improving the quality of Indonesian health workers in South Sulawesi. HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY AND MTCRC KOREA AGREE ON COLLABORATION IN THE MARINE AND FISHERIES SECTOR

Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) and Marine Technology Cooperation Research Center (MTCRC) agreed to cooperate in the sector of Marine and Fisheries. The agreement was stated in the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the Rector of UNHAS, Prof. Dr. Ir. Jamaluddin Jompa, M.Sc and Korean Director of MTCRC, Mr. Hansan Park. The activity was conducted in Meeting Room A, 4th Floor of the UNHAS Rectorate Building, Tamalanrea Campus, Makassar, Tuesday (02/08).

Mr. Hansan Park said MTCRC is an intergovernmental institution, a research centre focusing on the field of marine science and technology, which has been operating under the collaboration of two countries, Indonesia and Korea, since 2018 through the implementing arrangement of the Coordinating Ministry for Maritime Affairs and the Ministry of Ocean and Fisheries Korea.

As an intergovernmental institution, in addition to playing a central role in maintaining good relations between the two countries, MTCRC also plays the role of facilitator of bilateral meetings such as the ministerial meeting between the coordinating ministers. Since operating, MTCRC has been actively engaged in establishing collaboration with numerous parties.

PROF. ADI MAULANA, THE VICE RECTOR OF UNHAS ATTENDS AN INVITATION BY THE US GOVERNMENT TO PARTICIPATE IN THE INTERNATIONAL VISITOR LEADERSHIP PROGRAM (IVLP)



Vice Rector for Partnership, Innovation, Entrepreneurship, and Business, Hasanuddin University, Prof. Dr. Eng. Adi Maulana ST. M.Phil., was selected to represent lecturers from Indonesia in the International Visitor Leadership Program (IVLP). This program is hosted by the United States Government.

There were three main fields offered: governance, natural resource and environmental management, and human rights. Candidates for this program must be nominated by the US Embassy in their respective countries. Upon completing the portfolio assessment and processes, candidates would be proposed as participants after being approved by a special team.

Prof. Adi Maulana is considered to have significant contributions in the field of natural resource management, especially minerals and energy, and disaster management in Indonesia. Some of his work in the discovery of rare earth metals in Sulawesi are considered essential in the industrial sector. Especially in the era of green energy, his discovery can be an alternative to fossil energy. Prof. Adi Maulana successfully proposed disaster education subject to be a subject at the high school level in South Sulawesi. With this implementation, South Sulawesi is one of the first provinces in Indonesia to include disaster education as a special subject for high school students.



THE INTERNATIONAL OFFICE OF HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY SELECTS 16 STUDENT VOLUNTEERS



The International Office Student Volunteer (SV) is a team of students selected by the International Office (IO) to assist the internationalization in various events. This is the first time IO appoints student volunteers.

Students who become international student volunteers could get a great opportunity to interact directly with international students who come to UNHAS. In addition to exploring their potential and language skills, they can also learn about cross-cultural understanding which will be useful for them when they get the opportunity to study abroad in the future.

Sixteen SVs were selected through a competitive process with 98 candidates. The IO team sorted the applicants based on the applicable files and requirements. Applicants who passed the first screening then interviewed by the IO team. The SV admission will be conducted annually.

On August 23, 2022, they were officially inaugurated by the Vice Rector for Partnership, Innovation, Entrepreneurship, and Business, Prof. Adi Maulana. He expressed his hope for the Student Volunteers that the members could get new experiences and could develop themselves further. He also encouraged the SVs to apply for the International Student Mobility Awards (IISMA), and other overseas scholarships.

Adi Maulana, ST., M.Phil, as well as the Dean of the Faculty of Public Health, Prof. Sukri Palutturi. In addition, Nick Faulkner was not alone in socializing the most prestigious scholarship program in the United Kingdom. Also present was an alumnus of the Chevening program, Arifah Nababan.

In his speech, Prof. Sukri Palutturi, conveyed the background of this activity. He said he wanted to inform students about scholarship opportunities to study in the UK, especially the Chevening scholarship program. On the same occasion, Prof. Adi Maulana, before opening the event, also said that UNHAS, especially in his field, would also be committed to expanding the reach of partnerships so that information on scholarship opportunities like this was more widely echoed.

UNHAS will continue to strive to expand the network so that information and opportunities like this are wide open to our students. This of course aims to motivate our students to look for as many opportunities as possible to study abroad. On the main schedule moderated by Nur Arifah, SKM, MA (FKM Lecturer), Nick Faulkner introduced and explained Chevening Scholarships in general. This Chevening Scholarship is a scholarship from the British government funded by the Foreign and Commonwealth Office (FCO) which offers opportunities for young people around the world to continue their studies in the UK.



PROFESSOR OF INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY LAW AT THE UNIVERSITY OF NOTTINGHAM DELIVERS A PUBLIC LECTURE HELD BY THE FACULTY OF LAW

Hasanuddin University, Faculty of Law, held a guest lecture entitled "The TRIPS Waiver for Vaccine Patents" by Prof. Dr. Paul LC Torremans, Professor of Intellectual Property Law at the University of Nottingham, UK. The activity was carried out online via the Zoom platform on Thursday (10/20). The public lecture was officially opened by the Deputy Dean for Academic and Student Affairs, Dr. Maskun, S.H., L.LM., and guided by Nilasari, SH, as the moderator, who is an alumnus of the Faculty of Law, UNHAS, and LL.M. candidate at the Faculty of Law, University of Nottingham, UK.

Prof. Dr. Paul LC Torremans began the public lecture by explaining the rationale for legal protection of patent rights. The obligation of legal protection for patent rights is regulated in Article 27 of the Agreement on Trade-Related Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights, or TRIPS. It also describes the provision of voluntary licenses by patent holders under Article 31 of TRIPS, which has been practiced by Johnson & Johnson as a patent holder in South Africa.

The World Trade Organization (WTO) Agreement, or the Marrakesh Agreement, in Article IX, Paragraph 3, Point a, regulates the waiver of multilateral trade agreement obligations for WTO member countries. Prof. Dr. Paul LC Torremans said that the waiver is a political process that needs a political decision. The reasons for the importance of waivers for vaccine patents include increasing vaccine production and distribution. But there is also rejection of the waiver for vaccine patents due to the perspective that it is counterproductive in terms of innovation, trade secret issues, and limited raw materials.



THE NURSING FACULTY OF HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY HOSTS A GUEST LECTURER WITH A SPEAKER FROM KAIKOUKAI WELLNESS CENTER



The Nursing Science Study Program of the Faculty of Nursing at Hasanuddin University hosted a visiting lecture featuring a guest speaker from Japan, Moriyama Yoshifumi (General Manager of Kaikoukai Wellness Center and Rehabilitation Department at Nagoya Kyoritsu Hospital).

Moriyama Yoshifumi delivered a lecture with the topic "Use of Handgrip and Measurement of Muscle Mass," which was conducted at the Lecture Room of the Faculty of Nursing UNHAS, Tamalanrea Campus, on Friday (21/10). Moriyama Yoshifumi explained about sarcopenia, which is a condition of decreased muscle mass and decreased muscle strength and physical function, or weakened strength due to age. The leg circumference for the standard diagnosis of sarcopenia is below 34 cm for men and below 33 cm for women.

The walking evaluation was based on the frailty diagnosis standard, which calculates the speed of normal walking for 5 meters within 5 seconds. Other assessments on the Short Physical Performance Battery (SPPB) include measuring the length of time standing on one leg and assessing the distance of fast walking in six minutes. This SPPB test aims to take measurements with 3 tests, namely balance tests, walking speed, and sitting and standing from a chair.



CAPACITY BUILDING FOR STUDENT VOLUNTEERS BY INTERNATIONAL OFFICE

As one of the strategic steps to increase the capacity of 16 student volunteer members, the International Office of Hasanuddin University held a workshop entitled "Capacity Building for Student Volunteers". This workshop took place at UNHAS Hotel and Convention for 2 days, October 22-23, 2022.

This activity was officially opened by Prof. Dr. Eng. Adi Maulana, ST., M.Phil., the Vice-Rector for Partnership, Innovation, Entrepreneurship, and Business. In his remarks, Prof. Adi expressed his gratitude to the speakers and participants. He said that UNHAS continues to increase the capacity of insight, skills, and knowledge for students, especially student volunteers who have been very helpful for the university.

For 2 days, student volunteers participated in several programs such as; 1) How to be an Effective Volunteer; 2) Basic Hospitality and Hospitality Management; 3) Leadership and Team Management; and 4) Public Speaking. The program consisted of lectures, group work, and project.







THE FACULTY OF PHARMACY VISITS SEVERAL UNIVERSITIES IN THE UNITED KINGDOM TO ESTABLISH COOPERATION

Faculty of Pharmacy, Hasanuddin University, represented by Prof. Dr. rer nat Marianti A. Manggau, Apt., Yulia Yusrini Djabir, M.Si, MBMSc, Ph.D, Apt., and Firzan Nainu, M.Biomed.Sc, Ph.D, Apt., visited several universities in the United Kingdom, namely the University of Cambridge, King's College London in Great Britain, and Queens University of Belfast in Northern Ireland on September 19 - October 3, 2022.

The collaborative visit to the University of Cambridge resulted in an Academic and Research Agreement between the Faculty of Pharmacy and Weil Laboratory. Following up on the collaboration, Firzan Nainu, Ph.D., Apt., conducted visiting research for a month at Weil Laboratory from October 3 to October 26, 2022 to learn some of the latest wet lab methods, took part in academic discussions, and worked with Dr. Tim Weil to publish articles about the use of fruit flies Drosophila melanogaster in biomedical research.



In Queen's University Belfast, the delegation was welcomed by Dr. Niamh Buckley (Director of Internationalization), Professor David Grieve (Dean of Internationalization, Faculty of Medicine, Health and Life Sciences), Professor Colin P. McCoy (Head of School of Pharmacy), Professor Ryan F. Donnelly (Chair in Pharmaceutical Technology, School of Pharmacy). During the discussion, QUB offered to send an email draft of a Memorandum of Understanding as a follow-up to this meeting.



The next destination explored was King's College London. The KCL was represented by Professor Khuloud Al-Jamal (Head of Medicines Development), Dr. Driton Vllasaliu (Senior Lecturer), and Prof. Stuart Jones (Director of the Centre for Pharmaceutical Medicine Research). KCL accepted the offer of cooperation, which was considered to provide mutual benefits to both institutions, especially for the academic and research collaboration.



FACULTY OF LAW, HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY, INVITES PROFESSOR DAVID COHEN FROM STANFORD UNIVERSITY TO DELIVER A PUBLIC LECTURE



The Faculty of Law of Hasanuddin University held a Public Discussion with the theme "The Role of the Academic Community and CSO Human Rights Defenders in Guarding Human Rights Court of Paniai Case" with a speaker from Stanford University, Professor David Cohen, on Tuesday, October 26, 2022.

Dean of the Faculty of Law UNHAS, Prof. Dr. Hamzah Halim in his remarks, welcomed and felt honored with Prof. Cohen's

presence at UNHAS. Prof. Cohen is an International Human Rights Law Expert who also the Founding Director of the Center for Human Rights and International Justice Studies at Stanford University. This activity was expected be a good start for cooperation with Stanford University in education and human resource development.

Prof. Cohen in his general lecture explained that in judging cases of gross human rights violations, especially related to crimes against humanity, judges must first identify whether the act meets the contextual elements of crimes against humanity itself to prove that an act of crimes against humanity has been committed. The contextual elements are systematic, widespread, and attacks directed against civilian populations. If one of the elements is not met, then an act cannot be judged as a Crime Against Humanity.

In closing, Prof. Cohen said that the academic community, especially students, have the opportunity to gain legal understanding and skills that will be carried regardless of any role in the future. Prof. Dr. Iin Karita Sakharina, S.H., M.A. as the moderator also added that by holding this public discussion, it is hoped that it can strengthen the role of all parties in overseeing the trial process of the Paniai Human Rights Court, especially the academic community in order to break the chain of impunity and restore the rights of victims.

This public discussion was moderated directly by the Vice Dean for Planning, Resources and Alumni, Prof. Dr. Iin Karita Sakharina, S.H., M.A. because she also happens to be one of the lecturers in the field of human rights with expertise in international human rights.
