THE FACULTY OF NURSING, UNHAS HOLDS THE 5TH INTERNATIONAL NURSING AND HEALTH SCIENCES STUDENTS AND HEALTH PROFESSIONALS CONFERENCE



The Faculty of Nursing (FKep), Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) held the 5th International Nursing and Health Sciences Students and Health Professional Conference (INHSP) 2023 in celebrating the 67th UNHAS Anniversary Tuesday - Wednesday, August 22-23, 2023 at UNHAS Hotel and Convention. The theme of the conference was "Health Equity for All: Advancing Sustainable development Goals (SDGs) Achievement through Collaborative Innovation.

FACULTY OF CULTURAL SCIENCES, UNHAS DISCUSSES THE EXTENSION OF MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING AND THE ESTABLISHMENT OF KOREAN LANGUAGE STUDY PROGRAM WITH HANKOOK UNIVERSITY OF FOREIGN STUDIES, SEOUL, KOREA



The Faculty of Cultural Sciences (FIB) team visited Hankook University of Foreign Studies (HUFS) in Seoul to discuss extending cooperation between Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) and HUFS. In addition to developing the collaboration, the FIB UNHAS team also discussed plans to open a Korean language study program at UNHAS. Present at this meeting was the Vice President of HUFS for General Affairs and Cooperation, Prof. Jung Sang Chul, and the Chairman of the Department of Malay-Indonesian Translation and Interpretation, Prof. Seung Won Song, and the FIB UNHAS team consisting of Prof. Dr. Nurhayati, M. Hum., Dr. Munirah, M. Hum and Muhammad Syahrum, S.S., M, Hum. This meeting was held on Monday, August 28, 2023, at the Global Yongin campus in South Korea.

Before this meeting, the FIB UNHAS Team had presented papers at the 2023 Annual International Conference of the Korean Association of Southeast Asian Studies (KASEAS) at Jeonbuk National University, Jeun Ju, from 25-26 August 2023.

Furthermore, the FIB UNHAS team also met with the Indonesian Educational and Cultural Attache for South Korea at the Indonesian Embassy in Seoul. The FIB UNHAS Team, Tuesday, August 29, 2023, was received directly by Mr. Gogot Suharwanto, Ph.D. This was an essential visit because the FIB Team conveyed the potential for opening a Korean Language study program at UNHAS. FACULTY OF NURSING, HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY HOLDS A GUEST LECTURE FROM KANAZAWA UNIVERSITY



The Faculty of Nursing (FKep), Hasanuddin University (UNHAS), through the Department of Physiotherapy, held a Guest Lecture from Kanazawa University. This event was held on Friday, August 25, 2023, at *Lembaga Penelitian dan Pengabdian Masyarakat* (LP2M) or Institute of Research and Community Development Hall building from 8 a.m. to 12 p.m Central Indonesia Time (CIT). The Guest Lecture was presented by Masami Yokogawa, Ph.D., RPT from the Department of Physical Therapy, Faculty of Health Sciences, the Institute of Medical, Pharmaceutical and Health Sciences. The lecture was officially opened by the Vice Dean for Academic and Student Affairs, Syahrul Said, S.Kep., Ns.,M.Kes., Ph.D., followed by the lecturers and students from the Department of Physiotherapy, UNHAS.

The speaker, Masami Yokogawa, Ph,D said that Kanazawa University received foreign countries students for clinical first-year students, and this year, some students went to foreign countries to visit and observe. This phase was significant for our students. Moreover, she said that right now, the university provides no scholarships. However, any prospective student might be supervised by professors from the university.

In addition, the Head of the Physiotherapy Department, Andi Besse Ahsaniyah, S.Ft.Physio., M. Kes., said that Physiotherapist was considered a growing profession in Indonesia, and this lecture could support the internationalization in UNHAS and increase our students' knowledge with the most updated information in Physiotherapy. Therefore, seeing the audience, there were clinicians and procession students. Thus, the knowledge obtained might be applied here in Indonesia. This cross-border collaboration provided a deeper understanding of the international approach to physiotherapy.





FACULTY OF MARINE SCIENCES AND FISHERIES, UNHAS FORGES COLLABORATION WITH ORIENTAL CONSULTANT GLOBAL JAPAN



On Wednesday, August 30, 2023, representatives from the Faculty of Marine Science and Fisheries (FIKP) at Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) convened with the representatives of Oriental Consultant Global (OC Global) Japan. The meeting was held at the Senate Room, 2nd floor of FIKP UNHAS. The delegation from FIKP UNHAS was led by its Dean, Dr. Safruddin, along with Dr. Ahmad Faizal, Vice Dean for Partnerships, Research, and Innovation, Dr. Khairul Amri, Head of the Department of Marine Science, and Dr. Syafiuddin, Head of the Marine Station. Deputy General Manager Mitsukage Yamada, PMP Mr. Kubota, and Chief Engineer Ir represented the OC Global team. Umar Sulaiman, MT.

The initial discussions during the meeting paved the way for a follow-up session involving Prof. Adi Maulana, Vice-Rector for Innovation, Entrepreneurship, and Business Cooperation, held at the 6th-floor meeting room in UNHAS' rectorate building. This subsequent meeting sought potential collaboration areas between UNHAS and OC Global, including solar panels, seawater desalination, ice production plants, cold storage facilities, and community development projects to support local fishermen.

These collaborative initiatives were set to unfold on Barrang Lompo Island, located in Makassar. On the second day, Thursday, August 31, 2023, the FIKP UNHAS team accompanied their counterparts from OC Global on a visit to the UNHAS Marine Station on Barrang Lompo Island. This joint visit aimed to foster a deeper understanding of the local marine environment, enabling both teams to identify practical and effective solutions for the proposed collaborative projects.

The partnership between FIKP UNHAS and OC Global Japan marks a milestone in marine, fisheries, and sustainable development. This collaboration showcases both institutions' commitment to advancing knowledge and technology and highlights their dedication to fostering positive change and development within the region. This partnership is poised to make meaningful contributions to academic and practical domains through joint efforts and shared expertise, setting an example for future collaborations between the two institutions.



FACULTY OF ENGINEERING STUDENTS COMPLETE THE EXCHANGE PROGRAM IN UNIVERSITI SAINS MALAYSIA



Three students of the Industrial Engineering Study Program, Faculty of Engineering (FT), just completed their participation in the Universiti Sains Malaysia (USM) Exchange Program during the summer semester of 2023, from March to August. These three students were; Nurul Fakhira, Muhammad Furqon Izzulhaq, and Muhammad Fahryl A. Yani. They were enthusiastic about this new experience because they had been interacting with international students from diverse cultural backgrounds. USM has over 4,000 international students out of 28,000 on three campuses: the Kubang Kerian Campus in Kelantan for the Medical School, the Nibong Tebal Campus for engineering schools, and the Minden Campus in Penang as the main campus.

During the program, the students went through numerous activities such as Orientation Week (OW), Coffee Hours Class, Coffee Hours Day, and Campus Life. The OW was an introduction to Malaysia Cultural Exposure session, chilling and grilling, in which students were acquitted among them. Campus Tour introduced the campuses to the students, ice-breaking activities in which students got to know each other; sweat it off was an activity to get their body fit and avoid tiredness during the week.



Meanwhile, the Coffee Hour Class was designed to introduce the culture of Indonesian students from Brawijaya University, Muhammadiyah University of Malang, East Java, and, of course, Hasanuddin University. The students presented food and beverages, clothes, and music. Several students from Japan, Thailand, Germany, and Malaysia attended this event. In addition, the next activity was Coffee Hour Day. It was similar to the Coffee Hour Class. However, this event was more like a cultural exhibition and was attended by more international students from the United States of America (USA), Japan, China, Malaysia, Nigeria, and many more.

The last activity was Campus Life. In this activity, the students took three courses with nine credits in this program. They also had the opportunity to be mentored by a USM Faculty of Engineering lecturer as a co-supervisor on our thesis. They faced various challenges because all lectures were in English. In addition, the semester exams were also very strict with difficult questions. The three courses taken were Business Statistics and Introduction to Data Analytics from the School of Management and Project Management from the School of Engineering. This was such an outstanding program, and they expected other students from the FT to take part in building their global horizons and experience.

Kemitraan Negara Berkembang (KNB), or Developing Country Partnership, is a scholarship awarded to prospective students from developing countries around the globe and is managed by Lembaga Pengelola Dana Pendidikan (LPDP) or Indonesia Endowment Fund for Education. In Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) itself, there have been three recipients of this scholarship currently studying, namely Andrea Sofia Aleman Garcia of Honduras, a semester three student at the Faculty of Marine Sciences and Fisheries, Anwar Muneer Abdo Othman of Yemen, a semester three student at the Faculty of Engineering and Kanchul Loius Mendy of Gambia, a semester three student at the Faculty of Law.

UNHAS, as the host university of the KNB recipients, went through a monitoring and evaluation phase on Thursday, August 31, 2023, in Meeting Room A, 7th floor of the Rectorate Building. The meeting was attended by the Money Team from the Institutional Directorate, Ministry of Education and Culture, Higher Education, Research and Technology were Wahyu Hidayat, Armani, and Andita Pratiwi. Meanwhile, from the UNHAS side, the attendees were Andi Masyitha Irwan, Ph.D. (Head of the International Office), Nurul Ichsani, S.Sos., M.I.Kom (Head of the Sub-Directorate of the Admission Office), Catharina S.E, M.M (Head of the Sub-Directorate of Students Welfare), Dra. The report showed that the student's academic achievements were excellent, with 3,9 GPAs respectively. In addition, the students' nonacademic achievements were also reported, such as Kanchul Louis being elected as the President of UNHAS International Students Association, Andrea Aleman was invited to speak about climate change, and having a chance to get together with Mr. Ridwan Kamil, the Governor of West Java. UNHAS DELEGATES PARTICIPATE IN THE 2023 INTERNATIONAL ACADEMIC CONSORTIUM FOR SUSTAINABLE CITIES HELD BY THAMMASAT UNIVERSITY, THAILAND



Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) delegates successfully attended the 2023 International Academic Consortium for Sustainable Cities (IACSC) held by Thammasat University from Wednesday, August 23, 2023, to Friday, September 1, 2023, in Rangsit, Pathum Thani Province, Thailand. This Consortium conducts collaborative activities among universities from various countries to contribute to a sustainable society. It helps students from multiple majors and universities to collaborate to address urban and planning advantages.

The IACSC 2023 consisted of Sustainable Urban Development Program (SUDP) and International Urban Planning Workshop (IUPW) programs, which was participated by six universities, such as Yokohama City University (Japan), University of The Philippines (Philippines), Universiti Sains Malaysia (Malaysia), Vietnam National University (Vietnam), Thammasat University (Thailand), and Hasanuddin University (Indonesia). The SUDP was participated by Ghina Ulfiani Anugrah (Faculty of Public Health) and Jaysti Kine (Faculty of Nursing). Two UNHAS delegates named, Andi Nurul Inayah (Faculty of Engineering) in the IUPW program and Ghina Ulfiani Anugrah (Faculty of Public Health), proceeded to give an oral presentation in IACSC Consortium to share their group's ideas about urban development and society. The idea was called "Thailand Peri-urbanization with Sustainability Settlement" by Andi Nurul Inayah from the group of IUPW and "Preventing Vector-borne Diseases Caused by Breeding Site Mismanagement" by Ghina Ulfiani Anugrah's group of SUDP. These groups were selected as one of the top 3 groups from each program to present their ideas in front of Yokohama City University's Senior Advisor, Global Cooperation Institute for Sustainable Cities, Hidefumi Imura, and the United Nations Human Settlements Programme (UN-HABITAT) representatives, Clinton Moore and Tam Hoang.

On 29 – 31 August 2023, the Agricultural Engineering Study Program, Faculty of Agriculture (Faperta), Hasanuddin University (UNHAS), invited Prof. Dr. techn. Heidi Halbwirth from the Institute of Chemical, Environmental and Bioscience Engineering, Technology University of Vienna (TU Wien), Austria, to carry out case-based and project-based course content redesign workshops, Focus Group Discussions (FGD) for developing research collaborations, and public lectures. These activities are a series of activities for the *Pendidikan Tinggi* (DIKTI) or Higher Education Independent Campus Competition Program (PKKM) scheme obtained by the Agricultural Engineering Study Program, UNHAS.

During this visit, Prof. Heidi carried out public lecture activities at Lecture Theater 6 (LT 6) Faperta UNHAS, which was attended by 103 participants consisting of students and lecturers from the Agricultural Engineering Study Program and the Agricultural Science and Technology Study Program.
