



THE INTERNATIONAL OFFICE, HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY HOLDS ROADSHOW ON VISA MANAGEMENT FOR FOREIGN STUDENTS AND RESEARCHERS FOR THE MEDICAL COMPLEX AND AGRO COMPLEX ACADEMIC COMMUNITY



The International Office (IO), Hasanuddin University held a roadshow series on the Visa Arrangement for Foreign Students and Researchers and was attended by the academic community from Medical and Agro Complex. The first roadshow was hosted by the Faculty of Dentistry (FKG) and was officially opened by drg. Irfan Sugianto, M.Med.Ed., Ph.D (Dean). This first roadshow was held on Thursday, April 18, 2024 at 1pm Central Indonesia Time (CIT) at Molar Hall, FKG. The roadshow began with a remark from the Head of International Office (IO), Andi Masyitha Irwan, Ph.D. In her remark, Ms. Citha said that the roadshow aimed at building a strong understanding about the visa arrangement among the academic community. In addition, as the bureau foreign cooperation has been merged to the IO, it is the IO responsibility to spread the information to the whole university.

Next, drg. Irfan welcomed the roadshow and expressed his gratitude for hosting this roadshow. He continued by saying that the IO has been playing its great role in implementing the internationalization program at UNHAS. He also added that the IO so far distributed the weekly news unstoppable. He finally said that through this roadshow, the visa arrangement would in turn improve and affect numbers of inbound students and researchers. After the opening, the photo session was taken. The roadshow moved on to the presentation about visa arrangement by Saaduddin, M.Sc. (IO Task Force) and Dra. Harniaty Hamid (Head of Foreign Cooperation). The roadshow at FKG was moderated by Erni Marlina, drg., Ph.D., Sp.PM.Sub.Inf(K).

The second roadshow was held on Friday, April 19, 2024 at 1pm Central Indonesia Time (CIT) hosted by the Faculty of Agriculture (Faperta) at Faperta Meeting Hall. Likewise at FKG, Prof. Dr. Ir. Salengke, M.Sc (Dean) officially opened the roadshow and was joined by the academic community from the Faculty of Agriculture (Faperta), Faculty of Forestry (Fahut), Faculty of Animal Sciences (Fapet) and Faculty of Marine Sciences and Fisheries (FIKP). The roadshow was moderated by Dr. Muhammad Fuad Anshori.

In his remark, Prof. Salengke hoped that the roadshow would bring the audiences deep understanding with the visa arrangement. He said that the official invitation of the roadshow was sent to all study programs at this faculty. However, due to the schedule, it is found that not so many people joined. He also suggested that should we have known earlier that numbers of audiences were less, the faculty still has another room that suits with around 30 participants. However, he expected the audiences to actively participate in the roadshow. Andi Masyitha Irwan, Ph.D (Head of IO) also spoke about the aim of the roadshow as she did at FKG, one day earlier and expressed her gratitude to the audiences joining this roadshow. After the opening, the photo session was taken and continued with the visa arrangement presentation by Saaduddin, M.Sc. (IO Task Force) and Dra. Harniaty Hamid (Head of Foreign Cooperation).

HOLDING PUBLIC LECTURE, FACULTY OF LAW, HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY PRESENTS THE DEAN OF FACULTY OF LAW FROM UNIVERSIDADE DA PAZ FROM TIMOR LESTE



In the context of the 72nd Anniversary of the Faculty of Law (FH) Hasanuddin University (UNHAS), it again held a public lecture with the theme "Local Wisdom in improving tourism". This public lecture presented Mr. Dr. Leonito Riberio, S.H., M.H. (Dean of the Faculty of Law, Universidade da Paz from Timor Leste) and moderated by Mrs. Fadilla Jamila S.H., LL.M from the Civil Law Department. This activity took place in a hybrid manner in the Video Conference room and was officially opened by the chairman of the Quality Assurance and Reputation Improvement Group, Dr. Winner Sitorus, S.H., M.H., LL.M.

In his speech, Dr. Winner Sitorus said, "Thank you to Dr. Leonito Riberio for your willingness to give a public lecture for Faculty of Law students." Mr. Winner also said that the theme raised was very interesting because it could give us all an idea regarding how to improve the tourism sector for progress in increasing the potential of a region both nationally and internationally, and of course this will influence the progress of a country so that material This is important for us to look at together".

The material presented by Mr. Dr. Leonito Riberio, S.H., M.H. more specifically discussing investment in developing tourist attractions in Timor Leste, sustainable development efforts. "Utilization of tourist attractions for a region or even a country because tourist attractions are one component of community empowerment in the economic sector. So it will indirectly have an impact on the daily income of local communities through activities that have traditional artistic characteristics to attract tourists, both domestic and foreign," he said.

Furthermore, the resource person also said that developing the tourism sector itself has become the best choice for regions that have great potential, such as that of the country of Timor Leste. Because the development of this sector has a huge impact, especially for a region to increase development, create job opportunities and can provide local information from interactions with foreign tourists.

Apart from that, the development of the tourism sector is also a priority in National policy until 2023, namely emphasizing the development and development of the tourism sector as a manifestation of National identity.

This public lecture was attended by 80 students who attended offline and around 33 students who attended online. During the discussion or question and answer session, the students were also very interactive in asking questions to the resource person. At the end of the material, the resource person said that every country definitely has its own challenges or obstacles in efforts to improve the tourism sector. One of the obstacles faced in developing tourist areas in cities in Timor-Leste is the current weakness in tourism promotion because it still tends to be ceremonial and only part of the work routine.

For this reason, to face these obstacles requires cooperation from various sectors, starting from the government, related agencies and also the community. This activity closed with the virtual presentation of a certificate of appreciation to Mr. Dr. Leonito Riberio, S.H., M.H as a resource person.





FACULTY OF MEDICINE EXTENDS THE COLLABORATION WITH THE SCHOOL OF MEDICINE, CHIBA UNIVERSITY, JAPAN.



The collaboration between the Faculty of Medicine (FK), Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) and the School of Medicine Chiba University has been established since 2018 involving the Department of Pediatrics in the form of guest lectures, visiting lectures and outbound lectures as well as research collaboration with the VITADi Study (research about Vit. D for children) and TINKERBELL study (stunting reseach). On Tuesday, April 16 2024 a meeting was held between the two faculties which was initiated by the Vice Dean for Publications, Community Service and International Affairs, Dr. dr. Rina Masadah, M.Phil DFM, Sp.PA(K).

At the meeting, an extension of cooperation was signed, represented by Dr. dr. Aidah Juliaty A.Baso, Sp.A(K) (Head of Pediatric Health Department) and Prof. Hiromichi Hamada (Head of Pediatric Department, School of Medicine, Chiba University) by knowing Prof. Dr. dr. Haerani Rasyid, Sp.PD-KGH, Sp.GK, M.Kes. (Dean of FK UNHAS) and Dr. Toshinori Nakayama (Dean of the School of Medicine, Chiba University). Dr Rina Masadah said, "In the future, collaboration with Chiba University will involve more departments with more diverse forms of activities, especially research collaboration and international publications."

In order to level up Hasanuddin University (UNHAS)'s students participation in International Indonesian Students Mobility Awards (IISMA), the International Office (IO), Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) conducted the IISMA camp provided for the IISMA co-funding applicants. This event was attended by 6 potential candidates, four IISMA Alumni, student volunteers as well as the IO crews. The camp was held on Saturday, April 20, 2024 and took place at Lembaga Sertifikasi Profesi (LSP) or Professional Certification Institute and IO shared room.

The events consisted of four main agendas; choosing the right university and course, essay coaching, interview coaching as well as some advice on being overseas. Khaeruddin, Ph.D (IO Task Force) opened the camp by giving some talks and reflection to these potential candidates to remain consistent, and persistent on their dreams. In addition, he elaborated the support and service of IO as well as the university for the upcoming awardees. Similarly, Saaduddin, M.Sc.(IO Task Force) reminds the participants to be more wise in choosing the host universities, mainly the countries. He considered participants' parent ability on the fundings as this IISMA co funding is not fully covered by the Indonesian government through *Lemabaga Pengelola Dana Pendidikan* (LPDP) or Indonesia Endowment Fund for Education Agency.

The first session began with the essay coaching involving four IISMA Alumni and IO Task Forces as supervisors. Initially, they talked about structures, elaborations, and word choices.

The second session then continued to Interview tips and tricks. All invited IISMA alumni came with their valuable interview experiences, and advice on how to tackle questions from interviewers. These two agendas lasted for one hour each and should be interrupted by lunch time. Once it was done, the events then continued with the last session "what to do next". This session covered a more interactive discussion and advice to increase the participants' awareness on finalizing their application as well as more technical discussion.





During the meeting, it was also agreed to increase the number of colleagues as part of efforts to improve the academic reputation of FK UNHAS. This step is expected to make a positive contribution in improving the reputation and ranking of FK UNHAS on the world university scale. Currently, FK UNHAS is ranked 651-700 in the world in the field of medicine in 2024. Dr. Rina, as Deputy Dean for Publications, Community Service and International Affairs FK UNHAS, stated. "We hope that this collaboration will provide great benefits for both institutions and encourage progress in the field of medicine," said Dr. Rina.
