### HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY WELCOMES AUCKLAND UNIVERSITY OF TECHNOLOGY DELEGATION TO STRENGTHEN ACADEMIC AND RESEARCH COLLABORATION



On Monday, July 29th, 2024, a delegation from Auckland University of Technology (AUT), led by Professor Guy Littlefair, Pro Vice-Chancellor International and Dean of the Faculty of Design and Creative Technologies, and Professor Tek Tjing Lie, Head of the School of Engineering, Computer and Mathematical Sciences, paid a courtesy visit to Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) in Makassar, Indonesia. In the morning, the AUT team met with Dr Eng. Ir. Muh Rusman, MT, Vice Dean of Planning, Resources, and Alumni of UNHAS' Engineering Faculty (FT), Head of the Centre of Technology, secretary of Quality Assurance and Reputation Enhancement Unit, Heads of Departments, and Heads of Laboratories. The meeting agreed to seek potential academic and research cooperation in areas of mutual interest, such as educational material and scholar exchanges, student mobility, cooperative seminars, workshops, and other scholarly activities.

To strengthen these relationships, the two institutions agreed to convene a webinar in September 2024 to discuss potential research collaborations. The AUT team also visited other UNHAS laboratories to investigate research interests and possible opportunities for cooperation. In addition to academic discussions, the AUT team traveled to the teaching industry to meet with Dr. Fauzi R Rahim, SE, MSi CFP, AEPP, Director of Technology Business Incubation and Science Technopark. This meeting was intended to investigate the prospects for innovation and technology transfer between the two institutions.

The delegation wrapped up their visit by meeting with Dr Ansariadi, SKM, MSc, PhD, the UNHAS Director of Partnership, and Asmi Citra Malina, PhD, Director of Innovation and Intellectual Property in the UNHAS level 4 rectorate building. These sessions aimed to establish strategic alliances and improve collaboration in various disciplines. This visit demonstrated both institutions' commitment to establishing international academic and research relationships, critical for advancing knowledge and innovation worldwide.



# THE FACULTY OF PUBLIC HEALTH, HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY STUDENTS PARTICIPATE IN THE STUDENTS EXCHANGE PROGRAM AT OKAYAMA UNIVERSITY, JAPAN



Six students from the Faculty of Public Health (FKM) Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) participated in the Exchange Student Program at Okayama University, Japan. This program aimed at strengthening academic and cultural relations between the two countries and provided valuable learning experiences for students. The exchange program was started on July 9th-12th, 2024. It was a part of the Outbound Student Exchange Program in order to support UNHAS as a World Class University (WCU).

During the first day visit, FKM UNHAS students were welcomed by the Dean of Faculty of Science Okayama University accompanied by the coordinator of the Exchange Student, Prof. Kuroda Masahiro. The Dean said that he was extremely pleased to host the group of students and thanked them for visiting Okayama University, especially at the Faculty of Science.

After the welcoming speech, students then received lectures related to Public Health at the Faculty of Public Health, Okayama University and were delivered by from Prof. Hideyuki Kanda, MPH, Ph.D. In this session, students learned and shared experiences about the history of Okayama University, including how they manage the foreign students by providing excellence in research; excellence in education; affordable campus life; safe and convenient; friendly and welcoming. Moreover, Prof. Hideyuki Kanda also explained that there are 5 (five) majors in the Faculty of Public Health, Okayama University including industrial health, health sport, health sociology, nutrition, and epidemiology. And at the end of the session, Prof. Kanda explained about the main and scope projects on blood pressure as well as related factors and the advantages and disadvantages of electronic sports, internet technology and health care for students.

On the second day, the students were also invited to visit tourist sites in Okayama such as historical places in Okayama, and enjoyed the fireworks party (*Hanabi*) which was an annual program for Japanese people every summer. At the farewell event, Prof. Kuroda Masahiro said that their students would also visit Universitas Hasanuddin especially at The Faculty of Public Health (FKM) in September 2024 as the student exchange partner with UNHAS.

The conference was held in The Saujana Hotel with more than 100 participants, 74 papers that came from various countries i.e.. Indonesia, India, Thailand, South Korea, Japan, and China. The chairperson of the 2 Decades event, Dr.-Ing. Venny Veronica Natalia, ST., MT also joined the conference and represented the department in achieving the token of appreciation from the UM committee.

The four papers presented in the conference were Route Determination of Bike Sharing Services as A Solution towards a Social Sustainable City in Makassar – Indonesia (Arifuddin Akil, Venny Veronica Natalia, Sri Wahyuni, and Alfiana Muhsinin), Mobility Culture of Gen Z for Future Transport System: A View from A City in Developing Country (Venny Veronica Natalia), Urban Heat Island Dynamics in Response to Land Cover Change in Urban Area (Isfa Sastrawati, Reyhan Regisha, Ihsan, and Abdul Rachman Rasyid), and Effectiveness of The Livable Home Financing Program District National Zakat Amil Agency (Baznas) Enrekang Regency (Mimi Arifin, Shirly Wunas, Wiwik Wahidah Osman, Jayanti Mandasari Andi Munawarah Abduh, Gafar Lakatupa, and Muhajirin). The international collaboration was expected to promote the UNHAS Internationalization program and increase the opportunity to be a reputable university globally.
