The Faculty of Dentistry (FKG) at Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) has officially launched the "International Dental Summer Course 2024" in collaboration with the Dentistry Program at Udayana University (Unud) Bali, under the theme "Discovering Eastern Indonesia." The opening ceremony took place in the Molar Room of FKG UNHAS on Monday, August 5th, 2024.

Attendees at the opening included Dr. H. Muhammad Ichsan Mustari, MHM, representing the Acting Governor of South Sulawesi and serving as the Assistant for Economics and Development of the South Sulawesi Provincial Government; Prof. Muhammad Ruslin, drg., M.Kes., Ph.D., Sp.B.M.M., Subsp.Ortognat-D (K), Vice Rector for Academic and Student Affairs of UNHAS; the Head of the International Affairs Office of UNHAS; leaders within FKG UNHAS; faculty staff; and members of the FKG UNHAS academic community.

The event was inaugurated with remarks from Dr. drg. Putu Lestari Sudirman, M. Biomed, Head of the Dentistry Undergraduate Program at Udayana University, Bali, delivered online via Zoom. This was followed by a speech from the Dean of FKG UNHAS, Irfan Sugianto, drg., M.Med.Ed., Ph.D., who expressed gratitude to the Udayana Dentistry Program for their collaboration in making this event possible.

The course aims to introduce Indonesian culture, facilitate cultural exchange among participants, enrich knowledge in the field of dentistry, and increase the number of inbound students at UNHAS. The event includes 20 participants from Niigata University, Japan, and international and international class students from FKG UNHAS.



Following, Prof. Muhammad Ruslin, drg., M.Kes., Ph.D., Sp.B.M.M., Subsp.Ortognat-D (K) addressed the participants, offering encouragement and motivation to engage enthusiastically in the program. This partnership aims to develop a battery swapping station and install a solar power plant that will supply electricity to the battery swapping station. Santomo, Shuntaro Yamaguchi, in the presence of the Vice Dean for Resource Planning and Alumni, the Vice Dean for Research and Technology Partnerships, and witnessed by staff from PT. INTERNATIONAL COLLABORATION: FACULTY OF MEDICINE, HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY AND ERASMUS MC ROTTERDAM TACKLE HARD-TO-TREAT INFECTIONS



The Clinical Microbiology Study Program of the Faculty of Medicine (FK), Hasanuddin University (UNHAS), in collaboration with Erasmus MC Rotterdam, held a guest lecture titled "How to Fight Difficult to Treat Infections" on Monday, July 5th, 2024. The event was officially opened by the Dean of FK UNHAS, Prof. Dr. Haerani Rasyid, M.Kes., Sp.PD, K-GH, Sp.GK, FINASIM, accompanied by the Vice Dean for Planning, Resources, and Alumni, Dr. Firdaus Hamid, Ph.D., Sp.MK(K), and the Head of the Department of Microbiology, Dr. A. R. Sultan, DMM., M.Sc., Ph.D., Sp.MK.

"This event marks an important step in international collaboration and the advancement of knowledge at FK UNHAS, while also strengthening academic and research networks with leading institutions worldwide," said Prof. Haerani. The guest lecture was conducted in a hybrid format, with 70 participants attending online and 45 participants attending in person. The participants comprised lecturers and students from the specialist medical education programs (PPDS) in Clinical Microbiology, Internal Medicine, Clinical Pathology, Clinical Nutrition, and Pharmacy.

During the event, Dean Prof. Haerani officially handed over the Decree of Appointment as Adjunct Professor to Prof. Dr. W.J.B. (Willem) Van Wamel, in recognition of his outstanding contributions to the field of clinical microbiology. In his lecture, Prof. Dr. W.J.B. (Willem) Van Wamel shared insights and research findings on difficult-to-treat infections, focusing on the challenges of biofilms and the immune system's resistance to pathogenic bacteria.



INTERNATIONAL SEMINAR 'MARUDDANI 2024' HIGHLIGHTS BUGINESE VALUES AND CULTURAL CONNECTIONS



An international seminar with the theme Maruddani 2024: Pengukuhan Budaya, Penerapan Nilai-Nilai dan Falsafah Bugis di Tanah Rantau or Maruddani 2024 or Culture Establishment, Implementation of Buginese Values and Philosophy in Regions Far from Buginese Land was held on Monday, August 5th, 2024 in the Senate Room of Faculty of Cultural Sciences (FIB), Hasanuddin University (UNHAS). The seminar was initiated by the FIB; in collaboration with the Faculty of Social Sciences and Humanity, Universiti Malaysia Sabah and Persatuan Komuniti Bugis Sabah or the Association of Buginese Community in Sabah. The program was attended by 28 participants from Sabah-Malaysia and FIB UNHAS.

This activity was aimed at strengthening and maintaining the Buginese culture in regions outside Buginese land, especially Sabah, Malaysia. It is expected that a closer relationship can be built between Buginese people in Sabah and the academic community in Indonesia. One of the main aspects emphasized in this seminar was the importance of establishing culture and the implementation of Buginese values and philosophy in regions far from Buginese land. Prof. Dr. Akin Duli, M.A., Dean of FIB said that Buginese culture has an important role in maintaining the identity of Buginese community living in various parts of the world, including Sabah, Malaysia. Therefore, joint-researches on history, culture, and archaeology are very important to maintain an academic thread and familial values of the two nations.

Dr. Ilham Daeng Makkelo, Head of History Department, also the Head of the Committee said that the values and philosophy of Buginese people like siri (self-respect), pesse (solidarity), and lempu (honesty) must be implemented and maintained in the regions far from Buginese land. He argued that Buginese culture is not only a heritage, but also a moral foundation in the daily life of Buginese people, both those living in Buginese land and in other regions.

After the seminar, participants from Sabah visited several regions in South Sulawesi from August 6th to 12th, 2024. The Dean of FIB expressed his appreciation to all people who contributed to the program. Andi Lili Evita, the moderator and member of the program committee expressed her pride and optimism that a stronger connection can be created in the future between Malaysia and Indonesia.






