

The Institutional Directorate of the Ministry Education and Culture, Research and Higher Education held a plenary meeting in deciding the recipients of the *Kemitraan Negara Berkembang (KNB)* or Partnership of Developing Countries Scholarship from Sunday-Tuesday, June 2nd-4th, 2024 at Telkom University (TU) in bandung, West Java. Joining the meeting representing Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) were Muhammad Ridwan, M.A. (International Office (IO) Secretary), Nurul Ichsani, S.Sos., M.I.Kom (Head of Sub-Directorate of Admission) and Susi Asteria Irafany, S.T., M.Si. (Head of Sub-Directorate of Educational Administration). From the ministry office were Ibu Putri Nailatul Himma and Wahyu Hidayat. Meanwhile, as the host, TU was represented by Dr Rina Pudjiastuti (Vice Rector for Research, Innovation and Partnership) and Lia Yuldinawati., Ph.D (Director of Strategic Partnership and International Office).

The plenary meeting aimed at deciding KNB-elects for the academic year of 2024/2025. The plenary required a powerful coordination among KNB host universities as known that one applicant might have applied his/her study program in two different universities.

On the other hand, the host university in deciding its KNB-elects must have noticed the first choice and the second choice of the applicants. KNB applicants who chose university A as his/her first choice and pass, might no longer be selected by another host university. The host university must select other applicants to fulfill each host university's quota. This was where coordination between each host university was needed. The recommendations from this plenary would be officially decided by the Directorate of Institutional and each host university is preparing to welcome the arrival of KNB scholarship recipients on their campus.

There were lots of Indonesian and Australian government officials, Rectors of AIC partner universities, fellow Deans, researchers, lecturers and many more.

THE FACULTY OF DENTISTRY; TWO STUDY PROGRAMS UNDERGO INTERNATIONAL ACCREDITATION VISITATION PROCESS



Two Study Programs at the Faculty of Dentistry (FKG) Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) underwent a field visitation process from the International Accreditation Institute ASIIN (*Akkreditierungsagentur für Studiengänge der Ingenieurwissenschaften, der Informatik, der Naturwissenschaften und der Mathematik*) Cluster C. The two Study Programs were the Specialist Dentist Education in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery and Master of Dental Science. The visitation process lasted for 2 days (June 5-6, 2024). ASIIN, an accreditation agency based in Germany, has been widely recognized by the international education community for its credibility and prestige in assessing and accrediting higher education programs.

The participation of FKG in the ASIIN visitation process marked the institution's commitment to improving the quality of dental education offered to students. The ASIIN assessors involved in the visitation process, namely Prof. Dr. Maria Cristina Manzanares Céspedes, (Universitat de Barcelona), Dr.med.dent. Thomas Koch., DDS, M.Biotech (Med Uni Graz), Dr. Heribertus Dedy Kusuma Yulianto, (Gadjah Mada University), Windy Sepry Marcelina Sihombing (Student at Gadjah Mada University) and Dr. Emeline Jerez, (ASIIN Office).

At the closing event, which took place in the Senate Meeting Room, 2nd Floor, UNHAS Rectorate Building, the assessors explained the results of the 2-day visitation. UNHAS rector, Prof. Dr. Ir. Jamaluddin Jompa, M.Sc., in his speech expressed his thanks to the ASIIN assessor team, as well as his appreciation for the hard work of the two study program teams involved. "We are very grateful for the in-depth and constructive evaluation from the ASIIN team. "These results will be an encouragement for us to continue to improve the quality of education and services at Unhas, in accordance with the recommendations given," explained Prof. JJ.

The Dean of FKG, Irfan Sugianto, drg., M.Med.Ed., Ph.D, also expressed his thanks and would follow up on the recommendations given by the Assessor team. He also expressed his gratitude to the UNHAS executive leaders, Heads of the 2 Study Programs involved and the Task Force team who had provided support so that the visitation process ran smoothly.





STUDENTS OF MANDARIN LANGUAGE AND CHINESE CULTURE STUDY PROGRAM COMPLETED THE 2+2 JOINT DEGREE AT NANCHANG UNIVERSITY



The students of the 2+2 Joint Degree Program from the Mandarin Language and Chinese Culture Study Program (BKMT), Faculty of Cultural Sciences (FIB), Hasanuddin University (UNHAS)-Nanchang University (NCU) class of 2020 who came to Nanchang, China, specifically in Nanchang University (南昌大学) in March 2023, have now completed their studies on June 4th, 2024. 19 students of the program have completed their thesis in Mandarin which took approximately 6 months and were declared graduates in the Chinese Language and Literature (汉语言文学) major. Faculty of Humanities (人文学院). From the perspective of 19 students, there were several ups and downs when studying in the Bamboo Curtain country, starting from processing files while in Indonesia, up to the graduation stage. These 19 students have used all their energy, time and best abilities to write their thesis, accompanied by their supervisor who also actively assisted in writing the thesis.

Before being declared as graduates, these 19 students had to fulfill several graduation requirements. First, passing any courses. Second, pass the Hanyu Shuiping Kaoshi (Chinese Language Proficiency Test) (HSK) 5 exam. Finally, passing the thesis exam. There were around 13 graduates from this class who took part in the job interview process by companies in Morowali, Central Sulawesi and were declared to have passed. Therefore, when returning to Indonesia, they would immediately work in Morowali.





HASANUDDIN UNIVERSITY JOINS ZOOM MEETING FOR INTERNAL MIDTERM REVIEW BY HIGHER EDUCATION PARTNERSHIP INITIATIVES



Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) joined the Zoom meeting for Internal Midterm Review (IMR) United States Agency for International Development (USAID) by Higher Education Partnership Initiatives (HEPI) preparation. The cooperation between UNHAS and USAID HEPI started in 2022 and will continue until 2027. As the cooperation now reaches 2.5 years, the IMR would be carried out in which all stakeholders from both parties would be involved. Joining the meeting from UNHAS were Rini Rachmawati, Ph.D (UNHAS HEPI Project Secretary), Prof. Kasbawati (UNHAS Accreditation Division) Sri Widodo, Ph.D (UNHAS Internal Quality Assurance), Fakhruddin, Ph.D (Make Innovation Space at Engineering Faculty) and Muhammad Ridwan, M.A. (International Office Secretary). In addition, from the HEPI USAID, joining the meeting was Abdul Rahman, Ph.D (USAID Country Director),

The meeting aimed at seeking the precise time for the IMR visit to UNHAS. According to the schedule, the IMR team would meet and discuss with several parties who benefited from the HEPI project at UNHAS. Based on the agreement, the project consists of 3 main cores for implementation. Core 1 and 2 regarding curriculum and accreditation are conducted by *Lembaga Penjaminan Mutu dan Pengembangan Pendidikan (LPMPP)* or the Institute of Quality Assurance and Educational Development. Meanwhile, the International Office (IO) itself is in charge of the implementation of Core 3 which mostly deals with the students' mobility or pathways to the United States (US). During the meeting, both parties tried to adjust the best time for the schedule accordingly. The IMR would be scheduled on Monday, July 8th, 2024, and take place at both Tamalanrea and Gowa Campus. The Zoom meeting ended with the hope of a smooth implementation of the IMR.

THE INTERNATIONAL OFFICE HOLDS A PREPARATION MEETING FOR PARTICIPATING IN THE INTERNATIONAL ACADEMIC CONSORTIUM FOR SUSTAINABLE CITIES IN MANILA, THE PHILIPPINES



The International Academic Consortium for Sustainable Cities (IACSC) was first initiated by Yokohama City University (YSU) in September 2009. Initially, it originated from a meeting session entitled cities and universities. The IACSC aims to develop cooperation, to foster dialogues and discussions, to encourage sharing of information and resources, and to promote research and collaborative activities among academic and research institutions as well as to strengthen relationships among universities and cities to contribute to a sustainable society. There are three main units (environment unit, urban planning unit and public health unit) within the IACSC to achieve its goal. Since then, six universities have become a member. They are Yokohama city universities, Universiti Sains Malaysia, Thammasat University, University of Philippines, Vietnam National University, and Hasanuddin University.

This year, the University of the Philippines will be hosting the 15th IACSC Conference with preconference activities, International Urban Planning Workshop (IUPW), and Sustainable Urban Development Program (SUDP) on August 19th-22nd, 2024 at University of the Philippines Diliman (UPD) and University of the Philippines Los Baños (UPLB), respectively while the conference will be on August 23, 2024 at the SEDA Manila Bay, Aseana Avenue, Parañaque City, with the theme "Sustainable and Resilient Future Cities through Research and Innovation."

The 15th IACSC Conference is a collaboration among the College of Public Health - University of the Philippines Manila, the School of Urban and Regional Planning - University of the Philippines Diliman, and the Institute of Biological Sciences, the Graduate School, and the College of Human Ecology - University of the Philippines Los Baños. The Conference program shall include plenary sessions by distinguished experts on environment, public health, and urban planning, and provide an opportunity for students from the IACSC member institutions to present their learnings from the pre-conference workshops on urban planning and development, and have a discourse on relevant issues, researches and innovations in the fields of environmental health, public health, and urban planning for sustainable and resilient future cities.

To ensure Hasanuddin University's (UNHAS) participation in this prestigious event, the International Office (IO) organised the initial meeting on Thursday, June 6th, 2024 to discuss its participation in the Philippines this year. Joining the meeting were Khaeruddin Ph.D (IO Task Force), Dr. Eng. Ihsan, S.T., M.T., and Isfa Sastrawati S.T., M.T. (Faculty of Engineering). The meeting outcomes formulated a complete team of UNHAS participants. Six students from three faculties were selected namely Habel Bimbim Mangari, Andi Ahmad Fitra Yuda (Faculty of Engineering) Andi Shifa Salsabila, Kenzo Ibrahimovich, Annisa Rafa Ramadhani (Faculty of Public Health), and Fauziyah Ansar (Faculty of Nursing). 

THE FACULTY OF CULTURAL SCIENCES PRESENTS A WEBINAR ON TRANSLATION ACROSS CULTURES; RESEARCH AND PEDAGOGY



The Faculty of Cultural Sciences (FIB) through the Department of English Literatures, Master and Doctoral Programs of English Language Studies in collaboration with *Himpunan Penerjemah Indonesia* (*HPI*) or the Association of Indonesian Translation of South Sulawesi presented a webinar on "Translation Across Cultures: Research and Pedagogy" on Thursday, June 13th, 2024 at 10-12 am Makassar time. The speaker invited was Daniel Krausse, Ph.D (Postdoctoral Researcher) at Lattice-CNRS in Paris, France. The webinar began with the opening ceremony. The welcome remark was made by Prof. Nasmilah, Ph.D (Head of the English Literature Department). Meanwhile, representing the Dean of FIB, the opening speech was carried out by Dr. Dafirah (Vice Dean for Planning, Human Resources, and Alumni). In addition, the moderator of the webinar was Sitti Sahraeni, S.S., M. AppLing (Secretary of the English Literatures Department). The Webinar was the part of a series of seminars and conferences celebrating the 68th Anniversary of Hasanuddin University Chaired by the Faculty of Cultural Sciences (FIB) and co-chaired by the Faculty of Pharmacy (FF).

Furthermore, the speaker, Mr Daniel began his presentation with the definition of translation. He quoted a British writer, Anthony Burgess "Translation is not a matter of words only. It is a matter of making intelligible a whole culture." He then continued with keys to a good translation consisting of four aspects including communication bridge, preservation of meaning, cultural adaptation, and interpretation and creativity. Moreover, he also came up with types of translation including literary translation, media, audio/visual translation, specialized translation, machine translation, and legal and certified translation.

He ended his power points by figuring out the translation that meets linguistics. He added that this was about conversational questionnaires. It was a new project and currently developed by Alexandre Francois (Lattice-CNRS) in 2019 focusing on unstudied languages. This type is not literal but rather than contextual. His presentation attracted around 140 participants showing up on the Zoom platform. After the question and answer session, Prof. Nasmilah officially closed the webinar and continued with a photo session.

The judiciary meeting of the Indonesian International Students Mobility Awards (IISMA) Co-Funding Batch 1 was held through Zoom meeting on Wednesday, June 12, 2024 at 8 pm Makassar time. The International Office (IO), Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) was invited to join as one of its awardees joined this batch 1 represented by Muhammad Ridwan, M.A. (IO Secretary). According to the IISMA announcement, there were three participating regions in the meeting including North America, Asia, and Europe. From North America, joining the meeting were University of California, Davis and Michigan State University (MSU). Meanwhile, from Asia, joining the meeting was Singapore Management University (SMU). In Europe, joining the meeting were Radboud University (RU) and University of Information Technology and Management (UITM), Rzeszow for Vocational Studies. In addition, UNHAS itself would send its student named Nabila Eiffelyne Ariyantha to Radboud University.

The meeting continued to listen to each awardee's presentation. The first presentation started with awardees that would study at RU then followed by awardees studying at the University of California, Davis. Moreover, the awardees studying at UITM continued the presentation. Each awardee presented their preparation in terms of submitting the required document by IISMA and also their challenges during the preparation. The IISMA representative, Dewi Comala Sari explained the rules for IISMA awardees that have to be obeyed during the program. The rules explained did not mean to scare the awardees, rather it was a friendly reminder from the beginning before it occurs in the program. The Question and Answer (Q&A) was presented and several awardees proposed the questions. The judiciary ended with a photo session.



FACULTY OF MATHEMATICS AND NATURAL SCIENCES UNHAS VISITS UTM MALAYSIA AND NTU SINGAPORE FOR RESEARCH COLLABORATION DISCUSSION



On June 10-11, 2024, the Faculty of Mathematics and Natural Sciences (FMIPA) from Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) visited Universiti Teknologi Malaysia (UTM) and Nanyang Technological University (NTU) in Singapore to discuss potential research collaborations.

The visit began at UTM on June 10, 2024. During this visit, a Letter of Collaboration (LoC) was signed by Dr. Eng. Amiruddin, (Dean of FMIPA UNHAS), Prof. Eng. Dr. Rahmat bin Mohsin (Dean of the Faculty of Chemical Engineering UTM,) and Assoc. Prof. Dr. Shafinaz binti Shahir (Dean of the Faculty of Science UTM). Following the signing ceremony, the delegation toured UTM's Physics, Biology, Chemistry, and Mathematics laboratories, gaining insights into the university's research capabilities and infrastructure.

The next day, the UNHAS delegation visited the College of Science at NTU. They were welcomed by Associate Professor Guillaume Thibault (Assistant Dean for International Cooperation), who provided an overview of NTU's history and achievements, highlighting how the university has become one of the world's leading institutions. The visit continued with tours of the Division of Physics and Mathematics, the Division of Chemistry, and the ASEAN School of Environment, showcasing NTU's extensive research facilities and expertise.

The visit concluded with a luncheon at the Earth Observatory of Singapore (EOS), hosted by NTU, providing an opportunity for informal discussions and networking to strengthen ties between the institutions. The Faculty of MIPA UNHAS hopes that this visit will pave the way for fruitful research collaborations in the future, enhancing scientific knowledge and innovation across the regions.




Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) held an international webinar on Gender in Islamic Perspective. This webinar was a collaboration between UNHAS and Al Azhar University and was held on Sunday, June 20th, 2024 from 1pm Makassar time and 7am Cairo time. The webinar began with an opening ceremony that was officially opened by the Rector of UNHAS, Prof. Jamaluddin Jompa, M.Sc., well known as Prof JJ. The next speech was delivered by the President of Al Azhar University, Prof. Dr. Salama Gomaa Daoud. Joining the meeting from UNHAS side were Prof. drg. Muhammad Ruslin, M.Kes., Ph.D., Sp.BM(K) (Vice-Rector for Academic and Students Affairs), Prof. Dr. Farida Patittingi, M.Hum (Vice Rector for Human Resources, Alumni and Information System), Prof. Dr. Eng. Adi Maulana, S.T., M.Phil (Vice-Rector for Partnerships, Innovation, Entrepreneurship and Business), Prof. Dr. Akin Duli, M.A.(Dean of Faculty of Cultural Sciences), and other lecturers, students and fellow UNHAS academic communities. The speaker was Prof. Dr. Nahla Shabry As Sha'idy (Dean of Faculty of Islamic Studies, Al Azhar University) and was moderated by Dr. Syamsul Bahri (Lecturer of Department of Arabic Literature).

Prof. JJ, in his opening speech, expressed his gratitude to Prof. Salama and the speaker Prof. Nahla as well as to the participants for their time joining this webinar. In addition, Prof JJ said that the gender issue is being implemented at the right time where the global community is voicing how women can participate. At UNHAS, we create inclusive businesses for women so that in the future we are ready for social challenges regarding the role of women. He also encouraged the participants to propose questions, elicit more information, and insights about the role of women, related to the Islamic teachings. In his closing, Prof. JJ invited Prof Salam and other Al Azhar University officials to visit UNHAS in Makassar, Indonesia for the inauguration of the Center for Teaching Arabic and Islam.

Likewise UNHAS Rector, Prof Salama also conveyed his happiness for this webinar focusing on the Gender in Islamic Perspective. He also conveyed his respect to UNHAS and the Rector. He delivered the important point of this collaboration, namely the Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) that is being drafted and the process for signing is still ongoing. Prof. Salama introduced his university as one of the standard universities in Egypt and the world. In terms of Islamic studies such as sharia, it is a reference and center of world attention in terms of teaching Arabic.

After the two speeches, the webinar continued with Prof. Nahla's presentation. Her presentation referred to how Islam sees womens' participation in the society. She encouraged all women to be more engaged in pursuing their dreams. As she talked based on the Islamic perspective, she came up with many verses talking about women in the Holy Koran. Her presentation attracted around 400 participants coming from many different institutions outside UNHAS. These institutions included government officials, private sectors, women activists and others. This webinar was a follow up meeting of UNHAS Board of Trustee and Rector's visit to the university in Egypt and was considered as a starting point of the collaboration between both parties. This webinar was organized by the Gender Research Center, Lembaga Penelitian dan Pengabdian Masyarakat (LPPM) or the Institute of Research and Community Services and Department of Arabic Literature Study Program, Faculty of Cultural Sciences (FIB).


THE FACULTY OF SOCIAL AND POLITICAL SCIENCES STRENGTHEN COOPERATION WITH UNIVERSITI SAINS MALAYSIA



Strengthening international cooperation between campuses is one of the main agendas of the Faculty of Social and Political Sciences (FISIP), Hasanuddin University (UNHAS) which encourages UNHAS to become a global campus. In relation to this, Faculty of Social and Political Science held an international webinar in collaboration with the Political Science Section, School of Distance Education (SDE), Universiti Sains Malaysia (USM), Penang, Malaysia with the theme "Community Empowerment and Quality Education: Perspective From Indonesia and Malaysia". This activity was carried out on Wednesday, June 26, 2024 online and presented by two speakers, namely Prof.Dr.Phil. Sukri, S.IP, M.Si and Dr. Nurul Hasanah Abdul Rahman guided by Dr. Zaharul Abdullah who is also a lecturer at USM, Malaysia. Prof. Sukri, who is also the Dean of Social and Political Sciences, Unhas, presented material related to his research with the title "Indigenous People after Government Recognition: Opportunities or Challenges?". In his presentation, Prof. Sukri explained how indigenous communities have become an important issue on the political map of Indonesia, where until now there are still many indigenous communities in the advocacy process to obtain legal recognition.


It was hoped that this recognition would greatly influence various aspects of their lives, including aspects of natural resource management, especially those within their customary areas. So far, conflicts regarding the rights of indigenous peoples regarding the management of natural resources in their territories still occur frequently and indigenous communities are often the weak parties. In addition, another important aspect is the opportunity for Indigenous communities to be able to access public services provided by the government, including in the education sector. This aspect is certainly important, especially for developing human resources in indigenous communities. Thus, apart from the natural resources aspect, the human resources aspect is also an important part of the state's recognition of indigenous peoples.

Meanwhile, Dr. Nurul in his presentation explained the distance education policy concerning the SDGs Agenda in Malaysia. According to Dr. Nurul, the distance education policy is one of the Malaysian government's efforts to ensure that all citizens can access education without having to be restricted due to geographical constraints. The webinar was attended by 100 participants, not only from UNHAS and USM but also participants from various other cities in Indonesia and Malaysia. This activity will continue to carry out international cooperation between the two institutions in the future, including student and lecturer exchanges as well as collaborative research by lecturers from both institutions.





THREE STUDENTS OF UNIVERSITAS HASANUDDIN EXPLORE MARITIME CULTURE OF CHINA AT SHANGHAI OCEAN UNIVERSITY



Shanghai Ocean University (ShOU) conducted its 4th Shanghai Summer School RCEP Marine Culture International Program on June 5-27, 2024. Hasanuddin University deployed three students (two undergraduate students of Faculty of Marine Science and Fisheries and a postgraduate student from Faculty of Cultural Sciences). They are Ahmad Aufaasikki, Nurfauzani Sangaji, and Kumara Tungga Dewa.

This year's summer school brought together 34 students from nine countries, offering them an immersive experience in cutting-edge marine engineering topics. The program featured engaging outdoor excursions that significantly enhanced the participants' understanding of marine engineering. Students underwent simulated crew training aboard the Wu Song vessel and engaged in hands-on marine biology activities. At the Chongming Island research base for marine studies, they gained a comprehensive understanding of aquaculture processes. Additionally, a visit to the China Maritime Museum offered profound insights into the development of China's maritime culture.

The program also included a rich array of cultural activities aimed at deepening the students' appreciation of traditional Chinese culture. These activities included calligraphy, traditional Chinese painting, gu zheng (a traditional Chinese musical instrument) lessons, and dragon boat racing.

Moreover, they also forged connections with peers from around the world and learned the importance of cross-cultural communication through collaborative projects. The representatives of Indonesia also had a chance to present the country, in a series of information ranging from the geography, the demography, to the cultural diversity of Indonesia.
