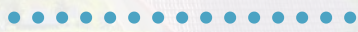

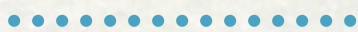

UNHAS History



UNHAS is one of the top universities and the most prominent university in the Eastern part of Indonesia. It has 44,774 students studying in more than 200 study programs of bachelors, profession, master, doctoral, and specialist programs. The university also provides 16 international classes in the field of economics, medicine, international relations, communications, laws, informatics, and engineering. UNHAS excels in developing science, technology, arts, and culture; focusing on the Indonesia maritime continent and aiming to nurture innovative and globally responsive leaders. The university is located in the center of the coral triangle, making the university becomes one of Indonesia's best places or the world best place to study coral reefs and other marine ecosystems.

UNHAS was formally established in 10 September 1956. Initially, it consisted of four faculties; the Faculty of Economics, the Faculty of Law and Public Knowledge, the Faculty of Medicine and the Teacher Education College Located in Manado City. The establishment of Hasanuddin University in Makassar is inseparable from the assistance of the University of Indonesia, especially in the formation of the Faculty of Economics, Faculty of Law, and Faculty of Medicine Makassar which is the forerunner of UNHAS. Currently, UNHAS has 16 faculties and one postgraduate school.

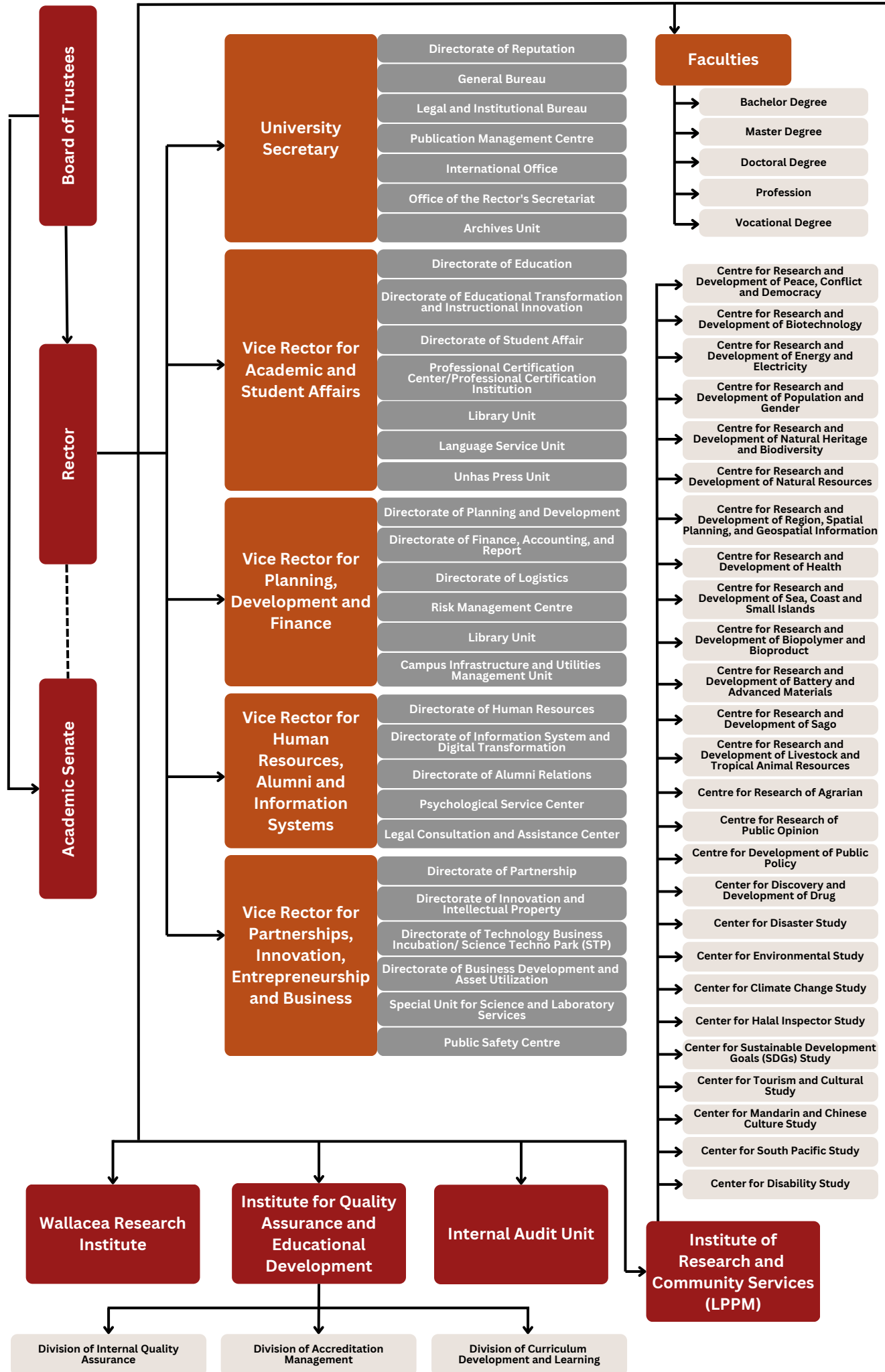
