Relation to Curriculum	This course is a compulsory course and offered in the 5 th semester.
Type of teaching, contact hours	Teaching methods used in this course are: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Lecture (i.e case study, focus group discussion, NHT, STAD, SBL and role play.) - Structured assignments (i.e., essays, activity in group, presentation, quiz) - Clinical fieldwork (i.e. field observation). The class size for lecture is approximately 27 students, while for clinical fieldwork is about 6 – 7 students for each lecturer. Contact hours for lecture is 23.33 hours, assignments is 28 hours, and clinical fieldwork is 46.67 hours.
Workload	For this course, students are required to meet a minimum of 165.67 hours in one semester, which consist of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 23.33 hours for lecture, - 28 hours for structured assignments, - 28 hours for private study, - 46.67 hours for clinical fieldwork.
